MATLAMAT PEMBANGUNAN MAMPAN (SDG) DASHBOARD

***SDG Dashboard* terkini memaparkan 195 indikator di peringkat nasional, 80 indikator di peringkat negeri dan 23 indikator peringkat daerah**

PUTRAJAYA, 26 JANUARI 2024 – Pada hari ini, Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) telah memuatnaik indikator terkini Matlamat Pembangunan Mampan (SDG) di platform *SDG Dashboard* berdasarkan laporan Indikator Matlamat Pembangunan Mampan (SDG), Malaysia, 2022 yang telah diterbitkan 7 Disember 2023. Platform ini memaparkan 195 indikator SDG di peringkat nasional, 80 indikator peringkat negeri dan 23 indikator peringkat daerah pentadbiran bagi data siri masa 2016 hingga 2022.

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata, “*SDG Dashboard* pada tahun ini memaparkan tambahan 20 indikator baharu peringkat nasional, empat (4) indikator peringkat negeri dan tiga (3) indikator peringkat daerah pentadbiran. *SDG Dashboard* memaparkan indikator SDG terkini secara visual interaktif bagi tujuan pemantauan ketersediaan indikator SDG ke arah mencapai Agenda 2030. Selain itu, data daripada platform ini boleh dimuat turun secara percuma serta pengguna boleh mengakses data mengikut kategori antaranya tahun, negeri, strata, jantina dan kumpulan umur. Inisiatif DOSM ini adalah usaha menyokong strategi kerajaan ke arah pendigitalan dan perkongsian data kepada masyarakat. Platform ini turut memberi manfaat kepada kerajaan negeri, pihak berkuasa tempatan, sektor swasta, penyelidik, pelajar dan orang ramai bagi mendapatkan maklumat berkaitan indikator SDG terkini”.

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Menurut Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir lagi, “Antara indikator baharu di peringkat nasional adalah SDG 2.3.1 (Produktiviti buruh sektor pertanian), SDG 7.b.1 (Kapasiti penjanaan tenaga boleh baharu) dan SDG 11.3.1 (Kadar penggunaan tanah). Indikator baharu di peringkat negeri antaranya SDG 2.2.1 (Prevalens pembantutan), SDG 2.2.2 (Prevalens kekurangan nutrisi) dan SDG 5.5.2 (Wanita dalam jawatan pengurusan). Manakala bagi meningkatkan pelaporan indikator sehingga ke peringkat terkecil, indikator baharu yang tersedia bagi peringkat daerah pentadbiran adalah SDG 1.4.1 (Akses kepada keperluan asas), SDG 5.5.1 (b) (Peratusan wanita dalam kerajaan tempatan) dan SDG 7.1.2 (penggunaan bahan api dan teknologi bersih)”.

SDG merupakan satu set matlamat global yang merangkumi 17 Matlamat serta 169 Sasaran. SDG memfokuskan kepada tiga dimensi utama pembangunan, iaitu ekonomi, sosial dan alam sekitar. Pencapaian SDG diukur melalui 248 indikator di peringkat global. Kesemua indikator ini berperanan sebagai pengukuran terhadap peningkatan taraf hidup dan pembangunan yang mampan. Indikator ini memainkan peranan penting kepada kerajaan dan pelbagai pihak untuk meningkatkan perkhidmatan dan menyediakan kehidupan yang lebih baik kepada generasi sekarang dan masa depan. Agenda Pembangunan Mampan memerlukan penglibatan menyeluruh dan inklusif, serta usaha gigih dari semua pihak dalam meningkatkan kesedaran terhadap SDG.

SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS (SDGS) DASHBOARD

***SDG Dashboard showcases 195 indicators at the national level,
80 indicators at the state level and 23 indicators at the district level***

PUTRAJAYA, 26th JANUARY 2024 – Today, the Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) has uploaded the latest indicators of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) on the SDG Dashboard platform based on the Sustainable Development Goals Indicator Report, Malaysia, 2022, published on 7th December 2023. This platform showcases 195 SDG indicators at national level, 80 indicators at state level and 23 indicators at administrative district levels for time series of 2016 to 2022.

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said, "The SDG Dashboard this year presents an additional 20 new indicators at the national level, four (4) state level indicators and three (3) administrative district level indicators. The SDG Dashboard displays the latest SDG indicators in a visual interactive for the purpose of monitoring the availability of SDG indicators towards achieving the 2030 Agenda. In addition, data from this platform can be downloaded for free as well as allowing users to choose data based on categories such as year, state, strata, gender and age group. This initiative by DOSM is an effort to support the government's strategies towards digitalisation and data sharing with the public. This platform also benefits state government, local authorities, the private sector, researchers, students and publics in obtaining latest information related to SDG indicators."

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According to Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir, "Among the new indicators at the national level are SDG 2.3.1 (Labor productivity for agriculture sector), SDG 7.b.1 (New renewable energy capacity) and SDG 11.3.1 (Land use rate). New indicators at the state level include SDG 2.2.1 (Prevalence of stunting), SDG 2.2.2 (Prevalence of malnutrition) and SDG 5.5.2 (Women in managerial positions). To enhance indicator reporting to granular level, new indicators that are available at the administrative district level include SDG 1.4.1 (Access to basic needs), SDG 5.5.1 (b) (Percentage of women in local government) and SDG 7.1.2 (Use of clean fuel and technology)."

The SDG represents a set of global goals comprising 17 Goals and 169 Targets. SDG focus on three main dimensions of development, namely economic, social and environmental. The achievement of SDG is measured through 248 indicators at the global level. All these indicators serve as measurements of the improvement in the quality of life and sustainable development. These indicators play a crucial role for the government and various stakeholders in enhancing services and providing a better life for the present and future generations. Sustainable Development Agenda requires comprehensive and inclusive engagement, as well as concerted efforts from all parties to raise awareness about the SDG.
