Kepengerusian ASEAN-Malaysia 2025: Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) akan mempengerusikan Jawatankuasa Sistem Statistik Komuniti ASEAN Ke-15 (ACSS15) yang bertujuan untuk memperkukuh kerjasama statistik ke arah pembangunan serantau yang mampan.

Malaysia buat julung kalinya telah menduduki tangga pertama (1) di peringkat global dalam laporan dwi-tahunan *Open Data Inventory* (ODIN) 2024/25 yang dikeluarkan oleh *Open Data Watch* (ODW), mengatasi 198 negara lain. Pencapaian ini merupakan lonjakan ketara daripada kedudukan ke-67 dalam penilaian ODIN 2022/23.

Kerajaan Malaysia telah mengisytiharkan 20 Oktober sebagai Hari Statistik Negara (MyStats Day), dengan tema 'Statistik Nadi Kehidupan'. Sementara itu, Hari Statistik Dunia Keempat akan disambut pada 20 Oktober 2025 dengan tema '*Driving Change with Quality Statistics and Data for Everyone*'.

OpenDOSM NextGen adalah medium yang menyediakan katalog data dan visualisasi bagi memudahkan pengguna menganalisis pelbagai data dan boleh diakses melalui portal <https://open.dosm.gov.my>.

Announcement

ASEAN-Malaysia 2025 Chairmanship: The Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) will chair the 15th ASEAN Community Statistical System Committee (ACSS15) which aims to strengthen the statistical cooperation towards sustainable regional development.

Malaysia, for the first time, ranked as number one (1) globally in the biennial Open Data Inventory (ODIN) 2024/25 report released by Open Data Watch (ODW), surpassing 198 other countries. This achievement marks a significant leap from its 67th position in the ODIN 2022/23 assessment.

The Government of Malaysia has declared October 20th as National Statistics Day (MyStats Day), with the theme 'Statistics is the Essence of Life.' Meanwhile, the Fourth World Statistics Day will be celebrated on 20th October 2025, with the theme 'Driving Change with Quality Statistics and Data for Everyone'.

