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Pemakluman

Kepengerusian ASEAN-Malaysia 2025: Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) akan mempengerusikan Jawatankuasa Sistem Statistik Komuniti ASEAN Ke-15 (ACSS15) yang bertujuan untuk memperkukuh kerjasama statistik ke arah pembangunan serantau yang mampan.

Malaysia buat julung kalinya telah menduduki tangga pertama (1) di peringkat global dalam laporan dwi-tahunan *Open Data Inventory* (ODIN) 2024/25 yang dikeluarkan oleh *Open Data Watch* (ODW), mengatasi 198 negara lain. Pencapaian ini merupakan lonjakan ketara daripada kedudukan ke-67 dalam penilaian ODIN 2022/23.

Kerajaan Malaysia telah mengisytiharkan 20 Oktober sebagai Hari Statistik Negara (MyStats Day), dengan tema 'Statistik Nadi Kehidupan'. Sementara itu, Hari Statistik Dunia Keempat akan disambut pada 20 Oktober 2025 dengan tema '*Driving Change with Quality Statistics and Data for Everyone*'.

OpenDOSM NextGen adalah medium yang menyediakan katalog data dan visualisasi bagi memudahkan pengguna menganalisis pelbagai data dan boleh diakses melalui portal <https://open.dosm.gov.my>.

Announcement

ASEAN-Malaysia 2025 Chairmanship: The Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) will chair the 15th ASEAN Community Statistical System Committee (ACSS15) which aims to strengthen the statistical cooperation towards sustainable regional development.

Malaysia, for the first time, ranked as number one (1) globally in the biennial Open Data Inventory (ODIN) 2024/25 report released by Open Data Watch (ODW), surpassing 198 other countries. This achievement marks a significant leap from its 67th position in the ODIN 2022/23 assessment.

The Government of Malaysia has declared October 20th as National Statistics Day (MyStats Day), with the theme 'Statistics is the Essence of Life.' Meanwhile, the Fourth World Statistics Day will be celebrated on 20th October 2025, with the theme 'Driving Change with Quality Statistics and Data for Everyone'.

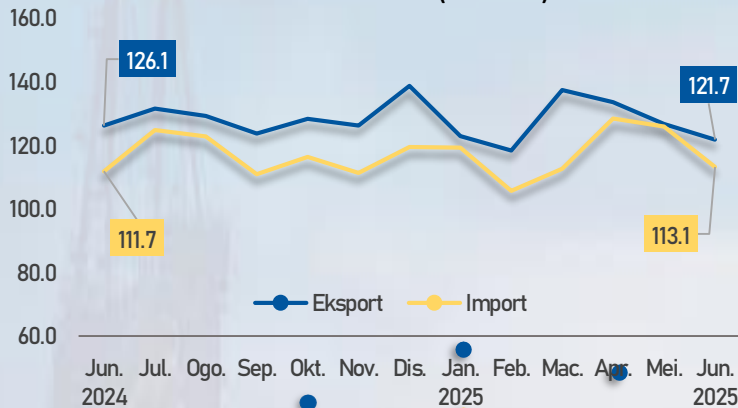

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PRESTASI PERDAGANGAN LUAR NEGERI MALAYSIA, JUN 2025

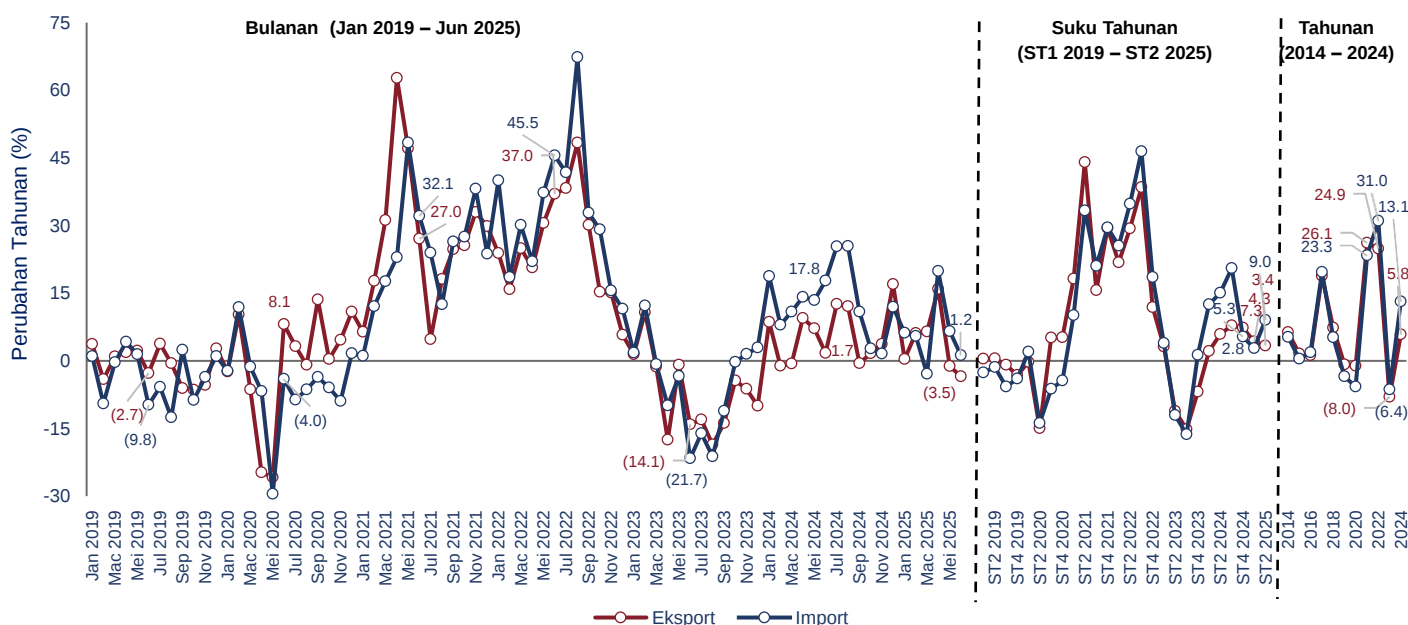
Prestasi dagangan Malaysia menyusut sedikit pada Jun 2025, sejajar dengan penurunan dalam eksport (-3.5%) dan imbalan dagangan (-40.1%) tahun ke tahun. Jumlah dagangan susut RM3.0 bilion atau 1.2 peratus, kepada RM234.9 bilion. Walau bagaimanapun, import mencatatkan peningkatan RM1.4 bilion (+1.2%) berbanding tempoh yang sama pada tahun sebelumnya.

Perbandingan secara bulanan menunjukkan eksport, import dan jumlah dagangan masing-masing menurun 3.9 peratus, 10.1 peratus dan 7.0 peratus. Sementara itu, lebih dagangan melonjak 1,030.7%, daripada RM0.8 bilion kepada RM8.6 bilion.

Bagi suku tahun kedua (ST2) 2025, jumlah dagangan, eksport dan import masing-masing mencatatkan perkembangan berbanding ST2 2024 dengan 6.1 peratus, 3.4 peratus dan 9.0 peratus. Pada masa yang sama, lebih dagangan mencatatkan penyusutan 55.3 peratus.

Eksport, import dan jumlah dagangan bagi separuh pertama tahun 2025 masing-masing meningkat 3.8 peratus, 5.9 peratus dan 4.8 peratus berbanding tempoh yang sama pada tahun sebelumnya. Sementara itu, lebih dagangan jatuh 17.2 peratus.

Prestasi eksport Malaysia mencatatkan penurunan kepada RM121.7 bilion, susut 3.5 peratus pada Jun 2025

Prestasi Eksport

Eksport Malaysia menurun 3.5 peratus pada Jun 2025, susut daripada RM126.1 bilion pada Jun 2024 kepada RM121.7 bilion.

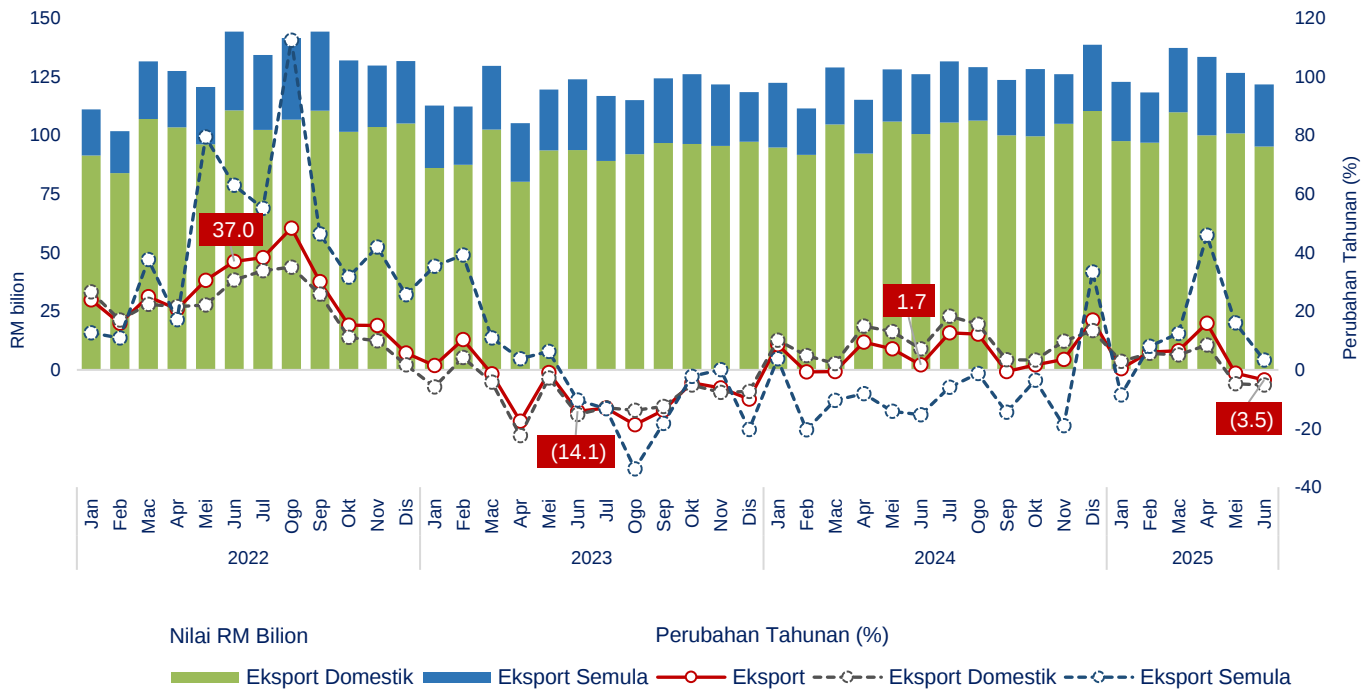
Penurunan ini sejajar dengan penguncupan 5.2 peratus dalam eksport domestik kepada RM95.3 bilion daripada RM100.5 bilion, yang

merangkumi 78.3 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan eksport. Namun begitu, eksport semula menyumbang 21.7 peratus daripada jumlah eksport, meningkat 3.4 peratus kepada RM26.4 bilion.

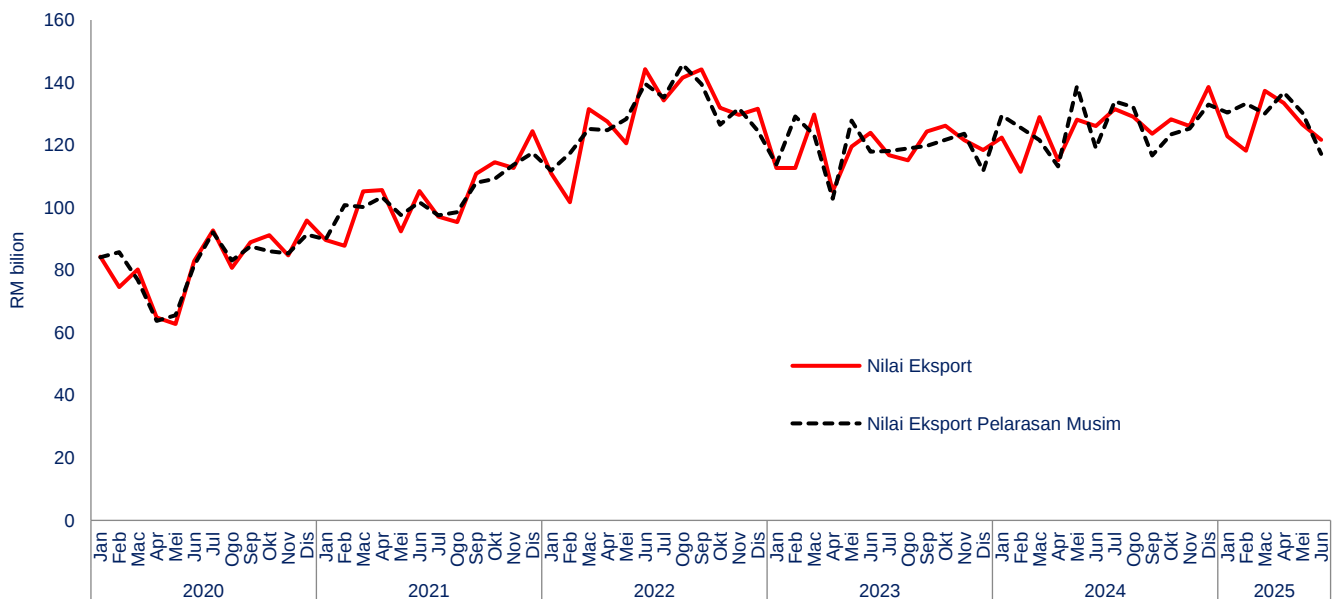
Selain itu, perbandingan bulanan menunjukkan eksport berkurang 3.9 peratus atau RM4.9 bilion. Analisis terma pelarasan musim

bulan ke bulan, eksport mencatatkan penurunan 10.2 peratus kepada RM117.1 bilion.

