BAGI INDEKS VOLUM PERDAGANGAN BORONG & RUNCIT, MALAYSIA, SUKE TAHUN PERTAMA 2024

Indeks Volum Perdagangan Borong & Runcit berkembang 3.7 peratus pada suku tahun pertama 2024

PUTRAJAYA, 9 MEI 2024 – Indeks volum Perdagangan Borong & Runcit Malaysia merekodkan pertumbuhan 3.7 peratus tahun ke tahun pada suku tahun pertama 2024 untuk mencapai 152.8 mata. Ini dilaporkan oleh Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) pada hari ini dalam siaran **INDEKS VOLUM PERDAGANGAN BORONG & RUNCIT (2015=100), SUKU TAHUN PERTAMA 2024**. Laporan ini juga membentangkan statistik mengenai indeks volum Perdagangan Borong & Runcit mengikut subsektor.

Mengulas laporan tersebut, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia dalam satu kenyataan hari ini berkata, “Peningkatan 3.7 peratus tahun ke tahun disumbangkan oleh subsektor Kenderaan Bermotor yang tumbuh 4.7 peratus kepada 134.1 mata. Ini diikuti oleh Perdagangan Runcit dan Perdagangan Borong yang meningkat masing-masing 3.8 peratus dan 3.5 peratus. Sebaliknya, bagi perbandingan suku tahun ke suku tahun, indeks volum turun -0.1 peratus, disebabkan oleh kejatuhan dalam subsektor Kenderaan Bermotor dengan -1.7 peratus.”

Beralih kepada prestasi mengikut subsektor, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin memaklumkan, "Pertumbuhan positif 4.7 peratus bagi indeks volum Kenderaan Bermotor disokong oleh Jualan Komponen & Aksesori Kenderaan Bermotor dengan 12.1 peratus. Ini diikuti oleh Penyelenggaraan & Pembaikan Kenderaan Bermotor dan Jualan Kenderaan Bermotor masing-masing dengan 8.5 peratus dan 4.3 peratus. Walau bagaimanapun, bagi perbandingan suku tahunan, indeks volum Kenderaan Bermotor merosot dengan -1.7 peratus."

Mengulas lanjut prestasi indeks volum Perdagangan Runcit, beliau seterusnya memaklumkan peningkatan sebanyak 3.8 peratus bagi subsektor ini disumbangkan oleh Jualan Runcit Makanan, Minuman & Tembakau dengan 6.5 peratus. Ini diikuti Jualan Runcit Barang Kesenian & Rekreasi (4.8%), Jualan Runcit di Kedai Penghususan (4.6%), Jualan Runcit Peralatan Isi Rumah (4.2%), Jualan Runcit di Kedai Bukan Penghususan (4.0%) dan Jualan Runcit Bahan Api Kenderaan (2.5%). Bagi perbandingan suku tahun ke suku tahun, indeks volum Perdagangan Runcit naik 0.04 peratus.

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin turut memaklumkan, "Indeks volum Perdagangan Borong merekodkan pertumbuhan positif 3.5 peratus, disumbangkan oleh Lain-lain Penghususan Jualan Borong dengan 7.2 peratus. Ini diikuti oleh Jual Borong Bahan Mentah Pertanian & Haiwan Hidup (5.0%), Jualan Borong Makanan, Minuman & Tembakau (4.6%), Jual Borong Berdasarkan Kontrak atau Yuran (2.4%) dan Perdagangan Borong Tanpa Penghususan (2.3%). Bagi perbandingan suku tahunan, indeks volum Perdagangan Borong naik 0.1 peratus berbanding suku tahun lepas."

"Bagi indeks volum pelarasan musim, Perdagangan Borong & Runcit meningkat 0.9 peratus berbanding suku tahun keempat 2023, disokong oleh Perdagangan Borong (1.5%) dan Perdagangan Runcit (1.3%)," jelas beliau.

FOR VOLUME INDEX OF WHOLESALE & RETAIL TRADE, MALAYSIA, FIRST QUARTER 2024

**Wholesale & Retail Trade Volume Index expanded 3.7 per cent
in the first quarter 2024**

PUTRAJAYA, MAY 9, 2024 – Volume index of Wholesale & Retail Trade Malaysia registered a growth of 3.7 per cent year-on-year in the first quarter of 2024 to reach 152.8 points. This is reported by Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) in today's release of **VOLUME INDEX OF WHOLESALE & RETAIL TRADE (2015=100), FIRST QUARTER 2024**. This report also presents statistics on volume index of Wholesale & Retail Trade by sub-sector.

Commenting on the report, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Chief Statistician Malaysia in a statement today said, "The year-on-year increase of 3.7 per cent was attributed to Motor Vehicles sub-sector which grew 4.7 per cent to 134.1 points. This was followed by Retail Trade and Wholesale Trade which increased 3.8 per cent and 3.5 per cent, respectively. Conversely, for quarter-on-quarter comparison, volume index inched down -0.1 per cent due to a fall of -1.7 per cent

in Motor Vehicles sub-sector.”

Moving on to performance across sub-sectors, Dato’ Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin added to note that, “The positive growth of 4.7 per cent in volume index of Motor Vehicles was supported by Sales of Motor Vehicles Parts & Accessories with 12.1 per cent. This was followed by Maintenance & Repair of Motor Vehicles and Sales of Motor Vehicles with 8.5 per cent and 4.3 per cent, respectively. However, for quarterly comparison, volume index of Motor Vehicles declined -1.7 per cent.”

Commenting further on the performance of volume index of Retail Trade, he pointed out that the increase of 3.8 per cent in this sub-sector was contributed by Retail Sales of Food, Beverages & Tobacco with 6.5 per cent. This was followed by Retail Sales of Cultural & Recreation Goods (4.8%), Retail Sales in Specialised Stores (4.6%), Retail Sales of Household Goods (4.2%), Retail Sales in Non-specialised Stores (4.0%), and Retail Sales of Automotive Fuel (2.5%). For quarter-on-quarter comparison, volume index of Retail Trade edged up 0.04 per cent.

Dato’ Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin added to note that, “Volume index of Wholesale Trade recorded a positive growth of 3.5 per cent, contributed by Other Specialised Wholesale with 7.2 per cent. This was followed by Wholesale of Agricultural Raw Materials & Live Animals (5.0%), Wholesale of Food, Beverages & Tobacco (4.6%), Wholesale on a Fee or Contract Basis (2.4%), and Non-specialised Wholesale Trade (2.3%). For quarterly comparison, volume index of Wholesale Trade inched up 0.1 per cent as compared to the previous quarter.”


“As for seasonally adjusted volume index, Wholesale & Retail Trade increased 0.9 per cent as against the fourth quarter of 2023, supported by Wholesale Trade (1.5%) and Retail Trade (1.3%),” he explained.