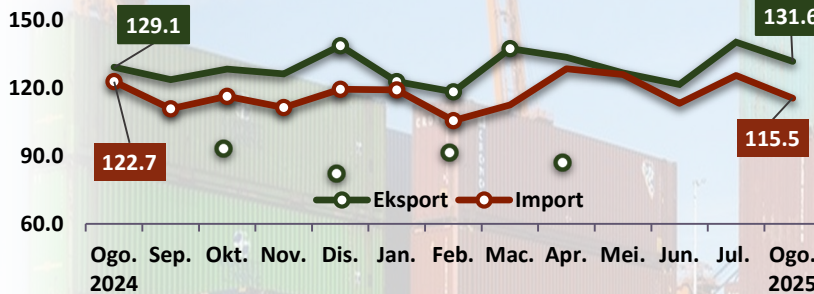

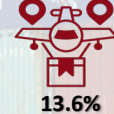

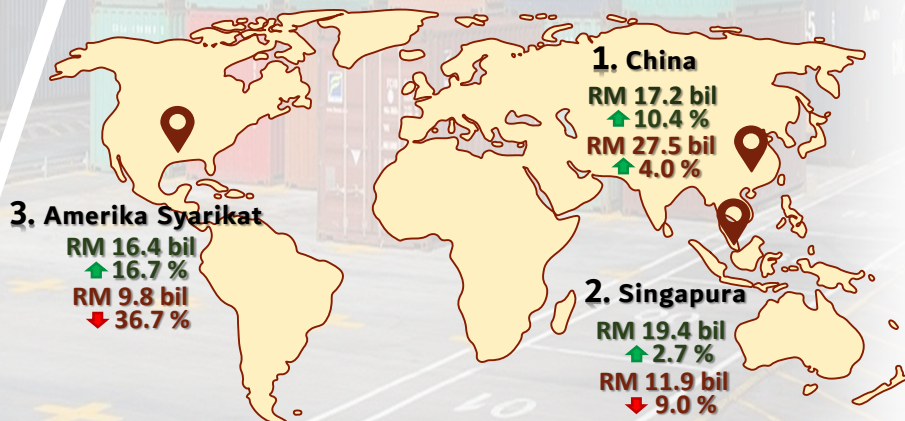

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PRESTASI PERDAGANGAN LUAR NEGERI MALAYSIA, OGOS 2025

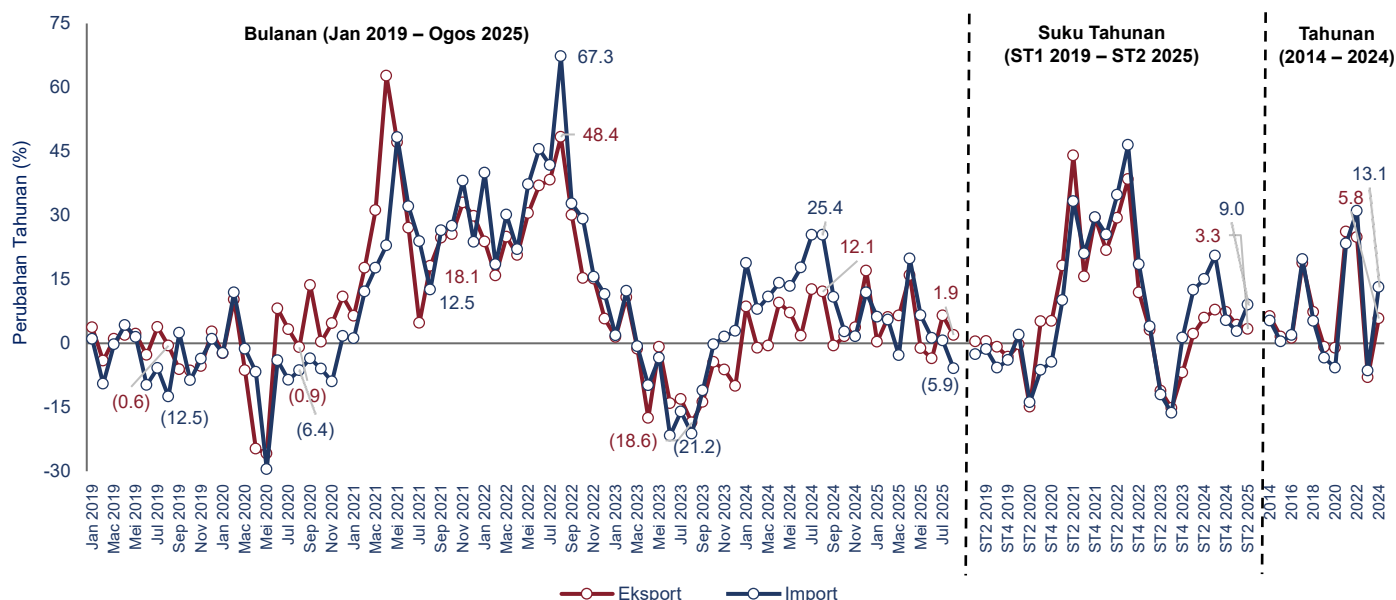
Prestasi dagangan Malaysia pada Ogos 2025 mencatatkan prestasi yang bercampur-campur di beberapa sektor utama. Nilai eksport mencatatkan RM131.6 bilion, menunjukkan peningkatan sebanyak RM2.5 bilion atau 1.9 peratus berbanding tempoh yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Sebaliknya, import mengalami penyusutan kepada RM115.5 bilion, merosot sebanyak RM7.3 bilion atau 5.9 peratus secara tahunan. Jumlah dagangan keseluruhan menurun kepada RM247.1 bilion, berkurang sebanyak RM4.8 bilion atau 1.9 peratus berbanding Ogos 2024. Di samping itu, imbalan dagangan negara mencatat lebih sebanyak RM16.1 bilion, meningkat dengan ketara

sebanyak RM9.8 bilion atau 153.8 peratus secara tahunan.

Perbandingan secara bulanan menunjukkan penyusutan eksport, import dan jumlah dagangan masing-masing 6.0 peratus, 8.0 peratus dan 6.9 peratus. Namun, lebih dagangan mencatatkan kenaikan 10.4 peratus atau RM1.5 bilion.

Eksport, import, jumlah dagangan dan lebih dagangan bagi bulan Januari hingga Ogos 2025 masing-masing meningkat 3.9 peratus, 3.6 peratus, 3.8 peratus dan 7.4 peratus berbanding tempoh yang sama pada tahun sebelumnya.