Prestasi Eksport mengikut Negara Destinasi Utama

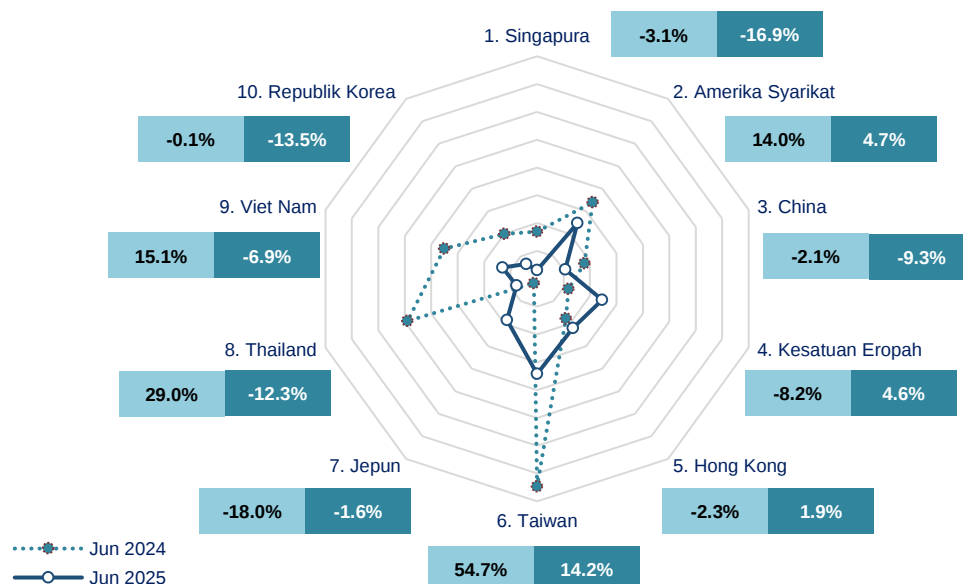
Singapura dan Amerika Syarikat merupakan negara destinasi utama dengan sumbangan 27.3 peratus kepada jumlah eksport Malaysia pada Jun 2025.

Singapura terus mendominasi sebagai negara destinasi utama dengan sumbangan 13.9 peratus kepada jumlah eksport. Eksport ke Singapura bernilai RM17.0 bilion, susut 16.9 peratus atau RM3.5 bilion berbanding tahun sebelumnya. Penurunan ini disebabkan oleh eksport yang lebih rendah bagi barangan elektrik dan elektronik (-RM1.9 bilion, -18.6%) serta keluaran petroleum (-RM1.6 bilion, -47.8%).

Sementara itu, nilai eksport ke Amerika Syarikat yang merangkumi 13.4 peratus daripada jumlah eksport mencatatkan RM16.3 bilion, naik RM731.6 juta atau 4.7 peratus. Peningkatan ini disokong oleh eksport yang lebih tinggi bagi barangan elektrik & elektronik (+RM671.2 juta, +7.3%) dan makanan yang diproses (+RM134.5 juta, +65.3%).

Daripada sepuluh negara utama destinasi eksport, eksport mencatatkan pertumbuhan negatif ke Singapura, China, Jepun, Thailand, Viet Nam dan Republik Korea. Manakala, Amerika Syarikat, Kesatuan Eropah, Hong Kong dan Taiwan mencatatkan peningkatan pada Jun 2025.

Eksport ke Negara ASEAN

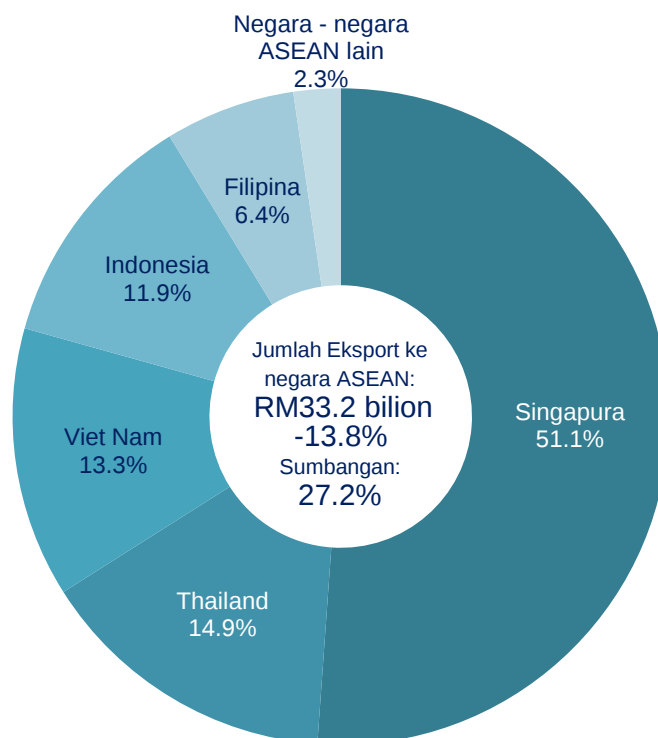
Eksport Malaysia ke negara-negara ASEAN menyumbang 27.2 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan eksport, bernilai RM33.2 bilion, mencatatkan penurunan 13.8 peratus.

Penurunan ini dipengaruhi terutamanya oleh eksport yang lebih rendah bagi barangan elektrik dan elektronik (-RM1.8 bilion, -13.1%), diikuti oleh keluaran petroleum (-RM1.6 bilion,

-24.0%) dan petroleum mentah (-RM929.2 juta, -61.4%).

Singapura mendahului kalangan negara anggota ASEAN dalam eksport keseluruhan, menyumbang 51.1 peratus dengan nilai RM17.0 bilion, jatuh 16.9 peratus berbanding pada tahun sebelumnya.

Prestasi Eksport mengikut Sektor Ekonomi

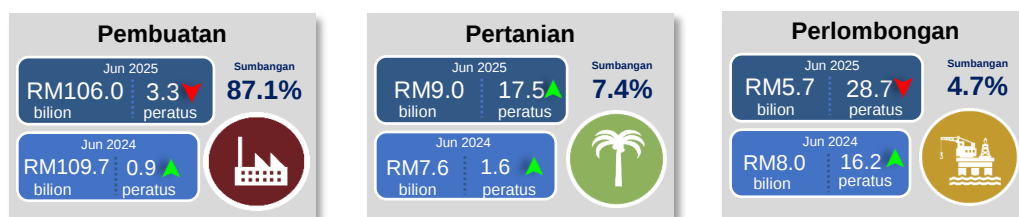
Eksport barangan perkilangan mencatatkan penurunan 3.3 peratus (-RM3.7 bilion), merangkumi 87.1 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan eksport. Punca utama kepada pertumbuhan negatif ini adalah bagi keluaran petroleum (-RM3.3 bilion, -28.1%), kimia & bahan kimia (-RM853.7 juta, -14.8%), serta produk besi & keluli (-RM550.8 juta, -21.6%).

Eksport barangan perlombongan, yang menyumbang 4.7 peratus daripada jumlah eksport, turun 28.7 peratus kepada RM5.7 bilion. Penurunan ini disebabkan oleh eksport yang lebih rendah bagi gas asli cecair

(-RM1.2 bilion, -26.5%), petroleum mentah (-RM899.7 juta, -42.7%), dan timah (-RM62.6 juta, -29.3%).

Eksport barangan pertanian naik 17.5 peratus kepada RM9.0 bilion, merangkumi 7.4 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan eksport. Peningkatan ini sejajar dengan pertumbuhan eksport minyak kelapa sawit & hasil keluaran berasaskan kelapa sawit (+RM1.4 bilion, +24.7%), keluaran pertanian yang lain (+RM79.6 juta, +8.5%), serta makanan laut, segar, sejuk atau beku (+RM22.3 juta, +12.9%).

Eksport mengikut Produk Utama Terpilih

Prestasi eksport menurun pada Jun 2025 disebabkan oleh pengurangan dalam produk-produk berikut:

- Keluaran petroleum bertapis merangkumi 6.4 peratus daripada jumlah eksport menurun 27.9 peratus atau RM3.0 bilion kepada RM7.8 bilion;
- Gas asli cecair menyumbang 2.8 peratus daripada jumlah eksport, menurun RM1.2 bilion atau 26.5 peratus kepada RM3.4 bilion. Selain itu, volum eksport dan nilai purata seunit masing-masing susut 12.5 peratus dan 16.0 peratus.;
- Petroleum mentah merangkumi 1.0 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan eksport, merosot RM899.7 juta atau 42.7 peratus kepada RM1.2 bilion, meskipun mencatatkan penurunan dalam volum eksport (-20.4%) dan nilai purata seunit (-28.1%), selari dengan kejatuhan harga minyak mentah Brent kepada RM303.2 setong;
- Kayu & hasil keluaran kayu menurun 6.8 peratus atau RM117.6 juta kepada RM1.6 bilion, merangkumi 1.3 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan eksport; dan
- Getah asli menyumbang 0.2 peratus daripada jumlah eksport, jatuh 22.1 peratus atau RM69.9 juta kepada RM246.4 juta. Penurunan ini sejajar dengan pengurangan dalam volum eksport (-25.3%) dan harga getah SMR20 (-14.1%). Sementara itu, nilai purata seunit meningkat 4.3 peratus.

Namun begitu, peningkatan dicatatkan dalam produk-produk berikut:

- Minyak sawit & keluaran pertanian berasaskan minyak sawit, merangkumi 8.1 peratus daripada jumlah eksport, meningkat 18.4 peratus atau RM1.5 bilion selaras dengan peningkatan eksport minyak sawit. Komoditi utama dalam kumpulan produk ini naik RM1.1 bilion atau 24.2 peratus, sejajar dengan peningkatan dalam volum eksport (+28.7%) dan harga minyak sawit tempatan 0.3 peratus (RM3,969.0 bagi satu tan metrik). Manakala, nilai purata seunit mencatatkan kejatuhan 3.5 peratus; dan
- Barangan elektrik dan elektronik (E&E), yang merangkumi 44.3 peratus daripada jumlah eksport, meningkat 1.3 peratus, daripada RM53.3 bilion kepada RM54.0 bilion.

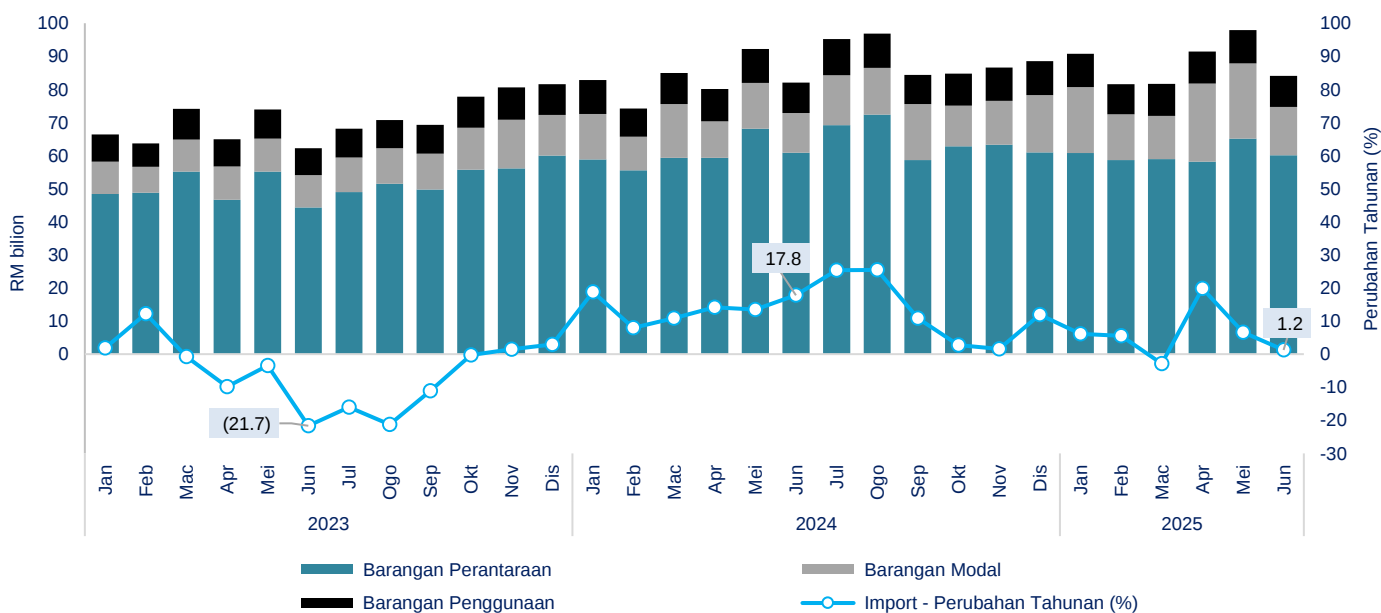
Import merekodkan peningkatan 1.2 peratus kepada RM113.1 bilion, mengatasi pertumbuhan eksport

Prestasi Import

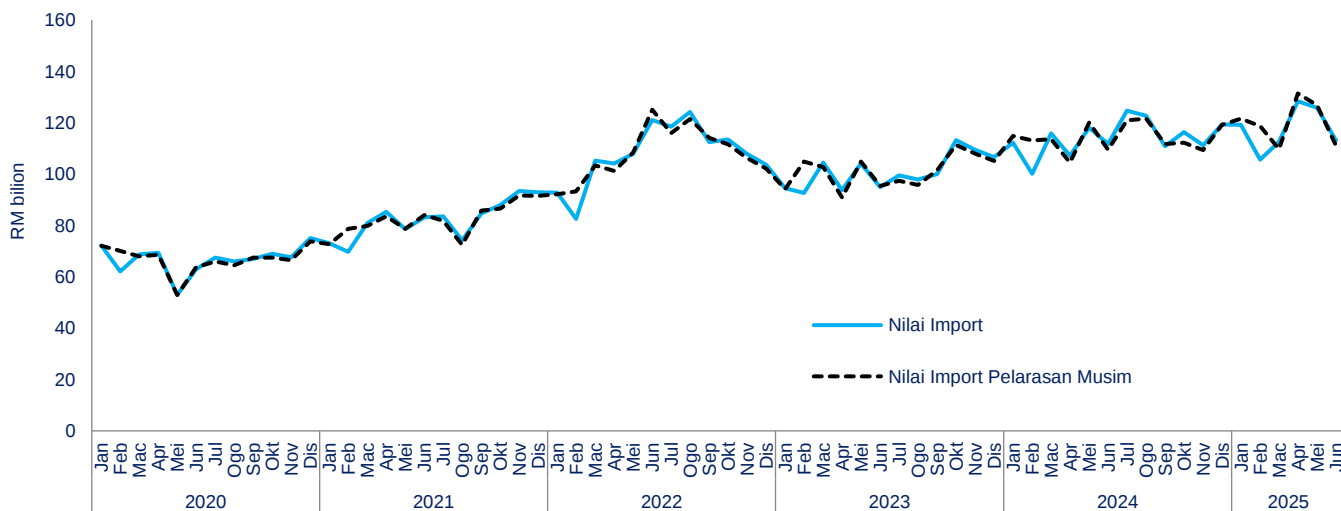
Nilai import Malaysia meningkat 1.2 peratus atau RM1.4 bilion kepada RM113.1 bilion pada Jun 2025. Namun, secara bulanan, import susut 10.1 peratus atau RM12.7 bilion. Berdasarkan analisis terma pelarasan musim bulan ke bulan, import mencatatkan penurunan 12.3 peratus kepada RM111.1 bilion.

