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INDEKS PERDAGANGAN LUAR NEGERI, MALAYSIA, OGOS 2025

Indeks Nilai Seunit Eksport meningkat 1.0 peratus kepada 152.9 mata pada Ogos 2025.

PUTRAJAYA, 26 SEPTEMBER 2025 – Indeks nilai seunit eksport Malaysia pada Ogos 2025 terus mencatatkan peningkatan 1.0 peratus daripada 151.4 mata pada bulan sebelumnya kepada 152.9 mata. Sementara itu, indeks nilai seunit import menurun 0.2 peratus daripada 125.0 mata kepada 124.8 mata. Walau bagaimanapun, terma perdagangan Malaysia bertumbuh 1.2 peratus bulan ke bulan daripada 121.1 mata kepada 122.5 mata pada Ogos 2025, sebagaimana dipaparkan oleh laporan **INDEKS PERDAGANGAN LUAR NEGERI (2010=100), OGOS 2025** pada hari ini. Penerbitan ini memaparkan statistik indeks nilai seunit, indeks volum dan terma perdagangan meliputi 10 seksyen komoditi produk barangan selaras dengan Klasifikasi Standard Perdagangan Antarabangsa (SITC).

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin menjelaskan indeks nilai seunit eksport meningkat 1.0 peratus pada Ogos 2025 berbanding bulan sebelumnya. Kenaikan ini disumbangkan oleh peningkatan dalam indeks minyak & lemak binatang & sayur-sayuran (+2.4%), minyak galian (+0.9%) dan alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (+0.6%). Namun begitu, indeks volum eksport jatuh 6.9 peratus selaras dengan penurunan dalam indeks barang-barang keluaran kilang (-12.3%), alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (-11.5%) dan makanan (-7.4%). Indeks volum eksport pelarasan bermusim juga turut jatuh 6.9 peratus daripada 174.9 mata kepada 162.8 mata. Merujuk kepada

perbandingan tahunan, kedua-dua indeks nilai seunit dan indeks volum eksport meningkat 1.7 peratus dan 1.2 peratus.

Indeks nilai seunit import merosot 0.2 peratus pada Ogos 2025, disumbangkan oleh penurunan dalam indeks minyak galian (-1.2%), bahan kimia (-0.4%) dan barang-barang keluaran kilang (-0.3%). Tambahan pula, indeks volum import juga turut jatuh 7.8 peratus pada Ogos 2025 berbanding bulan sebelum, disumbangkan oleh kejatuhan dalam indeks minyak galian (-16.4%), pelbagai barang keluaran kilang (-9.2%) dan alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (-8.8%). Indeks volum import pelarasan bermusim juga turut berkurang 7.2 peratus daripada 221.8 mata kepada 205.8 mata. Perbandingan tahun ke tahun menunjukkan kedua-dua indeks nilai seunit dan indeks volum import menurun 3.7 peratus dan 2.3 peratus.