Prestasi eksport Malaysia berkembang positif sebanyak 1.9 peratus kepada RM131.6 bilion pada Ogos 2025

Prestasi Eksport

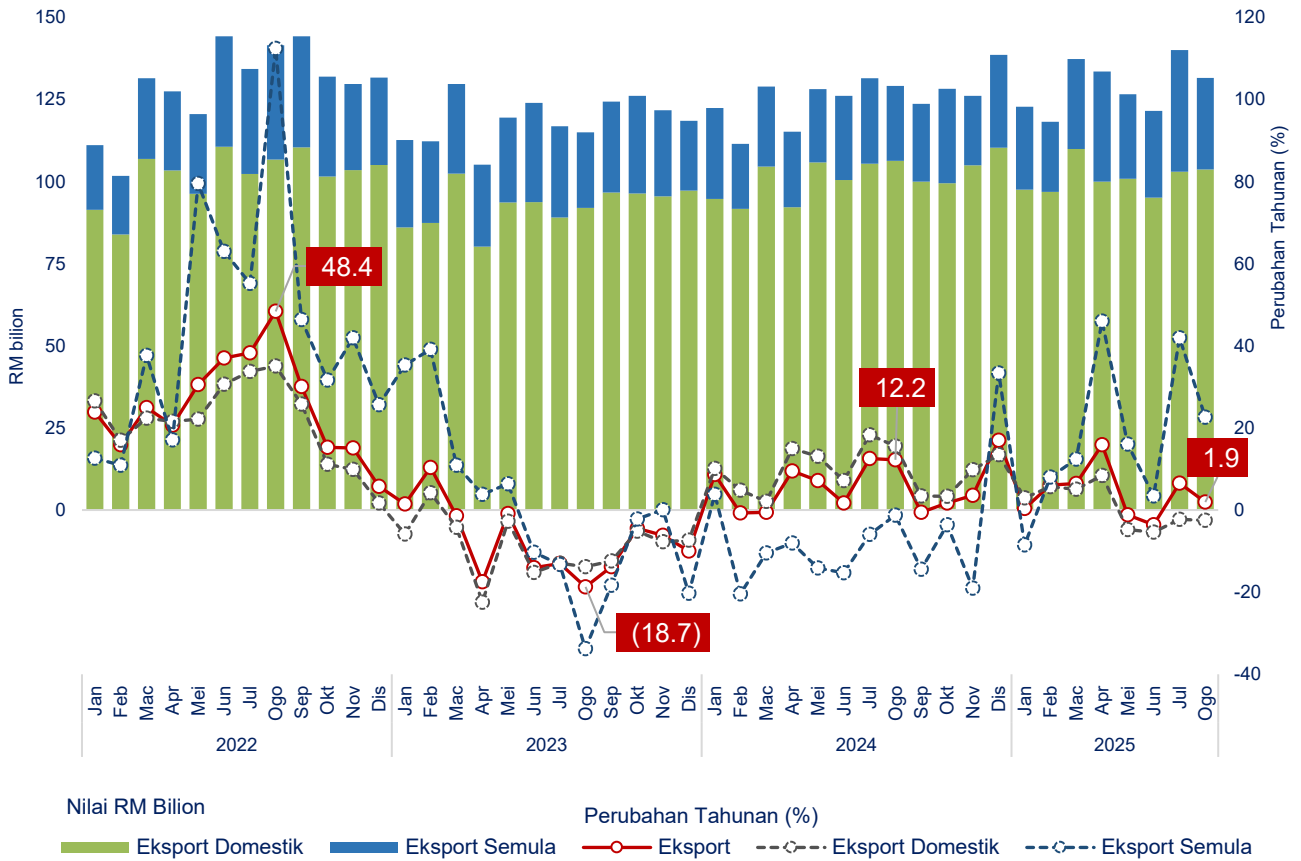
Eksport Malaysia meningkat 1.9 peratus pada Ogos 2025, meningkat daripada RM129.1 bilion pada Ogos 2024 kepada RM131.6 bilion.

Perkembangan ini sejajar dengan peningkatan 22.6 peratus dalam eksport semula kepada RM28.0 bilion daripada RM22.8 bilion, yang merangkumi 21.2 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan eksport. Namun begitu, eksport