Import mengikut Penggunaan Akhir mencatatkan peningkatan tahun ke tahun, dengan kenaikan dalam barangan modal (+21.8%) dan barangan penggunaan (+1.6%), manakala barangan perantaraan menurun 1.2 peratus.

Prestasi Import mengikut Negara Asal Utama

China dan Singapura merupakan dua negara utama asal import Malaysia pada Jun 2025 menyumbang 35.1 peratus daripada jumlah import.

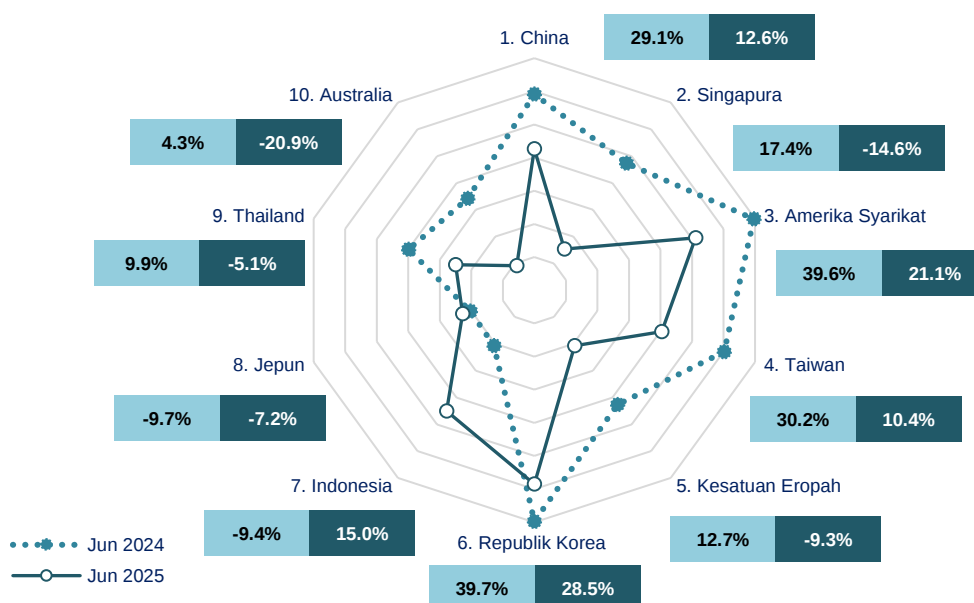
Import Malaysia dari China meningkat 12.6 peratus kepada RM27.8 bilion, merangkumi 24.6 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan import. Peningkatan ini didorong oleh keluaran petroleum yang mencatatkan lonjakan 95.4 peratus (+RM833.0 juta), diikuti oleh barangan keluaran lain (+RM454.8 juta, +66.1%) dan jentera, kelengkapan & peralatan (+RM435.1 juta, +14.6%).

Import dari Singapura bernilai RM11.8 bilion, merangkumi 10.4 peratus daripada jumlah

import Malaysia, jatuh 14.6 peratus atau RM2.0 bilion berbanding tahun sebelumnya. Penyusutan ini didorong terutamanya oleh penurunan import keluaran petroleum (-RM1.7 bilion, -41.8%) dan kimia & bahan kimia (-RM229.7 juta, -20.4%).

Import dari 10 negara asal utama menunjukkan peningkatan dari China, Amerika Syarikat, Taiwan, Republik Korea dan Indonesia. Namun begitu, penurunan dicatatkan bagi Singapura, Kesatuan Eropah, Jepun, Thailand dan Australia berbanding tempoh yang sama pada tahun lalu.

Carta 8: Perubahan Tahunan Import bagi Negara Asal Utama, Jun 2024 dan Jun 2025

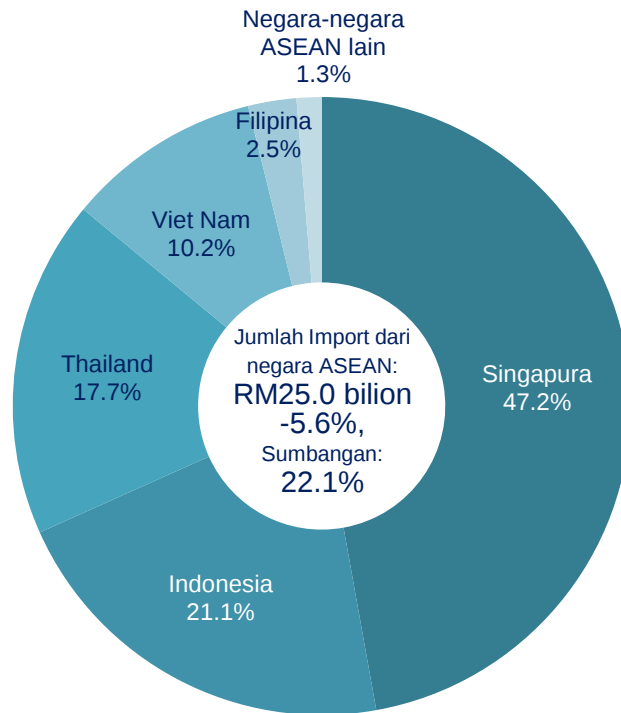


Import dari Negara ASEAN

Import dari negara-negara ASEAN menurun 5.6 peratus pada Jun 2025, mencecah RM25.0 bilion. Ia merangkumi 22.1 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan import Malaysia. Penurunan ini didorong oleh pengurangan import keluaran petroleum (-RM2.1 bilion, -41.6%), kimia & bahan kimia (-RM530.3 juta, -25.4%) serta kelengkapan pengangkutan (-RM277.3 juta, -28.9%).

Import dari Singapura kekal sebagai yang tertinggi dalam kalangan negara ASEAN, walaupun mencatatkan penurunan 14.6 peratus (-RM2.0 bilion) berbanding tahun sebelumnya, menyumbang 47.2 peratus daripada jumlah import ASEAN.

Prestasi Import mengikut Sektor Ekonomi

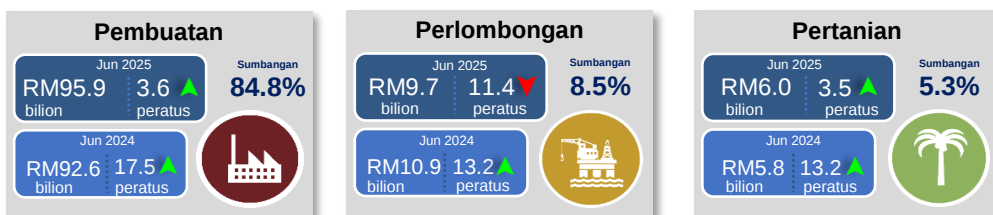
Barangan pembuatan, yang merangkumi 84.8 peratus daripada jumlah import, naik 3.6 peratus dari RM92.6 bilion kepada RM95.9 bilion, tahun ke tahun. Prestasi ini didorong oleh peningkatan import barangan elektrik & elektronik (+RM3.8 bilion, +10.5%); jentera, kelengkapan & peralatan (+RM1.4 bilion, +15.3%); serta barangan pembuatan lain (+RM820.9 juta, +37.4%).

Import barangan pertanian (5.3% daripada jumlah import) meningkat 3.5 peratus (+RM198.9 juta) tahun ke tahun kepada RM6.0 bilion, didorong oleh peningkatan import minyak sawit & keluaran

pertanian berasaskan minyak sawit (+RM147.4 juta, +42.7%), makanan laut, segar, sejuk atau beku (+RM75.4 juta, +25.9%) dan minyak sayuran lain (+RM21.4 juta, +5.3%).

Namun begitu, import barangan perlombongan berjumlah RM9.7 bilion, susut 11.4 peratus berbanding tahun sebelumnya dan menyumbang 8.5 peratus daripada keseluruhan import Malaysia. Penurunan ini didorong oleh pengurangan import petroleum mentah (-RM1.7 bilion, -27.8%) dan gas asli cecair (-RM505.6 juta, -43.6%).

Import mengikut Produk Utama Terpilih

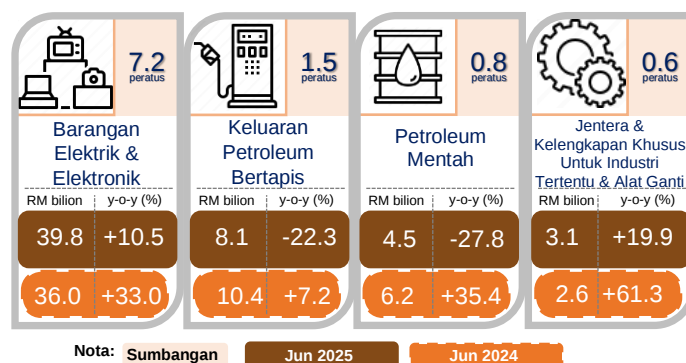
Import menunjukkan prestasi baik pada Jun 2025, dengan pertumbuhan positif dilihat dalam produk berikut:

- Barangan elektrik dan elektronik merangkumi 7.2 peratus daripada jumlah import dan meningkat 10.5 peratus atau RM3.8 bilion kepada RM39.8 bilion; dan
- Jentera & kelengkapan khas untuk industri tertentu serta alat ganti naik 19.9 peratus atau RM507.8 juta kepada RM3.1 bilion, menyumbang 0.6 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan import.

Walaupun bagaimanapun, pertumbuhan negatif direkodkan bagi produk berikut:

- Keluaran petroleum bertapis menyumbang 1.5 peratus daripada jumlah import, meningkat RM2.3 bilion atau 22.3 peratus kepada RM8.1 bilion selari dengan penurunan nilai purata seunit 23.6 peratus. Manakala, volum import meningkat 1.7 peratus; dan
- Import petroleum mentah, yang menyumbang 0.8 peratus daripada jumlah import, susut RM1.7 bilion atau 27.8 peratus kepada RM4.5 bilion. Penurunan ini sejajar dengan penurunan dalam nilai purata seunit (-27.1%), volum import (-0.9%) serta kejatuhan harga minyak Brent 22.0 peratus kepada RM303.2 setong.

Import mengikut Klasifikasi Penggunaan Akhir & Kategori Ekonomi Umum

Jumlah import pada Jun 2025 bernilai RM113.1 bilion, mencatatkan kenaikan 1.2 peratus berbanding tahun sebelumnya. Tiga kategori utama import mengikut Penggunaan Akhir, yang merangkumi 74.4 peratus daripada jumlah import, ialah;

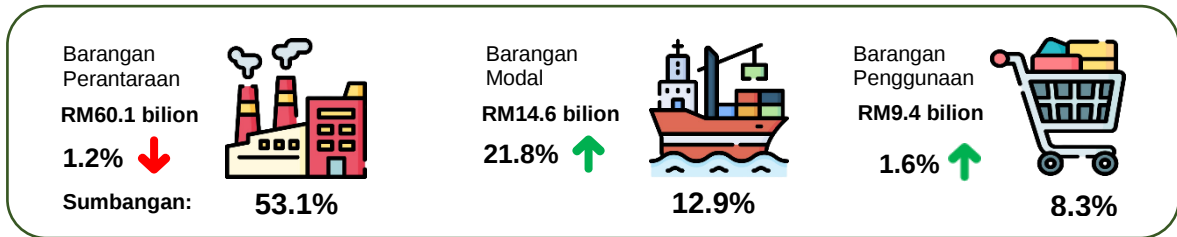
Barangan perantaraan, menyumbang RM60.1 bilion atau 53.1 peratus daripada jumlah import, jatuh 1.2 peratus. Kejatuhan ini disebabkan oleh pengurangan import bahan api & pelincir, utama (-RM2.0 bilion, -24.8%), bekalan perindustrian, diproses (-RM1.5 bilion, -7.1%), dan bahan api & pelincir, diproses, lain-lain (-RM1.1 bilion, -32.1%).

Barangan modal, meningkat 21.8 peratus kepada RM14.6 bilion (12.9 peratus daripada

jumlah import), didorong oleh peningkatan import barangan modal (kecuali alat kelengkapan pengangkutan) 25.6 peratus kepada RM13.7 bilion.

Barangan penggunaan, meningkat 1.6 peratus kepada RM9.4 bilion (8.3 peratus daripada jumlah import), disebabkan oleh peningkatan import barangan tahan lama (+RM268.0 juta, +18.0%).

EKSPORT DAN IMPORT MENGIKUT LOKASI

Malaysia mencatatkan jumlah perdagangan bernilai RM234.9 bilion pada Jun 2025 dengan eksport dan import masing-masing bernilai RM121.7 bilion dan RM113.1 bilion.

Eksport bernilai RM121.7 bilion pada Jun 2025, menurun sebanyak RM4.4 bilion (-3.5%) berbanding bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Penurunan eksport dipengaruhi oleh eksport yang lebih rendah di kebanyakan negeri iaitu Johor (-RM3.3 bilion), Sarawak (-RM1.8 bilion), Kedah (-RM1.6 bilion), Selangor (-RM1.2 bilion), Terengganu (-RM743.0 juta), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (-RM491.4 juta), Pahang (-RM312.9 juta), W.P. Labuan (-RM277.3 juta), Perak (-RM209.0 juta) dan Negeri Sembilan (-RM54.7 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai eksport meningkat di Pulau Pinang sebanyak RM4.9 bilion, Sabah (+RM414.3 juta), Melaka (+RM372.0 juta), Kelantan (+RM69.5 juta) dan Perlis (+RM2.9 juta).