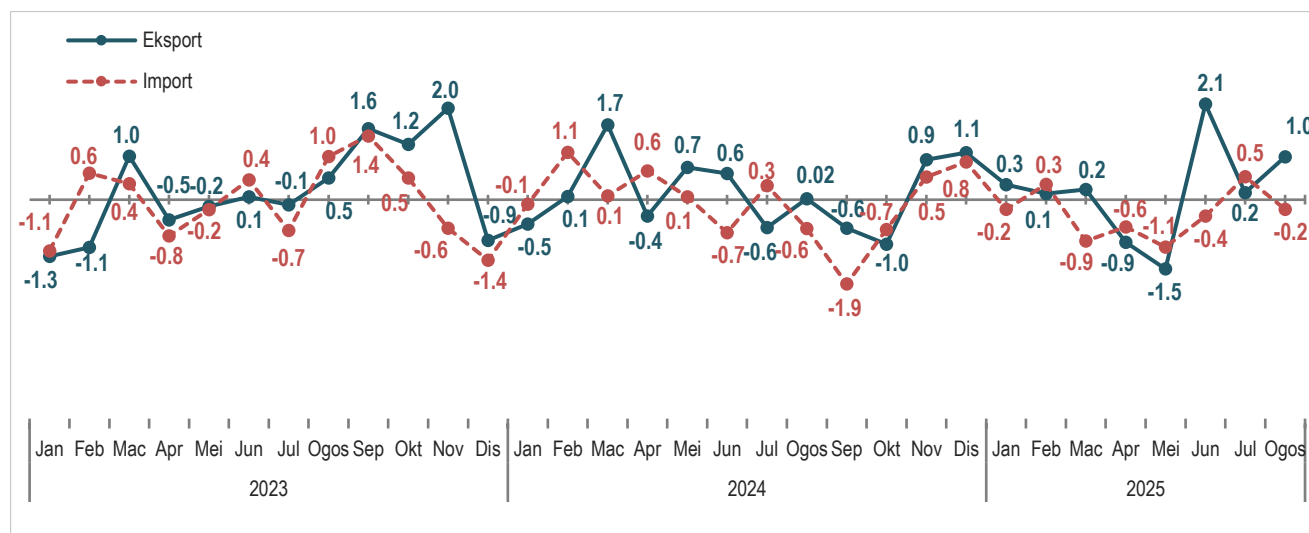
Terma perdagangan Malaysia meningkat 1.2 peratus bulan ke bulan kepada 122.5 mata pada Ogos 2025, didorong oleh peningkatan dalam indeks minyak galian (+2.1%), minyak & lemak binatang & sayur-sayuran (+1.3%) dan alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (+0.7%). Tambahan pula, terma perdagangan Malaysia tahun ke tahun bertambah 5.6 peratus daripada 116.0 mata pada Ogos tahun lalu.

Kepengerusian ASEAN-Malaysia 2025: Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) akan mempengerusikan Jawatankuasa Sistem Statistik Komuniti ASEAN Ke-15 (ACSS15) yang bertujuan untuk memperkukuh kerjasama statistik ke arah pembangunan serantau yang mampan.

Malaysia buat julung kalinya telah menduduki tangga pertama (1) di peringkat global dalam laporan dwi-tahunan Open Data Inventory (ODIN) 2024/25 yang dikeluarkan oleh Open Data Watch (ODW), mengatasi 197 negara lain. Pencapaian ini merupakan lonjakan ketara daripada kedudukan ke-67 dalam penilaian ODIN 2022/23.

Kerajaan Malaysia telah mengisytiharkan 20 Oktober sebagai Hari Statistik Negara (MyStats Day), dengan tema 'Statistik Nadi Kehidupan'. Sementara itu, Hari Statistik Dunia Keempat akan disambut pada 20 Oktober 2025 dengan tema '*Driving Change with Quality Statistics and Data for Everyone*'.

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EXTERNAL TRADE INDICES, MALAYSIA, AUGUST 2025

The Export Unit Value Index increased 1.0 per cent to 152.9 points in August 2025.

PUTRAJAYA, SEPTEMBER 26, 2025 – Malaysia's export unit value index in August 2025 continues to grow by 1.0 per cent from 151.4 points in the previous month to 152.9 points. Meanwhile, import unit value index descended 0.2 per cent from 125.0 points to 124.8 points. Nevertheless, Malaysia's terms of trade grew 1.2 per cent month-on-month from 121.1 points to 122.5 points in August 2025 as reported today in **EXTERNAL TRADE INDICES (2010=100), AUGUST 2025**. This publication presents the unit value index, volume index and terms of trade for 10 commodity sections of merchandise products in accordance with the Standard International Trade Classification (SITC).

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin highlighted, the export unit value index rose by 1.0 per cent in August 2025 as compared to the previous month. This growth was primarily driven by the increases in the index of animal & vegetable oils & fats (+2.4%), mineral fuels (+0.9%) and machinery & transport equipment (+0.6%). In contrast, the export volume index fell by 6.9 per cent in line with the decrease in the index of manufactured goods (-12.3%), machinery & transport equipment (-11.5%) and food (-7.4%). The seasonally adjusted export volume index also slipped by 6.9 per cent from 174.9 points to 162.8 points. Referring to the annual comparison, both the exports unit value index and volume index expanded 1.7 per cent and 1.2 per cent respectively.