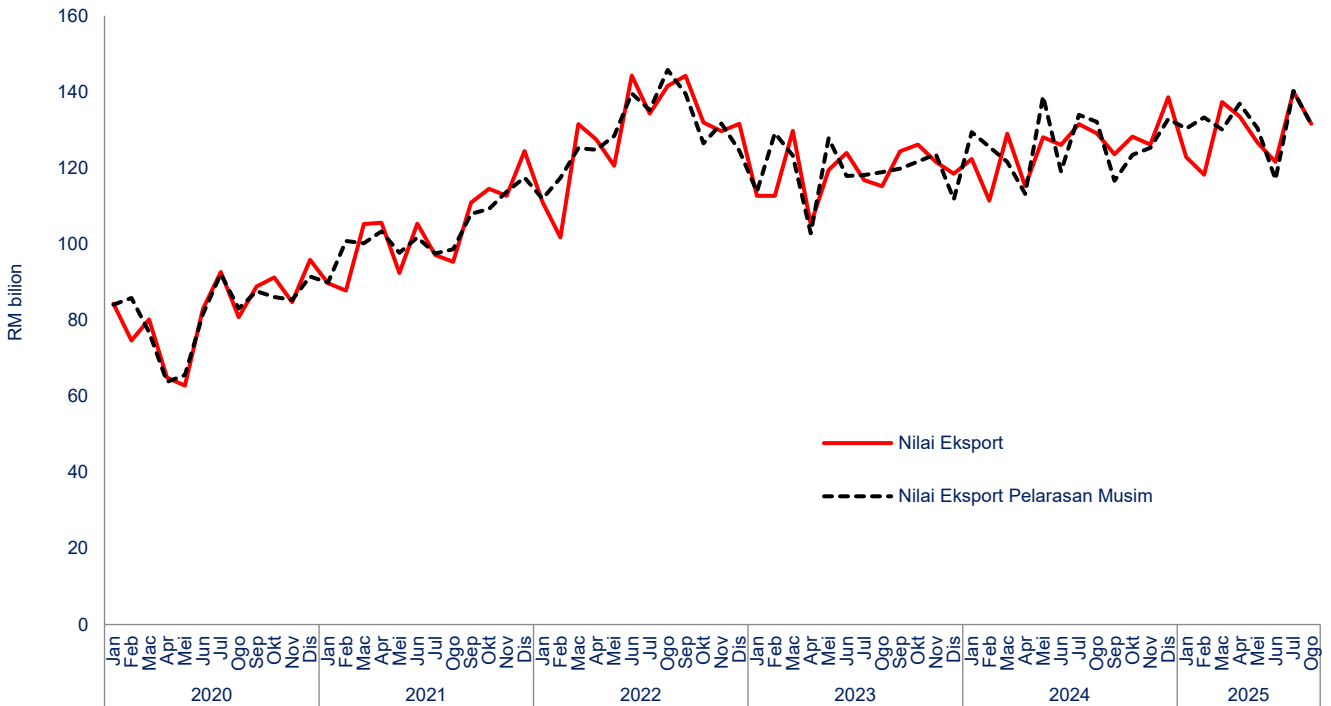
domestik menyumbang 78.8 peratus daripada jumlah eksport, menurun 2.5 peratus kepada RM103.6 bilion.

Selain itu, perbandingan bulanan menunjukkan eksport berkurangan 6.0 peratus atau RM8.5 bilion. Analisis terma pelarasan musim bulan ke bulan, eksport mencatatkan penurunan 6.3 peratus kepada RM131.4 bilion.

Prestasi Eksport mengikut Negara Destinasi Utama

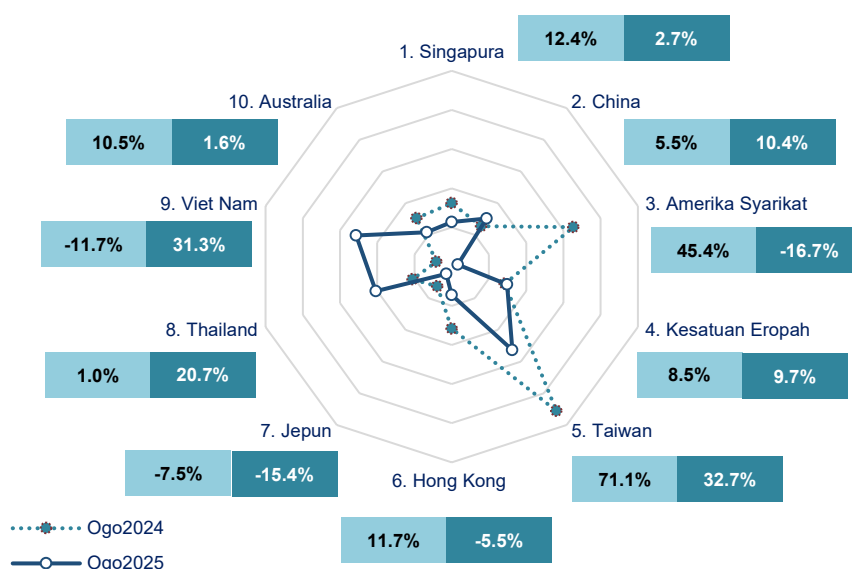
Singapura dan China merupakan negara destinasi utama dengan sumbangan 27.8 peratus kepada jumlah eksport Malaysia pada Ogos 2025.