Pulau Pinang kekal sebagai pengeksport utama dengan sumbangan 39.5 peratus, diikuti oleh

Johor (18.6%), Selangor (16.9%), Sarawak (5.3%) dan W.P. Kuala Lumpur (4.0%).

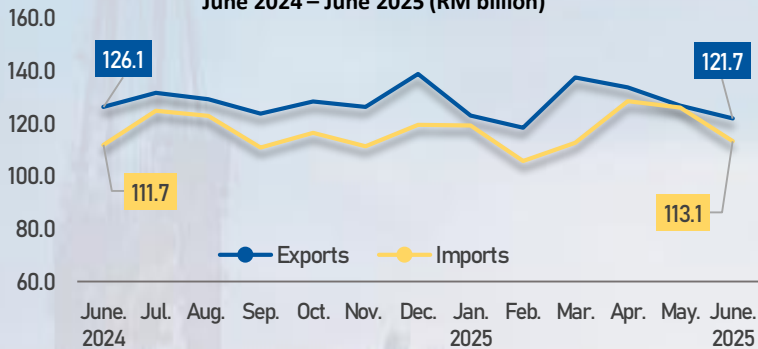
Sebaliknya, import pada bulan Jun 2025 meningkat RM1.4 bilion (+1.2%) berbanding bulan yang sama pada tahun 2024. Walau bagaimanapun, nilai import menurun di Negeri Sembilan sebanyak RM1.3 bilion, Kedah (-RM980.0 juta), Melaka (-RM954.9 juta), Selangor (-RM903.4 juta), Pahang (-RM753.3 juta), Terengganu (-RM246.7 juta), Perlis (-RM87.2 juta) dan Sarawak (-RM16.9 juta).

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MALAYSIA'S EXTERNAL TRADE PERFORMANCE, JUNE 2025

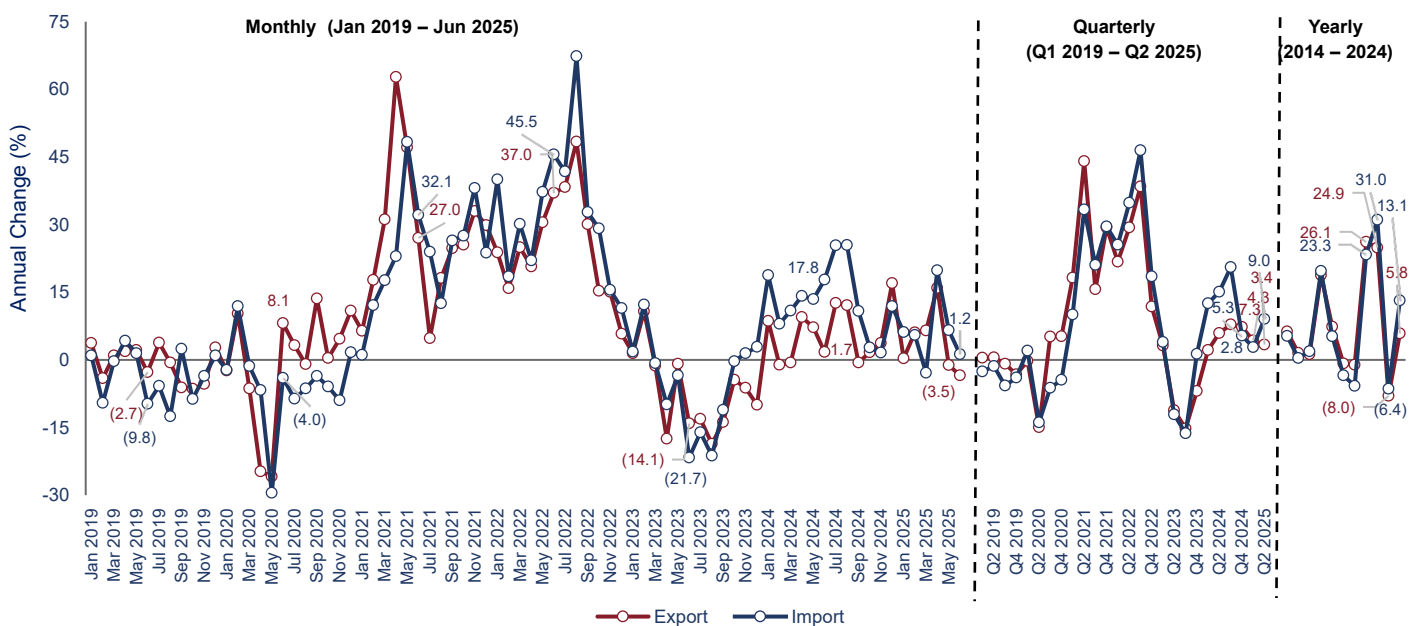
Malaysia's trade performance slightly decreased in June 2025, consistent with the decline in exports (-3.5%) and trade balance (-40.1%), year-on-year (y-o-y). Total trade downed by RM3.0 billion or 1.2 per cent, y-o-y, reached RM234.9 billion. Nevertheless, import experienced an increase of RM1.4 billion (+1.2%) as compared to the same period in the previous year.

The monthly comparison shows that exports, imports and total trade declined by 3.9 per cent, 10.1 per cent and 7.0 per cent, respectively. While, trade surplus surged by 1,030.7% from RM0.8 billion to RM8.6 billion.

For the second quarter (Q2) 2025, total trade, exports and imports recorded an expansion as compared to Q2 2024 by 6.1 per cent, 3.4 per cent and 9.0 per cent, respectively. At the same time, trade surplus recorded a contraction of 55.3 per cent.

Exports, imports and total trade for first half of 2025 rose by 3.8 per cent, 5.9 per cent and 4.8 per cent, respectively, as compared to the same period of preceding year. Meanwhile, trade surplus declined by 17.2 per cent.

EXPORTS

Malaysia's export performance in June 2025 registered a decrease to RM121.7 billion downed by 3.5 per cent

Performance of Exports

Malaysia's exports decreased by 3.5 per cent in June 2025, down from RM126.1 billion in June 2024 to RM121.7 billion.

This negative growth mirrors the 5.2 per cent decrease in domestic exports to RM95.3 billion

from RM100.5 billion, accounting for 78.3 per cent of overall exports. However, re-exports accounted for 21.7 per cent of total exports, up by 3.4 per cent to RM26.4 billion.

Moreover, a monthly comparison showed that exports reduced by 3.9 per cent or RM4.9 billion. With regards to analysis of the seasonally adjusted terms month-on-month

(m-o-m), exports decreased by 10.2 per cent to RM117.1 billion.

Chart 2: Domestic Exports, Re-Exports (RM billion) and Annual Change (%)

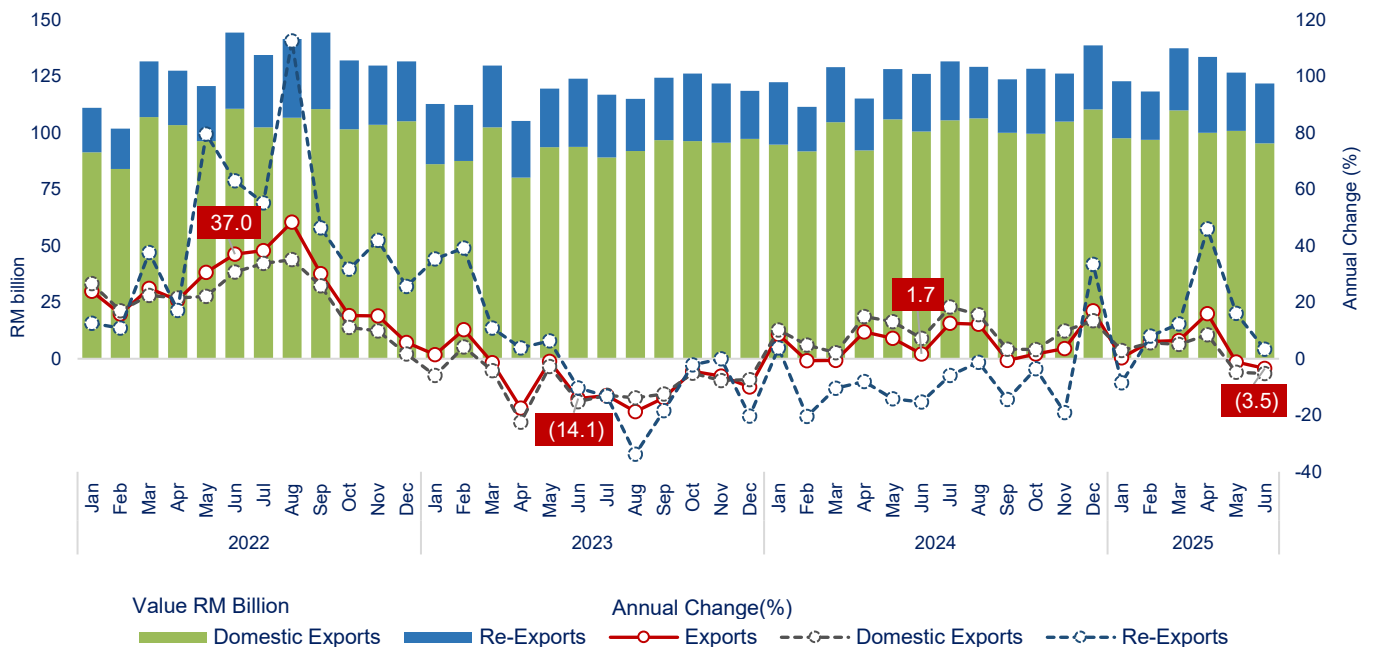
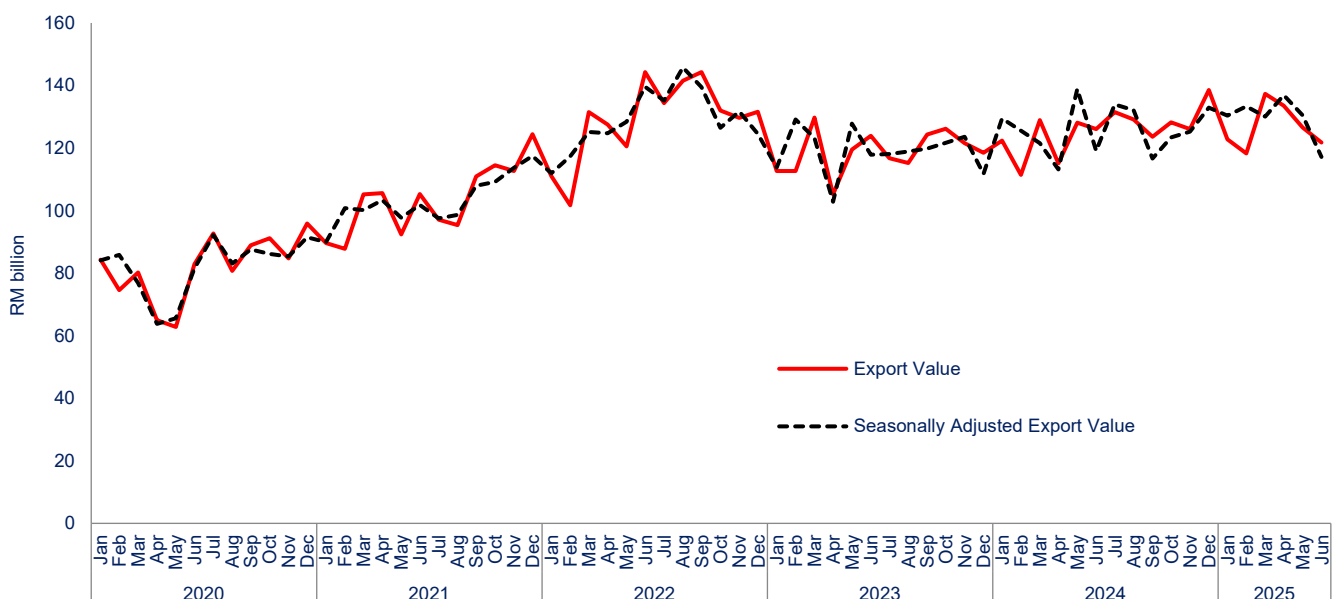


Chart 3: Actual Export Value and Seasonally Adjusted Export Value, RM billion



Export Performance for Major Country of Destination

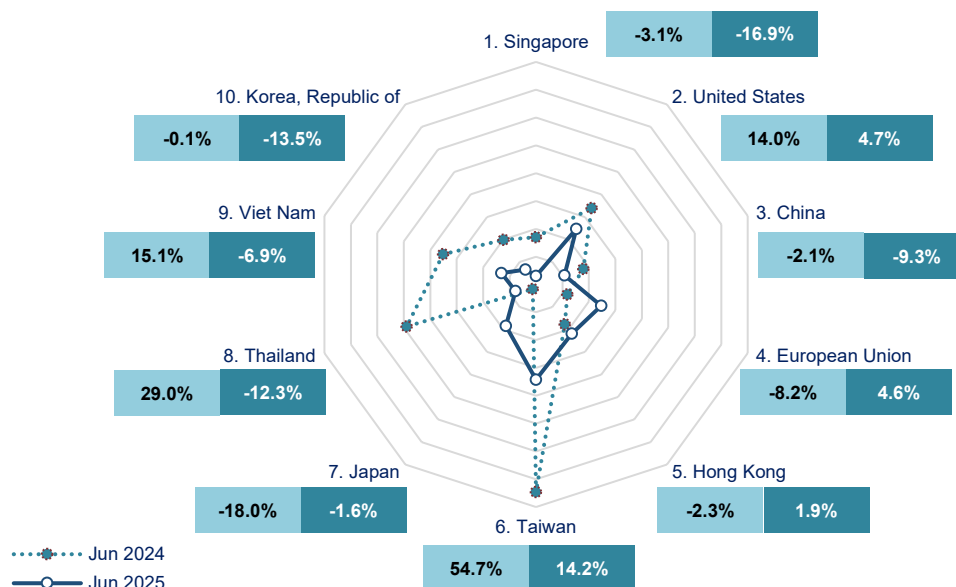
Singapore and the United States were the main destination countries with a contribution of 27.3 per cent to Malaysia's total exports in June 2025.