The import unit value index declined 0.2 per cent in August 2025, contributed by the decline in the index of mineral fuels (-1.2%), chemicals (-0.4%) and manufactured goods (-0.3%). Furthermore, the import volume index also decreased by 7.8 per cent in August 2025 as compared to the previous month, contributed by the decrement in the index of mineral fuels (-16.4%), miscellaneous manufactured articles (-9.2%) and machinery & transport equipment (-8.8%). The seasonally adjusted import volume index also descended by 7.2 per cent from 221.8 points to 205.8 points. A year-on-year comparison showed that both the import unit value index and volume index edged down by 3.7 per cent and 2.3 per cent respectively.

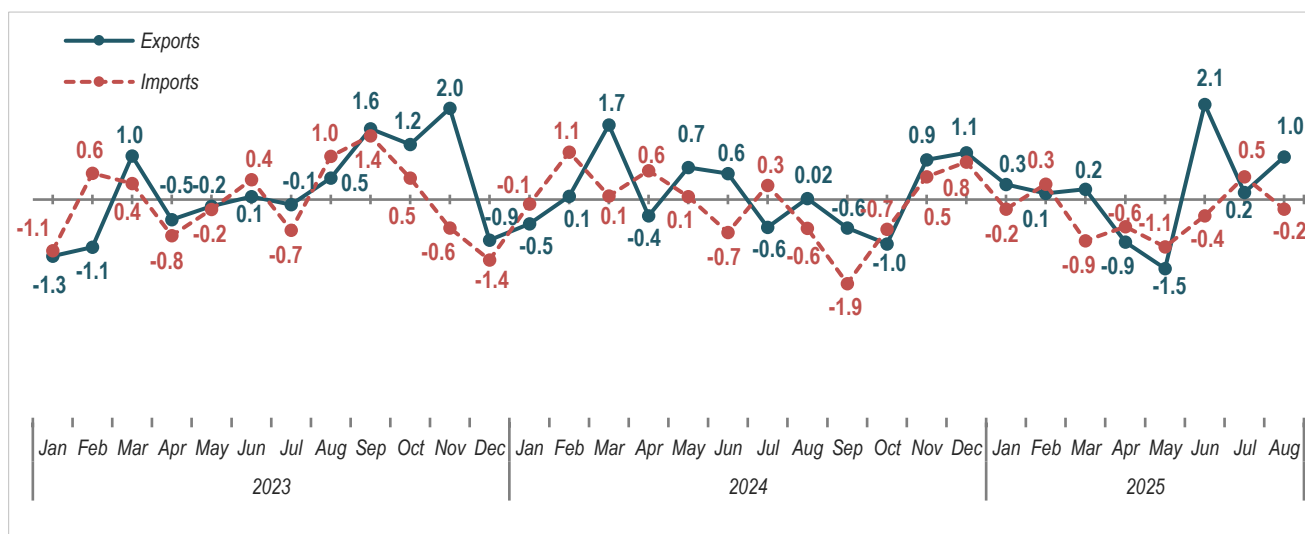
Malaysia's terms of trade ascended 1.2 per cent month-on-month to 122.5 points in August 2025, driven by the increase in the index of mineral fuels (+2.1%), animal & vegetable oils & fats (+1.3%) and machinery & transport equipment (+0.7%). In addition, Malaysia's terms of trade rose 5.6 per cent year-on-year from 116.0 points in August previous year.

ASEAN-Malaysia 2025 Chairmanship: Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) will chair the 15th ASEAN Community Statistical System Committee (ACSS15) which aims to strengthen the statistical cooperation towards sustainable regional development.

Malaysia, for the first time, ranked as number one (1) globally in the biennial Open Data Inventory (ODIN) 2024/25 report released by Open Data Watch (ODW), surpassing 197 other countries. This achievement marks a significant leap from its 67th position in the ODIN 2022/23 assessment.

The Government of Malaysia has declared October 20th as National Statistics Day (MyStats Day), with the theme 'Statistics is the Essence of Life'. Meanwhile, the Fourth World Statistics Day will be celebrated on 20th October 2025, with the theme 'Driving Change with Quality Statistics and Data for Everyone'.