Singapura terus mendominasi sebagai negara destinasi utama dengan sumbangan 14.7 peratus kepada jumlah eksport. Eksport ke Singapura bernilai RM19.4 bilion, meningkat 2.7 peratus atau RM509.8 juta berbanding tahun sebelumnya. Peningkatan ini disebabkan oleh eksport yang lebih tinggi bagi barangan elektrik dan elektronik (+RM952.0 juta, +10.9%) serta jentera, kelengkapan dan alat ganti (+RM255.2 juta, +15.2%).

Sementara itu, nilai eksport ke China yang merangkumi 13.1 peratus daripada jumlah eksport mencatatkan RM17.2 bilion, naik RM1.6 bilion atau 10.4 peratus. Peningkatan ini disokong oleh eksport yang lebih tinggi bagi barangan elektrik & elektronik (+RM580.5 juta, +10.2%) dan bijih logam & serpihan logam (+RM498.1 juta, +106.7%).

Daripada sepuluh negara utama destinasi, eksport mencatatkan pertumbuhan positif ke Singapura, China, Kesatuan Eropah, Taiwan, Thailand, Viet Nam dan Australia. Manakala, Amerika Syarikat, Hong Kong dan Jepun mencatatkan penurunan pada Ogos 2025.

Eksport ke Negara ASEAN

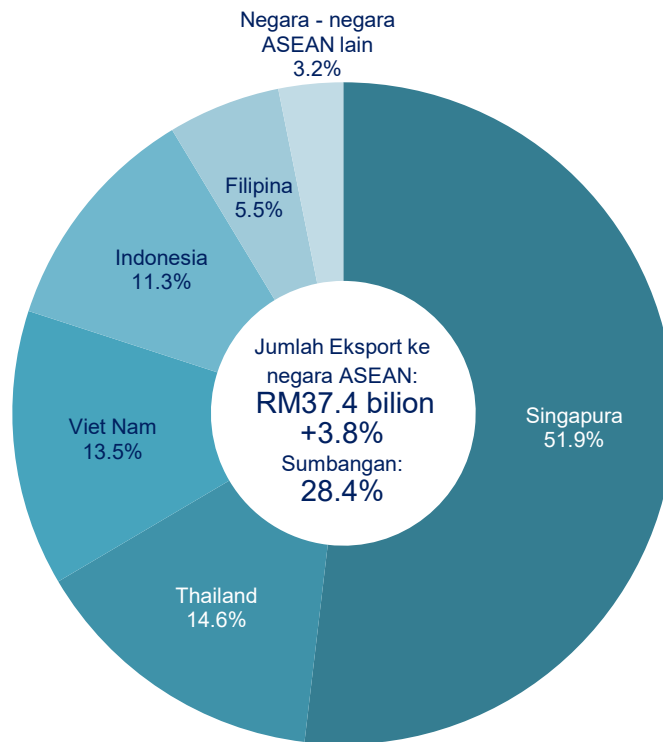
Eksport Malaysia ke negara-negara ASEAN menyumbang 28.4 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan eksport, bernilai RM37.4 bilion, mencatatkan peningkatan 3.8 peratus.

Perkembangan ini dipengaruhi terutamanya oleh eksport yang lebih tinggi bagi barangan elektrik & elektronik (+RM2.6 bilion, +20.7%), diikuti oleh kelengkapan optik & saintifik

(+RM216.1 juta, +23.1%) dan barangan perkilangan lain (+RM191.9 juta, +22.1%).

Singapura mendahului di kalangan negara anggota ASEAN dalam eksport keseluruhan, menyumbang 51.9 peratus dengan nilai RM19.4 bilion, melonjak 2.7 peratus berbanding pada tahun sebelumnya.