Singapore dominated the main destination country with a contribution of 13.9 per cent to total exports. Exports to Singapore was valued at RM17.0 billion, downed by 16.9 per cent or RM3.5 billion, y-o-y. The decline was attributable from slower exports of E&E products (-RM1.9 billion, -18.6%) and petroleum products (-RM1.6 billion, -47.8%).

Meanwhile, the value of exports to the United States which constituted 13.4 per cent of total exports worth RM16.3 billion, up by RM731.6 million or 4.7 per cent. The increase was supported by higher exports of E&E products (+RM671.2 million, +7.3%) and processed food (+RM134.5 million, +65.3%).

Out of ten major countries of destination, exports grew negatively to Singapore, China, Japan, Thailand, Viet Nam and Republic of Korea. While, the United States, the European Union, Hong Kong and Taiwan grew positively in June 2025.

Exports to ASEAN Countries

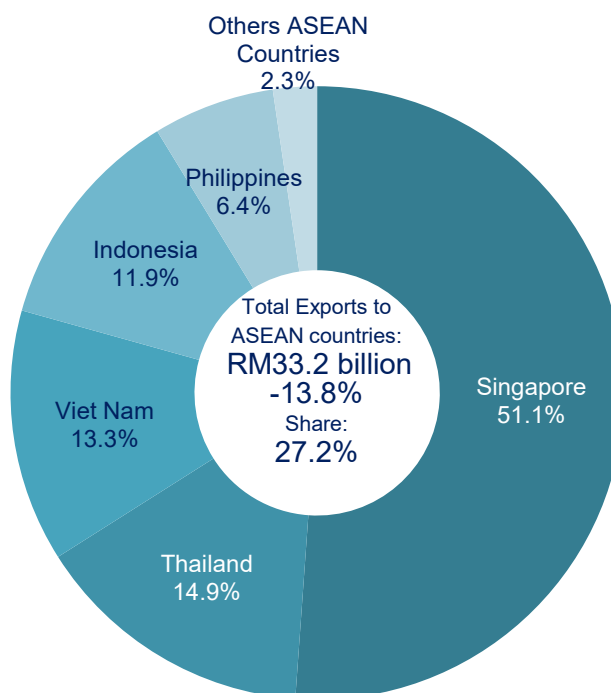
Malaysia's exports to ASEAN countries accounted for 27.2 per cent of overall exports, amounting RM33.2 billion, declined by 13.8 per cent.

The decrease was mainly impacted by the slower exports of E&E products (-RM1.8 billion, -13.1%), followed by petroleum

products (-RM1.6 billion, -24.0%) and crude petroleum (-RM929.2 million, -61.4%).

Singapore topped the ASEAN member states in overall exports, accounting 51.1 per cent, with a value of RM17.0 billion with 16.9 per cent decrease from the previous year.

Export Performance for Economic Sectors

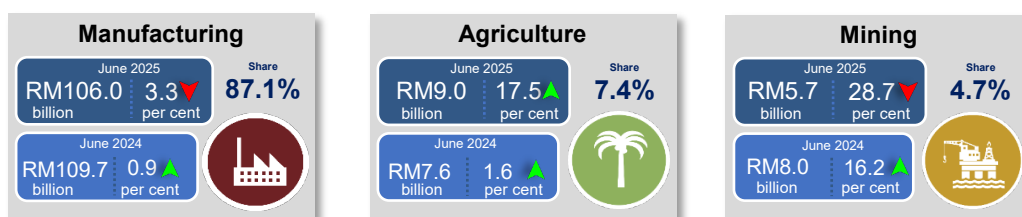
Manufactured goods exports registered a decreased by 3.3 per cent (-RM3.7 billion), accounting for 87.1 per cent of overall exports. The main causes of negative growth were petroleum products (-RM3.3 billion, -28.1%), chemical & chemical products (-RM853.7 million, -14.8%), and iron & steel products (-RM550.8 million, -21.6%).

Exports of mining products, which accounted for 4.7 per cent of total exports, fell by 28.7 per cent to RM5.7 billion, caused by lower

exports of liquefied natural gas (-RM1.2 billion, -26.5%), crude petroleum (-RM899.7 million, -42.7%), and tin (-RM62.6 million, -29.3%).

Exports of agricultural products increased by 17.5 per cent to RM9.0 billion, accounting for 7.4 per cent of overall exports. The increase was consistent with the growth in exports of palm oil & palm-based agriculture products (+RM1.4 billion, +24.7%), other agriculture (+RM79.6 million, +8.5%), and seafood, fresh, chilled or frozen (+RM22.3 million, +12.9%).

Exports of Selected Major Products

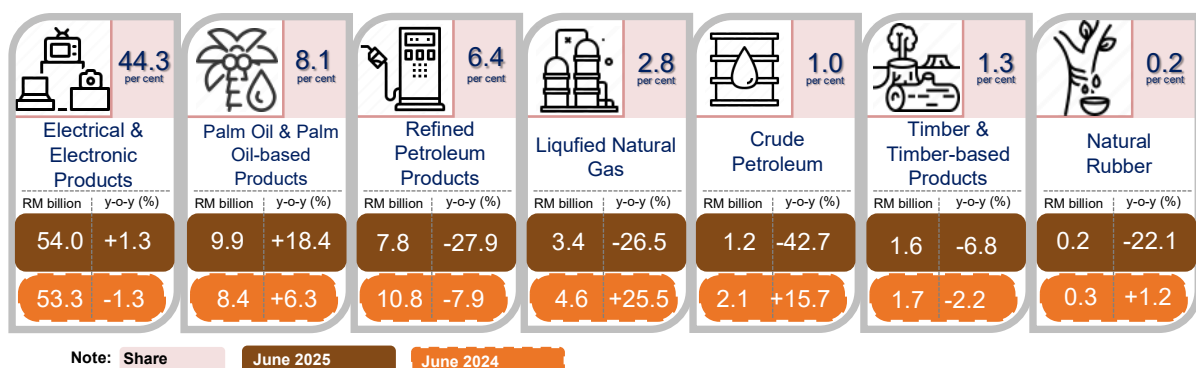
Export performance weakened in June 2025, driven by declines in the following products:

- Refined petroleum products, which accounted for 6.4 per cent of total exports, fell by 27.9 per cent or RM3.0 billion to RM7.8 billion; (-28.1%) in line with the decline in Brent oil price to RM303.2 per barrel;
- Liquefied natural gas accounted for 2.8 per cent of total exports, decline by RM1.2 billion or 26.5 per cent to RM3.4 billion. In addition, export volume and average unit value decreased by 12.5 per cent and 16.0 per cent, respectively;
- Crude petroleum, which accounted for 1.0 per cent of total exports, fell by RM899.7 million or 42.7 per cent, to RM1.2 billion despite a decrease in export volume (-20.4%) and average unit value
- Timber & timber-based products decreased by 6.8 per cent or RM117.6 million to RM1.6 billion, accounting for 1.3 per cent of total exports; and
- Natural rubber, which accounted for 0.2 per cent of total exports, decreased by 22.1 per cent or RM69.9 million to RM246.4 million. This was consistent with the decrease in export volume (-25.3%) and SMR20 rubber price (-14.1%). Meanwhile, average unit value up by 4.3 per cent.

Nonetheless, the following products recorded an improvements:

- Palm oil and palm-based agriculture products accounted for 8.1 per cent of total exports, increasing by 18.4 per cent or RM1.5 billion in line with the palm oil exports. The principal commodity in this product group, rose by RM1.1 billion, or 24.2 per cent, in accordance with the rose in export volume (+28.7%) and price of local palm oil by 0.3 per cent (RM3,969.0 per metric tonnes). Subsequently, the average unit value declined by 3.5 per cent; and
- Electrical & electronic products (E&E), accounting for 44.3 per cent of total exports, increased by 1.3 per cent, from RM53.3 billion to RM54.0 billion.

IMPORTS

Imports recorded a 1.2 per cent increase to RM113.1 billion, exceeding export growth

Performance of Imports

Malaysia's import value increased by 1.2 per cent, or RM1.4 billion to RM113.1 billion in June 2025. On a m-o-m basis, imports downed by 10.1 per cent or RM12.7 billion. According to the m-o-m seasonally adjusted terms analysis, imports decline 12.3 per cent to RM111.1 billion.

Imports by End Use increased, y-o-y, with an increase in capital goods (+21.8%) and consumption goods (+1.6%), whereas intermediate goods decreased by 1.2 per cent.

Chart 6: Imports Value (RM billion) and Annual Change (%)

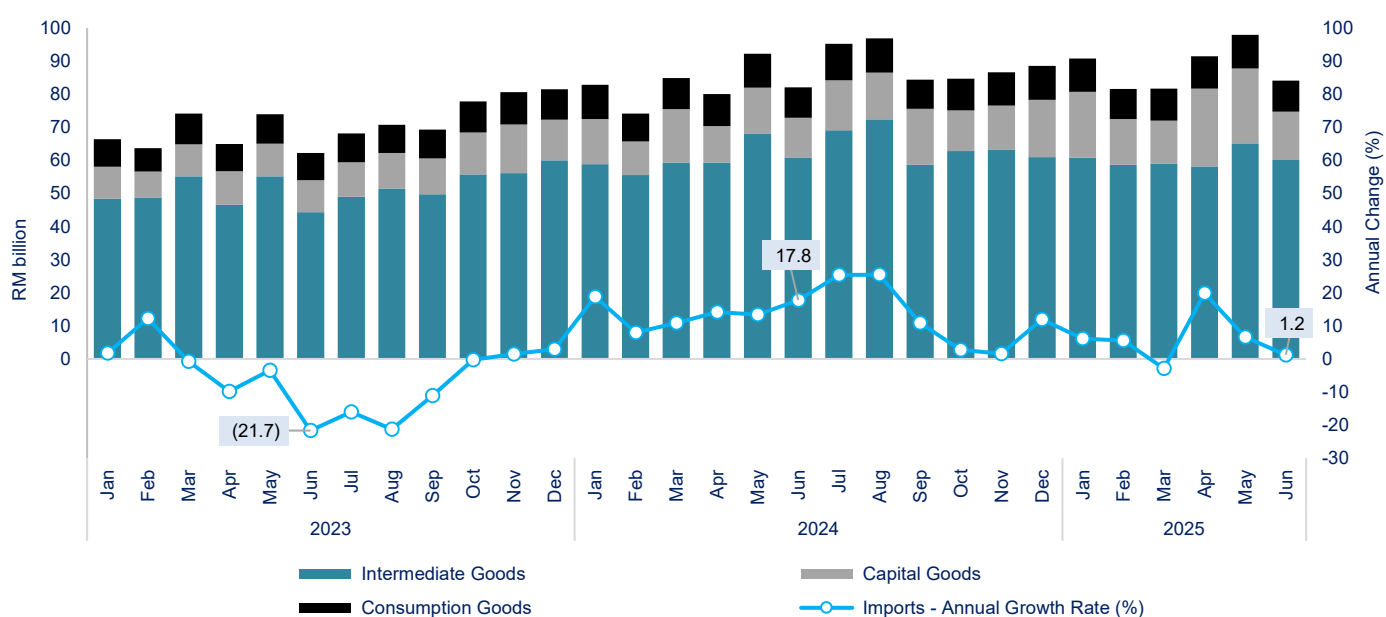
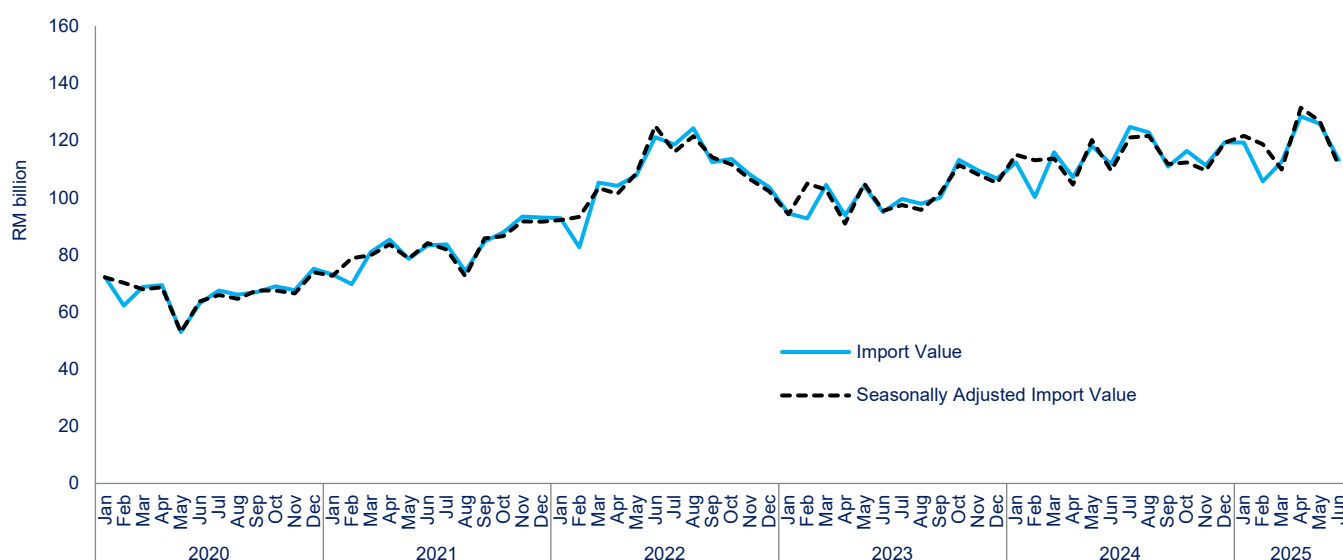


Chart 7: Actual Import Value and Seasonally Adjusted Imports Value, RM billion



Import Performance for Major Country of Origin

China and Singapore were Malaysia's two major country of origin in June 2025, accounting for 35.1 per cent of total imports.

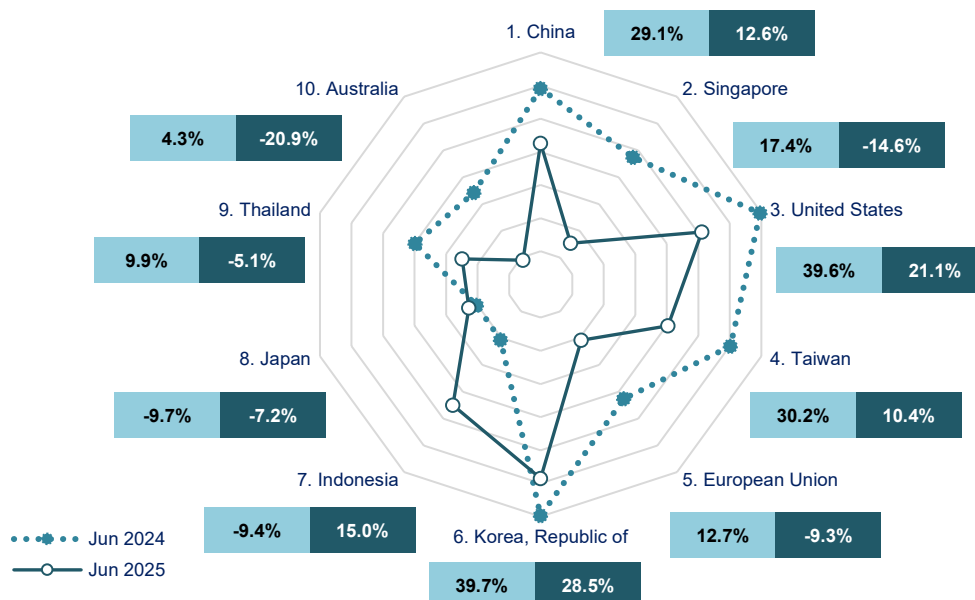
Malaysia's imports from China climbed by 12.6 per cent to RM27.8 billion, accounting for 24.6 per cent of total imports. This growth is driven by petroleum products which gained a 95.4 per cent increase (+RM833.0 billion), followed by other manufactures (+RM454.8 million, +66.1%) and machinery, equipment & parts (+RM435.1 million, +14.6%).

Imports from Singapore were worth RM11.8 billion, accounting for 10.4 per cent of Malaysia's

imports, downed by 14.6 per cent, or RM2.0 billion, y-o-y. This diminishment was primarily driven by slower imports of petroleum products (-RM1.7 billion, -41.8%) and chemical & chemical products (-RM229.7 million, -20.4%).

Imports from the top 10 countries of origin showed an increase from China, the United States, Taiwan, the Republic of Korea, and Indonesia. However, declines were recorded for Singapore, the European Union, Japan, Thailand, and Australia compared to the same period last year.

Chart 8: Annual Change for Imports for Major Country of Origin, June 2024 and June 2025



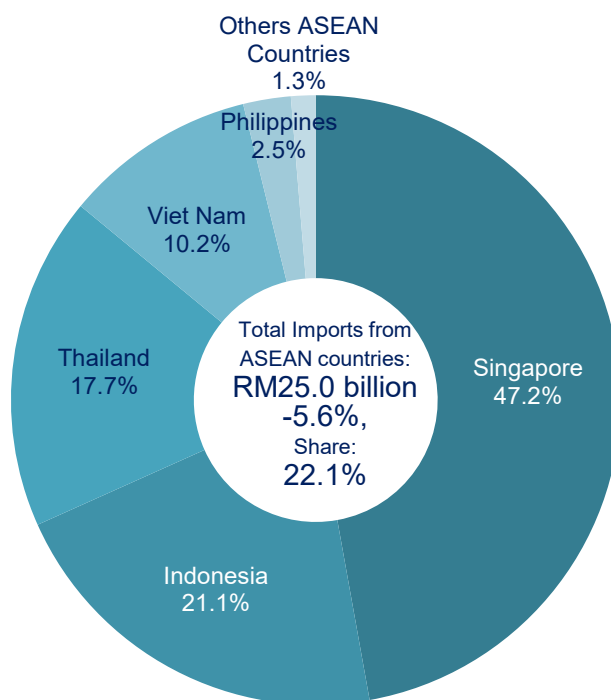
Imports from ASEAN Countries

Imports from ASEAN countries fell by 5.6 per cent in June 2025, reaching RM25.0 billion. It accounted for 22.1 per cent of Malaysia's overall imports. This is driven from slower imports of petroleum products (-RM2.1 billion, -41.6%), chemical & chemical products (-RM530.3 million, -25.4%) and

transport equipment (-RM277.3 million, -28.9%).

Imports from Singapore remained the largest among ASEAN countries, despite recording a decline of 14.6 per cent (-RM2.0 billion) compared to the previous year, contributing 47.2 per cent to total ASEAN imports.

Import Performance for Economic Sectors

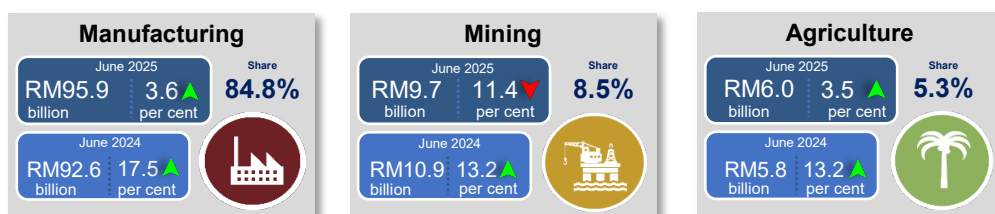
Manufactured goods, accounting for 84.8 per cent of overall imports, grew by 3.6 per cent from RM92.6 billion to RM95.9 billion, y-o-y. This performance was driven by increased imports of E&E products (+RM3.8 billion, +10.5%); machinery, equipment & parts (+RM1.4 billion, +15.3%); and other manufactures (+RM820.9 million, +37.4%).

Imports of agricultural products (5.3% of total imports) increased 3.5 per cent (+RM198.9 million), y-o-y, to RM6.0 billion, boosted by higher imports of palm oil & palm-based agriculture

products (+RM147.4 million, +42.7%), seafood, fresh, chilled or frozen (+RM75.4 million, +25.9%), and other vegetables oil (+RM21.4 million, +5.3%).

However, mining imports amounted to RM9.7 billion, down 11.4 per cent from the previous year and accounting for 8.5 per cent of Malaysia's overall imports. The decrease was attributed to lower imports of crude petroleum (-RM1.7 billion, -27.8%) and liquefied natural gas (LNG) (-RM505.6 million, -43.6%).

Imports of Selected Major Products

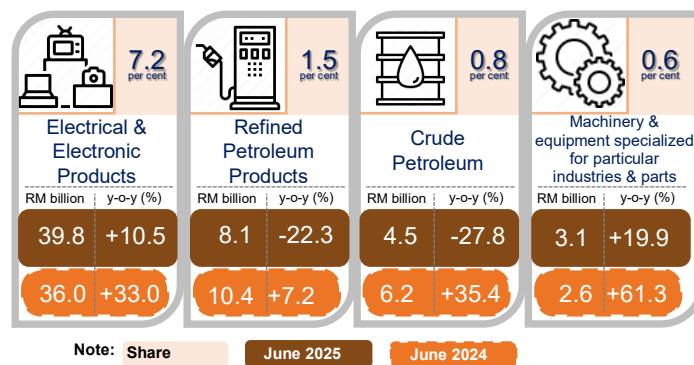
Imports performed well in June 2025, with positive growth in the following products:

- E&E products accounted for 7.2 per cent of total imports and grew by 10.5 per cent or RM3.8 billion to RM39.8 billion; and
- Machinery & equipment specific to certain industries & spare parts climbed by 19.9 per cent or RM507.8 million to RM3.1 billion, accounting for 0.6 per cent of total imports.

Meanwhile, negative growth was noted for the following products:

- Refined petroleum products accounted for 1.5 per cent of total imports, increasing by RM2.3 billion or 22.3 per cent to RM8.1 billion in line with the average unit value decreased by 23.6 per cent. While, import volume rose by 1.7 per cent; and
- Crude petroleum imports, accounting for 0.8 per cent of total imports, dropped by RM1.7 billion or 27.8 per cent to RM4.5 billion. This was in line with a decrease in average unit value (-27.1%), import volume (-0.9%) and a fall in Brent oil price by 22.0 per cent to RM303.2 per barrel.

Exhibit 4: Imports of Selected Major Product, June 2024 and June 2025



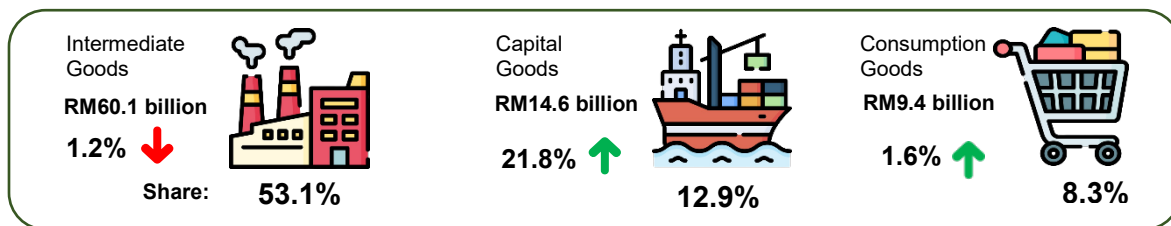
Imports for End Use & Broad Economic Categories (BEC) Classification

Total imports in June 2025 stood at RM113.1 billion, registering a year-on-year increase of 1.2 per cent. The three major categories of imports by End-use, which collectively accounted for 74.4 per cent of total imports, were:

Intermediate goods, accounting for RM60.1 billion or 53.1 per cent of total imports, decreased by 1.2 per cent. This was due to decrease in imports of fuel & lubricants, primary (-RM2.0 billion, -24.8%), industrial supplies, processed (-RM1.5 billion, -7.1%), and fuel & lubricants, processed, other (-RM1.1 billion, -32.1%).

Capital goods, climbed by 21.8 per cent to RM14.6 billion (12.9 per cent of total imports), with higher imports of capital goods (except transport equipment) up by 25.6 per cent reaching RM13.7 billion.

Consumption goods, increased by 1.6 per cent to RM9.4 billion (8.3 per cent of total imports), due to higher imports of durables goods (+RM268.0 million, +18.0 %).

Malaysia's total trade for June 2025 amounted to RM234.9 billion with exports and imports recorded RM121.7 billion and RM113.1 billion, respectively.

Exports was valued at RM121.7 billion in June 2025, decreased RM4.4 billion (-3.5%) as compared to the same month of the previous year. The decrease in exports was attributed to the lower exports in most states such as Johor (-RM3.3 billion), Sarawak (-RM1.8 billion), Kedah (-RM1.6 billion), Selangor (-RM1.2 billion), Terengganu (-RM743.0 million), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (-RM491.4 million), Pahang (-RM312.9 million), W.P. Labuan (-RM277.3 million), Perak (-RM209.0 million) and Negeri Sembilan (-RM54.7 million). However, exports increased in Pulau Pinang by RM4.9 billion, Sabah (+RM414.3 million), Melaka (+RM372.0 million), Kelantan (+RM69.5 million) and Perlis (+RM2.9 million).

Pulau Pinang remained as the top exporter with a contribution of 39.5 per cent, followed by Johor

(18.6%), Selangor (16.9%), Sarawak (5.3%) and W.P. Kuala Lumpur (4.0%).

On the contrary, imports in June 2025 increased RM1.4 billion (+1.2%) as compared to the same month in year 2024. The increase in imports was attributed by the higher imports in Pulau Pinang (+RM3.4 billion), Johor (+RM1.5 billion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM890.4 million), Sabah (+RM254.5 million), Perak (+RM108.0 million), W.P. Labuan (+RM27.8 million) and Kelantan (+RM11.8 million). However, imports decreased in Negeri Sembilan by RM1.3 billion, Kedah (-RM980.0 million), Melaka (-RM954.9 million), Selangor (-RM903.4 million), Pahang (-RM753.3 million), Terengganu (-RM246.7 million), Perlis (-RM87.2 million) and Sarawak (-RM16.9 million).

Selangor dominates Malaysia's imports with a share of 24.4 per cent, followed by Johor (24.3%), Pulau Pinang (23.7%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (8.3%) and Kedah (5.4%).

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NOTA TEKNIKAL

1. PENGENALAN

Penerbitan ini mengandungi Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri Malaysia (barangan) berkaitan dengan import dan eksport (termasuk eksport semula) mengikut seksyen dan Bahagian barangan, negara asal dan yang dituju, barangan utama / terpilih, Klasifikasi Kategori Ekonomi Umum (BEC) dan penggunaan akhir serta data pelarasan musim.

Statistik ini juga meliputi Perdagangan Luar Negeri Malaysia (barangan) berkaitan import dan eksport di peringkat negeri (mengikut pintu keluar dan masuk) dengan seluruh dunia.

2. OBJEKTIF

Objektif utama penerbitan ini untuk membekalkan statistik tentang prestasi perdagangan Malaysia dengan negara-negara lain dari segi nilai dan volum barangan. Penerbitan ini menjadi input kepada penggubalan dasar, rujukan penting dalam pelaksanaan keputusan, pemantauan dan penilaian keberkesanan program pembangunan negara serta penyelidikan.

3. BIDANG DAN LIPUTAN

3.1 Malaysia menggunakan 'sistem perdagangan umum' dalam penyusunan Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri. Di bawah sistem ini, sempadan negara digunakan sebagai sempadan perangkaan. Semua barang yang dibawa masuk atau keluar dari negara (selain pengecualian yang disebutkan di para 11 di bawah) direkodkan, sama ada barangan itu tertakluk kepada kelulusan tertentu atau pun tidak. Barangan yang dibawa masuk atau keluar dari gudang-gudang simpanan kastam, Zon Bebas direkodkan di dalam perangkaan ini.

3.2 Butir-butir tentang kapal dan kapal terbang dagangan dan persendirian turut **diambil kira** jika ianya diimport atau dieksport sebagai barang yang dibeli, dijual atau disewa (kewangan) tidak kira sama ada ianya tiba atau berlepas dengan kuasanya sendiri.

3.3 Eksport mengikut lokasi adalah berdasarkan negeri asal (iaitu negeri dalam Malaysia di mana peringkat akhir pengeluaran atau pembuatan berlaku). Sebaliknya, import mengikut lokasi berdasarkan negeri destinasi terakhir (iaitu negeri di mana barangan dikeluarkan daripada kawalan Kastam, tetapi tidak semestinya di mana barangan itu akhirnya dijual atau digunakan).

Ketepatan dalam pelaporan negeri asal dan negeri destinasi akhir dalam dokumentasi oleh pihak Jabatan Kastam Diraja Malaysia (JKDM) memberi kesan kepada kualiti statistik perdagangan barangan mengikut lokasi. Dalam hal ini, lokasi pemuatan/pelepasan akan digunakan sebagai proksi bagi negeri asal/destinasi akhir yang sebenar.

3.4 Aktiviti eksport dan import yang berlaku di kawasan Supra (merangkumi aktiviti pengeluaran yang melangkaui pusat kepentingan ekonomi utama bagi mana- mana negeri) atau periklanan yang dilakukan oleh ejen penghantar tidak termasuk dalam penyusunan statistik import dan eksport mengikut lokasi. Nilai import atau eksport bagi W.P. Kuala Lumpur adalah termasuk W.P. Putrajaya.

4. SUMBER DATA

- 4.1 Pengikraran import dan eksport (*hard/soft copy*) yang diluluskan oleh Jabatan Kastam Diraja Malaysia (JKDM) dan Pihak Berkuasa Zon Bebas.
- 4.2 Keterangan mengenai pengiraman bungkusan pos/courier yang dibekalkan oleh Pos Malaysia Berhad.
- 4.3 Penyata dan pengikraran eksport mengenai *bunkers* dan *stores* yang dibekalkan kepada kapal terbang yang dikeluarkan/diluluskan oleh syarikat-syarikat petroleum.
- 4.4 Penyata penjualan barangan yang dibekalkan oleh pengusaha-pengusaha kedai bebas cukai.
- 4.5 Penyata jualan dan belian elektrik yang dikeluarkan oleh syarikat pengeluar

5. KONSEP DAN DEFINISI

Sesuatu barangan dianggap sebagai import apabila ianya dibawa **masuk** ke dalam negara, sama ada terus ataupun disimpan di gudang dalam kawasan yang dikawalselia oleh pihak Kastam tanpa mengira sama ada barangan tersebut adalah untuk kegunaan sendiri, diproses, digunakan dalam pembuatan ataupun untuk dieksport semula ke negara lain.

5.3 Eksport

Sesuatu barangan (keluaran atau buatan tempatan atau diimport untuk dieksport semula) dianggap sebagai eksport apabila ianya dibawa **keluar** dari negara.

5.4 Eksport Domestik

Sesuatu barangan (keluaran atau buatan tempatan) dianggap sebagai eksport domestik apabila ianya dibawa **keluar** dari negara.

5.5 Eksport Semula

Sesuatu barangan dianggap sebagai eksport semula apabila ianya dibawa **keluar** dari negara dalam keadaan seperti mana ianya **diimport** tanpa mengalami sebarang **perubahan**. Proses membungkus semula, menyisih atau menggred tidak dikira sebagai satu proses perubahan.

5.6 Imbangan Perdagangan

Imbangan perdagangan ialah perbezaan antara nilai eksport dan import. Apabila eksport melebihi import **lebih** direkodkan manakala **defisit** pula dicatatkan apabila import melebihi eksport.

6. ASAS PENILAIAN

- 6.1 **WTO Valuation Agreement (1994)** digunakan sebagai asas penilaian untuk semua transaksi barangan.
- 6.2 **Nilai** ditunjukkan dalam Ringgit Malaysia.
- 6.3 **Import** dinilai mengikut **cif (cost, insurance and freight – kos, insuran dan tambang)** iaitu nilai barangan di pasaran di sempadan statistik/kastam negara pengimport termasuk semua perbelanjaan insuran dan tambang semasa dalam perjalanan **tetapi** kos pemunggaran dari alat pengangkutan tidak diambil kira **kecuali** kos tersebut ditanggung sendiri oleh pengangkut.
- 6.4 **Eksport** dinilai mengikut **fob (free on board)** iaitu nilai barangan di pasaran di sempadan statistik/kastam negara pengeksport termasuk semua perbelanjaan pengangkutan ke sempadan tersebut, duti eksport dan duti lain yang perlu dibayar serta kos untuk memunggah barang ke atas alat pengangkutan **kecuali** kos terakhir itu ditanggung sendiri oleh pengangkut.

7. KLASIFIKASI BARANG DAGANGAN

- 7.1 Penyusunan Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri (barangan) bagi bulan rujukan Januari 2022 hingga Mei 2022 menggunakan Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System (HS) 2017 yang juga dikenali sebagai Perintah Duti Kastam (PDK) 2017. Bermula bulan rujukan Jun 2022, HS2022 yang juga dikenali sebagai PDK2022 telah digunakan menggantikan HS2017. Walau bagaimanapun, pengelasan mengikut Standard International Trade Classification (S.I.T.C) Rev.4 masih digunakan dengan penyesuaian.
- 7.2 Selepas perbincangan dan perundingan dengan Lembaga Minyak Sawit Malaysia (MPOB), pilihan kod untuk minyak kelapa sawit dan hasil keluaran berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit adalah berdasarkan minyak kelapa sawit tulen dan hasil keluaran berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit serta kod-kod yang berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit dan hasil keluaran berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit (melebihi 50%).

8. VOLUM

Volum merupakan berat bersih atau ukuran lain bagi barangan itu, tidak termasuk kontena. Jika barangan itu dilaporkan dalam pelbagai unit ukuran, maka unit ukuran tersebut tidak dapat diselaraskan. Oleh itu, hanya nilai barangan sahaja dipaparkan.

9. NEGARA ASAL DAN YANG DITUJU

- 9.1 **Negara asal** merujuk kepada lokasi / negara barangan yang dibawa masuk ke dalam negara. Jika maklumat negara asalnya tidak dapat ditentukan. Sebagai contoh, bagi barangan melalui Singapura, maka import berkenaan dilaporkan dari Singapura.
- 9.2 **Negara yang dituju** merujuk kepada destinasi/negara akhir barangan itu dijangka akan digunakan. Bagi barangan yang dihantar dengan *optional bill of lading*, negara di mana pelabuhan pertama diketahui akan dilaporkan sebagai negara yang dituju. Jika maklumat negara yang dituju tidak dapat ditentukan. Sebagai contoh, bagi

barangan yang dieksport melalui Singapura, maka eksport berkenaan dilaporkan ke Singapura.

- 9.3 **Bagi bunkers dan stores yang dibekalkan kepada kapal dan kapal terbang,** negara yang dituju ditentukan mengikut lokasi/negara residen syarikat pengendali kapal atau kapal terbang tersebut.

10. TRANSAKSI BERNILAI RENDAH (TBR)

Mulai bulan rujukan Januari 2023, transaksi tunggal 'di bawah RM1,000' bagi Semenanjung Malaysia telah diliputi dalam penyusunan Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri dan transaksi bernilai 'di bawah RM5,000' telah dilaporkan mengikut kod HS yang diikrar. Manakala mulai bulan rujukan Januari 2024, transaksi tunggal 'di bawah RM2,000' untuk Sabah dan Sarawak telah dilaporkan mengikut kod HS yang diikrar.

11. PENGECEUALIAN

Barang-barang yang tidak termasuk dalam Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri adalah:

- 11.1 barangan transit, iaitu pengangkutan barangan di bawah kawalan kastam dari sebuah stesen kastam ke sebuah stesen kastam yang lain. Misalnya, pergerakan barangan dari Thailand ke Singapura melalui Semenanjung Malaysia dan pergerakan barangan dari sebuah zon bebas ke sebuah zon bebas yang lain di Malaysia. Barang dalam transit yang diliputi *through bills of lading* / *air-way bills* juga termasuk di bawah kategori ini;
- 11.2 barangan pindah kapal, iaitu pemindahan barangan di bawah kawalan pihak yang berkuasa, dari suatu pengangkutan yang digunakan untuk pengimportan kepada suatu pengangkutan lain yang digunakan untuk pengeksportan **dalam** kawasan kawalan pihak berkuasa yang sama. Stesen ini merupakan stesen pengimportan dan juga pengeksportan. Sebagai contoh, barangan dari Myanmar yang dibawa masuk ke kawasan kastam Pulau Pinang yang semata-mata bertujuan untuk dihantar ke negara ketiga (misalnya ke Hong Kong). Satu lagi contoh adalah barangan dari India yang dibawa masuk melalui Kawasan Bebas Pelabuhan Klang yang semata-mata bertujuan untuk dihantar ke Negara Ketiga (misalnya ke Sepanyol);
- 11.3 emas (kewangan) dan wang kertas serta duit syiling dalam edaran;
- 11.4 barangan yang diimport dan dieksport oleh, atau bagi pihak perkhidmatan diplomatik dan Angkatan Tentera Bukan Malaysia;
- 11.5 filem wayang untuk disewa;
- 11.6 kemasukan barangan untuk sementara waktu dan ianya tertakluk kepada pengeksportan semula dalam keadaan yang sama. Barangan ini diimport untuk tujuan tertentu dan dieksport semula dalam masa yang telah ditentukan tanpa mengalami sebarang perubahan, kecuali susut nilai yang biasa. Contohnya, binatang dan motokar bagi pertunjukan sarkas, perlumbaan, pertandingan dan pameran serta peralatan-peralatan bunyi untuk pertunjukan muzikal;
- 11.7 *barges (lash)* yang digunakan untuk mengangkut kargo dari kapal ke pantai atau sebaliknya;

- 11.8 ikan dan hasil laut lain yang dibawa oleh kapal laut berdaftar di Malaysia dan mendarat terus dari laut.
- 11.9 bekas untuk menyimpan sesuatu barang/benda, silinder, botol dan seumpamanya yang dinyatakan sebagai 'dikembalikan';
- 11.10 bekalan dan minyak yang dibekalkan kepada kapal laut dan kapal terbang yang dikendalikan oleh operator yang menetap di Malaysia;
- 11.11 semua sampel, pemberian dan bahan untuk ujian atau analisa tanpa mengira nilai transaksi yang terlibat;
- 11.12 tiket loteri & toto;
- 11.13 pergerakan barangan di antara Negeri di dalam Semenanjung Malaysia tanpa mengira cara pengangkutan serta pergerakan barangan melalui **darat** di antara Sabah dan Sarawak;
- 11.14 disket atau CD-ROM yang mengandungi perisian komputer dan / atau data, dibuat mengikut pesanan, audio dan videotapes yang mengandungi perakaman asal dan customised blueprints, dll; dan
- 11.15 barangan untuk **dibaiki**.

12. KEMASKINI TERHADAP NEGARA-NEGARA KESATUAN EROPAH (EU)

Bermula 1 Februari 2020, United Kingdom secara rasminya keluar daripada EU. Perkembangan ini telah diambil kira di dalam penerbitan mulai bulan Februari 2020 dan seterusnya.

- 13. Bermula rujukan Januari 2022, Statistik Eksport Produk Halal mengikut Pengelasan Barangan disusun daripada hasil gabungan pangkalan data Perdagangan Luar Negeri dengan senarai syarikat berstatus halal yang diperoleh daripada Jabatan Kemajuan Islam Malaysia (JAKIM).

14. PELARASAN MUSIM

Data siri masa adalah amat berguna untuk ahli ekonomi, pembuat dasar dan polisi serta penganalisis siri masa untuk mengenal pasti ciri-ciri penting siri ekonomi seperti arah, *turning point* dan konsistensi antara penunjuk ekonomi yang lain. Kadang-kadang ciri ini sukar untuk diperhatikan kerana pergerakan bermusim. Oleh itu, sekiranya kesan bermusim boleh disingkirkan, perilaku data siri ini dapat dilihat dengan lebih baik. Anggaran dan penyingkiran kesan bermusim dipanggil pelarasan bermusim.

Pelarasan bermusim adalah satu proses untuk mengenal pasti dan menyingkirkan bentuk pola bermusim yang biasa berlaku dalam tempoh satu tahun, yang mungkin juga merangkumi pengaruh dari kesan cuti yang bergerak dan hari bekerja/ berdagang bagi suatu tempoh. Objektif utama proses ini adalah untuk menyerlahkan dasar arah aliran dan pergerakan-pergerakan jangka pendek dalam siri ini.

Di Malaysia, kebanyakan data siri masa terjejas oleh kesan bermusim. Oleh itu, untuk menghapuskan kesan bermusim dan juga melaraskan musim data siri masa ekonomi Malaysia, pakej pelarasan bermusim standard, X-12 ARIMA telah digunakan oleh Jabatan Perangkaan, Malaysia.

Data siri masa ekonomi Malaysia kerap dipengaruhi oleh perayaan agama utama seperti Aidilfitri bagi umat Islam, Tahun Baru Cina untuk kaum Cina dan Deepavali untuk kaum India. Tarikh perayaan-perayaan ini tetap mengikut tahun lunar tetapi berbeza-beza mengikut kalendar Gregorian. Oleh itu, untuk menganggar dan menyingkirkan kesan cuti yang bergerak dari data siri masa, satu prosedur telah dibangunkan iaitu *Seasonal Adjustment for Malaysia* (SEAM).

Kaedah SEAM digunakan untuk membuang kesan bermusim bagi data Perdagangan Luar Negeri Malaysia. Pelarasan musim dibuat ke atas data bulanan bagi jumlah eksport dan import. Data siri pelarasan bermusim untuk tiga tahun sebelumnya akan disemak setiap tahun apabila data untuk 12 bulan lengkap.

15. KLASIFIKASI MENGIKUT KATEGORI EKONOMI UMUM (BEC)

- 15.1 Klasifikasi mengikut Kategori Ekonomi Umum (BEC) diwujudkan adalah untuk meringkaskan Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri (PPLN) mengikut kelas komoditi ekonomi yang luas. Di samping itu, ia dibentuk sebagai pengantara untuk menukarkan data PPLN yang disusun berdasarkan HS kepada kategori penggunaan akhir yang lebih bermakna dalam konteks Sistem Akaun Negara (SNA) iaitu barang modal, barang pengantara dan barang penggunaan. Penyusunan ini membolehkan data PPLN dihubungkan dengan perangkaan ekonomi umum seperti perangkaan akaun negara dan perangkaan perindustrian bagi tujuan penganalisan ekonomi di peringkat negara, kawasan dan dunia.
- 15.2 BEC termasuk sembilan belas kategori asas. Setiap kategori BEC didefinisikan dari segi bahagian, kumpulan, sub-kumpulan dan tajuk HS. Setiap tajuk asas HS ditetapkan secara khusus kepada satu kategori BEC. Penetapan ini dibuat berasaskan penggunaan akhir yang utama bagi sesuatu komoditi dalam setiap tajuk HS, walaupun erdapat banyak komoditi yang didagangkan di peringkat antarabangsa boleh dikelaskan kepada pelbagai kegunaan.
- 15.3 Statistik dalam Jadual 16: Import Barangan Mengikut Klasifikasi Kategori Ekonomi Umum dijana berdasarkan import tertanggung iaitu import tolak eksport semula. Angka tersebut boleh menjadi negatif bagi bulan rujukan tertentu jika eksport semula melebihi daripada import.

16. KERAHSIAAN DATA

Data perdagangan telah disusun di bawah peruntukan ***Statistics Act 1965 (Revised-1989)***. Akta ini mensyaratkan bahawa kandungan penyata individu adalah sulit. Selaras dengan peruntukan tersebut, hanya angka agregat diterbitkan.

17. DASAR PINDAAN

Data pada bulan semasa adalah sementara (provisional) dan tertakluk kepada pindaan sehingga ia dimuktamadkan. Pindaan dibuat sekiranya wujud maklumat tambahan. Bermula tahun 2021, data muktamad akan dikeluarkan 7 (tujuh) bulan selepas tahun rujukan. Perangkaan muktamad perdagangan luar negeri bagi tahun rujukan 2021 telah digunakan mulai bulan rujukan Jun 2022.

18. **PEMBUNDARAN**

Jumlah-jumlah kecil, apabila dicampurkan, **mungkin** tidak bersamaan dengan jumlah besar disebabkan oleh pembundaran.

TECHNICAL NOTES

1. INTRODUCTION

This publication contains statistics of Malaysia's External trade (merchandise) pertaining to imports and exports (including re-exports) by sections, divisions and groups of commodity, country of origin and destination, selected/major commodities, Broad Economic Category (BEC) classification and end-use as well as seasonally adjusted data.

This publication also contains statistics of Malaysia's External Trade (merchandise) on imports and exports at the state level (based on exit and entry points) with the rest of the world.

2. OBJECTIVE

The main objective of compiling Malaysia's external trade statistics is to provide information on Malaysia's trade performance vis-a-vis the rest of the world in terms of volume and value of merchandise goods. The trade statistics, therefore, serve as a tool in assisting the government in formulating policies and monitoring economic performance as well as for development planning. The data can also be used by the private sector and individuals for specific purposes such as for economic projection and analysis.

3. SCOPE AND COVERAGE

3.1 *The 'general trade system' of recording is adopted in compiling Malaysian external trade statistics. Under this system, the national boundary of the country is used as the statistical frontier. All goods entering or leaving the country (except specific exclusions mentioned in paragraph 11 below) are recorded, whether or not such goods are subject to clearance. Accordingly, goods entering or leaving customs bonded warehouses, Free Zones are recorded in the statistics.*

3.2 *Details of commercial and private ships and aircraft are also **included** in these statistics if they were imported or exported as goods purchased, sold or leased (financial) whether or not they arrived or departed under their own power.*

3.3 *Exports by location based on the state of origin (i.e. state of Malaysia where the final stage of production or manufacturing occurs). On the other hand, imports by location based on the state of final destination (i.e. the state of Malaysia in which goods are released from Customs controls, but not necessarily where they are ultimately sold or consumed).*

The accuracy in reporting the actual State of origin and State of final destination on Royal Malaysian Customs Department documentation affects the quality of State merchandise trade statistics. In this case, the location of loading/discharge may be used as a proxy for the actual state of origin/final destination.

3.4 *Export and import activities that are taking place in the Supra area (including production activities beyond the centre of predominant economic interest for any state) or declarations made by the agent are not included in the compilation of imports and exports statistics by location. Imports or exports value for the W.P. Kuala Lumpur includes the W.P. Putrajaya.*

4. SOURCE OF DATA

- 4.1 *Import and export declarations (hard/soft copy) approved by the Royal Malaysian Customs Department (RMCD) and Free Zone Authorities.*
- 4.2 *Particulars on postal/courier packages are provided by Pos Malaysia Berhad.*
- 4.3 *Statements and export declarations on bunkers and stores supplied to aircraft issued/approved by the petroleum companies.*
- 4.4 *Statements on goods sold are supplied by the operators of duty-free shops.*
- 4.5 *Statements on the sale and purchase of electricity issued by 'power producer company'.*

5. CONCEPTS AND DEFINITIONS

- 5.1 *The compilation of these statistics is in accordance with the guidelines of the **International Merchandise Trade Statistics: Concepts and Definitions (IMTS) 2010** from the **United Nations**.*

5.2 **Imports**

*Goods are regarded as imports when they are brought **into** the country either directly or into bonded warehouses, irrespective of whether such goods are for consumption, to be processed, use in manufacturing or subsequent re-exports to other countries.*

5.3 **Exports**

*Goods (locally produced or manufactured or imported for subsequent re-exports) are regarded as exports when they are taken **out** of the country.*

5.4 **Domestic Exports**

*Goods (locally produced or manufactured) are regarded as domestic exports when they are taken **out** of the country.*

5.5 **Re-exports**

*Goods are regarded as re-exports when they are taken **out** of the country in the same form as they were **imported** without any **transformation**. Re-packing, sorting or grading processes are not considered as part of the transformation process.*

5.6 **Balance of Trade**

*The balance of trade is the difference between the value of exports and imports. When exports exceed imports it is recorded as a **surplus** while a **deficit** is registered when imports exceed exports.*

6. BASIS OF VALUATION

- 6.1 *The **WTO Valuation Agreement (1994)** is used as the basis of valuation for all transactions of goods.*
- 6.2 ***Values** are shown in Malaysian Ringgit.*

- 6.3 **Imports** are valued on a **c.i.f. (cost, insurance and freight)** basis, that is, the value of the goods in the market at the statistical / customs frontier of the importing country, including all charges for transport and insurance whilst in transit **but** excluding the cost of unloading from the carrier **unless** it is borne by the carrier.
- 6.4 **Exports** are valued on a **f.o.b. (free on board)** basis, that is, the value of the goods in the market at the statistical / customs frontier of the exporting country, including all costs of transporting the goods to the statistical / customs frontier, export and other duties payable as well as the cost of loading the goods onto the carrier **unless** the latter cost is borne by the carrier.

7. CLASSIFICATION OF COMMODITIES

- 7.1 The compilation of External Trade Statistics (merchandise) for the reference month of January 2022 to May 2022 used the Harmonised Commodity description and Coding system (HS) 2017, also known as Customs Duties Order (PDK) 2017. Commencing from the reference month of June 2022, HS2022 also known as PDK2022 has been used to replace HS2017. However, Standard International Trade Classification (S.I.T.C) Rev.4 is still in use with appropriate updates.
- 7.2 After discussion and consultation with Malaysian Palm Oil Board (MPOB), the selection of codes for palm oil and palm oil-based products is based on pure palm oil and palm oil-based products as well as those codes which are predominantly palm oil and palm oil-based products (more than 50%).

8. VOLUME

Volume, where shown, represent the nett weight or other measurement of the goods exclusive of packing containers. Where a commodity item comprises different kinds of commodities for which a common unit of measurement cannot be used, only values are shown.

9. COUNTRY OF ORIGIN AND DESTINATION

- 9.1 **Country of origin** refers to the location/country of goods brought into the country. If the country of origin information cannot be determined, for example, for goods via Singapore, then the import is reported from Singapore.
- 9.2 **Country of destination** refers to the final destination/country where the goods are expected to be used. For goods sent with a country where the first port is known will be reported as the country of destination. if the destination country information cannot be determined, for example, for goods exported through Singapore, then the exports is reported to Singapore.
- 9.3 **For bunkers and stores supplied to ships and aircraft**, the country of destination is determined according to the country of residence of the operator of the ship or aircraft.

10. LOW VALUE TRANSACTIONS (LVT)

With effect from reference month of January 2023, single transactions with a value 'below RM1,000' for Peninsular Malaysia have been covered in the compilation of External Trade Statistics and transactions worth 'below RM5,000' have been reported according to the pledged HS code. Meanwhile with effect from reference month of January 2024, single transactions with a value 'below RM2,000' for Sabah and Sarawak have been reported according to the pledged HS code.

11. EXCLUSIONS

Classes of goods excluded from external trade statistics are: -

- 11.1 transit cargo, that is goods transported under customs control from one Customs office to another. Examples are the movement of goods from Thailand bound for Singapore through Peninsular Malaysia and the movement of goods within Malaysia from one free trade zone to another. All goods in transit covered through bills of lading/air-way bills are also included in this category;*
- 11.2 transshipment cargo, that is goods transferred under the control of the relevant authorities from the importing means of transport to the exporting means of transport **within** the area of control of the same authorities, which is the office of both importation and exportation. For example, goods from Myanmar brought into the Pulau Pinang Customs area for the sole purpose of transport to a third country (e.g. to Hong Kong). Another example is goods from India brought into the Port Klang Free Zone for the sole purpose of transport to a third country (e.g. to Spain);*
- 11.3 gold bullion (monetary) and issued currency notes and coins;*
- 11.4 goods imported and exported by, or on behalf of, diplomatic services and non-Malaysian Armed Forces;*
- 11.5 exposed cinematographic films on a rental basis;*
- 11.6 temporary admission of goods subject to re-exportation in the same state. Such goods must be imported for a specific purpose and must be intended for re-exportation within a specified period without having undergone any change except normal depreciation. Examples are animals and cars for circuses, races, competitions and exhibitions and instruments/sound equipment for musical performances;*
- 11.7 barges (lash) used for the transportation of cargo from vessel to shore or vice-versa;*
- 11.8 fish and other marine produce landed by Malaysian registered vessels direct from the sea;*
- 11.9 containers, cylinders, bottles, crates and the like specified as returnable;*
- 11.10 stores and fuel supplied to ships and aircraft handled by operators of Malaysian residence;*
- 11.11 samples, gifts and specimens for test or analysis, irrespective of value;*
- 11.12 toto & lottery tickets;*

11.13 movement of goods by any mode of transportation between states within Peninsular Malaysia and movement of goods by **land** between Sabah and Sarawak;

11.14 diskettes or CD-ROMs with stored computer software and/or data, developed to order, audio and videotapes containing original recordings and customised blueprints, etc; and

11.15 goods for **repair**.

12. **UPDATE TO EUROPEAN UNION (EU) COUNTRIES**

From 1st July 2013, Croatia has joined EU. This development has been incorporated in the publication from July 2013 onwards.

13. *Commencing from January 2022, statistics on Exports of Halal Products by Commodity Classification is compiled from an integrated external trade database with list of Halal certified companies which obtained from the Department of Islamic Development Malaysia (JAKIM).*

14. **SEASONAL ADJUSTMENT**

Time-series data are very useful for economists, policy & decision makers and time-series analysts to identify the important features of economic series such as direction, turning point and consistency between other economic indicators. Sometimes this feature is difficult to observe because of seasonal movements. Thus, if the seasonal effect can be removed, the behaviour of the series would be better viewed. The estimation and removal of the seasonal effects is called seasonal adjustment.

Seasonal adjustment is a process to identify and to remove the regular within-a-year seasonal pattern, which may also include the influences of moving holidays and working / trading days effect in each period. The ultimate objective of the process is to highlight the underlying trends and short-term movements in the series.

In Malaysia, most of the time series data are affected by seasonal effects. Hence, to eliminate the seasonal effect as well as to seasonally adjust the Malaysian economic time series data, a standard seasonal adjustment package, X-12 ARIMA was used by Department of Statistics, Malaysia.

Malaysian economic time series data are often affected by major religious festivals such as Eid-ul Fitr of the Muslims, Chinese New Year of the Chinese and Deepavali of the Indians. These festivals' dates are fixed according to the lunar year but vary according to the Gregorian calendar. Therefore, to estimate and remove moving holiday effect from time-series data, a procedure was developed, namely Seasonal Adjustment for Malaysia (SEAM).

The SEAM method is used to remove seasonal effect for Malaysia's merchandise external trade data. The seasonal adjustment is carried out on monthly total exports and total imports. The seasonally adjusted series data for the preceding three years are revised each year when the figures for complete 12 months become available.

15. CLASSIFICATION BY BROAD ECONOMIC CATEGORIES (BEC)

- 15.1 The BEC was originally devised mainly for the summarization of data on international trade by large economic classes of commodities. In addition, it was designed to serve as a means for converting external trade data compiled on the HS into end use categories that are meaningful within the framework of the System of National Accounts (SNA) namely capital goods, intermediate goods, and consumption goods. This aggregation permits external trade statistics to be considered jointly with other sets of general economic statistics such as national accounts and industrial statistics for national, regional or world level economic analysis.
- 15.2 The BEC includes nineteen basic categories. Each category of the BEC is defined in terms of divisions, groups, sub-groups and basic headings of HS. Each HS basic heading is allocated entirely to one BEC category. The allocation is done on the basis of the main end use of the commodities in each HS basic heading, although it is recognised that many commodities that are traded internationally may be put to a variety of uses.
- 15.3 The statistics in Table 16: Imports of Commodities by Broad Economic Categories Classifications are generated based on retained imports i.e. imports minus re-exports. The figure could be negative for a reference month if re-exports are higher than imports.

16. CONFIDENTIALITY REQUIREMENTS

The trade data statistics have been compiled under the provisions of the **Statistics Act 1965 (Revised-1989)**. The Act stipulates that the contents of individual returns are **confidential**. In conformity with the said stipulation, only aggregated figures are published.

17. REVISION POLICY

Data for the current month is provisional and subject to revision until it is finalised. Revisions are made if there are additional information. Starting 2021, final data will be released by 7 (seven) months after reference year. Final external trade statistics for reference year 2021 was used from reference month June 2022.

18. ROUNDING

Sub-totals **may** not add up exactly to totals due to rounding.