Prestasi Eksport mengikut Sektor Ekonomi

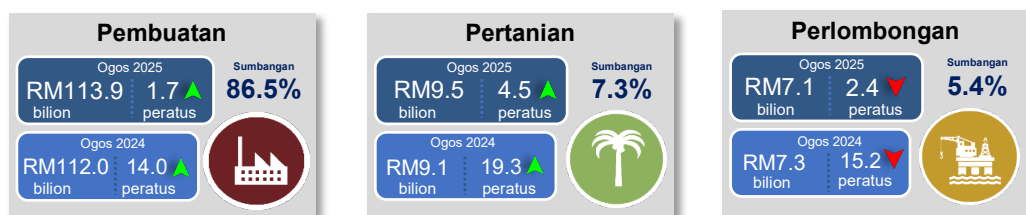
Eksport barangan perkilangan mencatatkan pertambahan 1.7 peratus (+RM1.9 bilion), merangkumi 86.5 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan eksport. Punca utama kepada pertumbuhan positif ini adalah bagi barangan elektrik dan elektronik (+RM5.1 bilion, +10.1%), jentera, kelengkapan dan alat ganti (+RM871.7 juta, +14.5%), serta barangan optik dan saintifik (+RM778.7 juta, +14.7%).

Eksport barangan pertanian naik 4.5 peratus kepada RM9.5 bilion, merangkumi 7.3 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan eksport. Peningkatan ini sejajar dengan

kenaikan eksport minyak sawit & keluaran pertanian berasaskan minyak sawit (+RM650.0 juta, +9.7%) dan minyak sayuran lain (+RM36.1 juta, +11.9%).

Eksport barangan perlombongan, yang menyumbang 5.4 peratus daripada jumlah eksport, turun 2.4 peratus kepada RM7.1 bilion. Penurunan ini disebabkan oleh eksport yang lebih rendah bagi petroleum mentah (-RM496.4 juta, -28.8%), timah (-RM156.2 juta, -54.9%) dan gas asli cecair (-RM108.2 juta, -2.6%).

Eksport mengikut Produk Utama Terpilih

Prestasi eksport menyusut pada Ogos 2025, namun terdapat pertumbuhan positif dalam produk-produk berikut:

- Barangan elektrik & elektronik, yang merangkumi 42.2 peratus daripada jumlah eksport, meningkat 10.1 peratus, daripada RM50.4 bilion kepada RM55.5 bilion; dan
- Minyak sawit dan keluaran pertanian berasaskan minyak sawit, merangkumi 8.2 peratus daripada jumlah eksport, naik 9.1 peratus atau RM97.7 juta selaras

dengan kenaikan eksport minyak sawit. Komoditi utama dalam kumpulan produk ini meningkat sebanyak RM183.9 juta atau 3.3 peratus, didorong oleh kenaikan harga minyak sawit tempatan sebanyak 10.7 peratus (RM4,329.0 bagi satu tan metrik) dan peningkatan nilai purata seunit sebanyak 3.7 peratus. Namun begitu, terdapat pengurangan dalam volum eksport sebanyak 0.4 peratus.

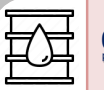
Namun begitu, penurunan dicatatkan dalam produk-produk berikut:

- Keluaran petroleum bertapis merangkumi 6.4 peratus daripada jumlah eksport, menurun 16.9 peratus atau RM1.7 bilion kepada RM8.4 bilion;
- Gas asli cecair menyumbang 3.1 peratus daripada jumlah eksport, menurun RM108.2 juta atau 2.6 peratus kepada RM4.1 bilion. Selain itu, volum eksport meningkat sebanyak 21.0 peratus, manakala nilai purata seunit menurun sebanyak 19.5 peratus;
- Petroleum mentah merangkumi 0.9 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan eksport, susut sebanyak RM496.4 juta atau 28.8 peratus kepada RM1.2 bilion. Penurunan ini sejajar dengan kejatuhan dalam volum eksport

(-2.5%) dan nilai purata seunit (-27.0%), selari dengan penurunan harga minyak mentah Brent kepada RM288.3 setong;

- Kayu & hasil keluaran kayu turun 5.2 peratus atau RM101.7 juta kepada RM1.8 bilion, merangkumi 1.4 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan eksport; dan
- Getah asli menyumbang 0.2 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan eksport, susut sebanyak 33.3 peratus atau RM152.6 juta kepada RM305.1 juta. Penurunan ini sejajar dengan pengurangan dalam volum eksport (-31.4%), kejatuhan nilai purata seunit sebanyak 2.8 peratus, serta penurunan harga getah SMR20 sebanyak 6.4 peratus.

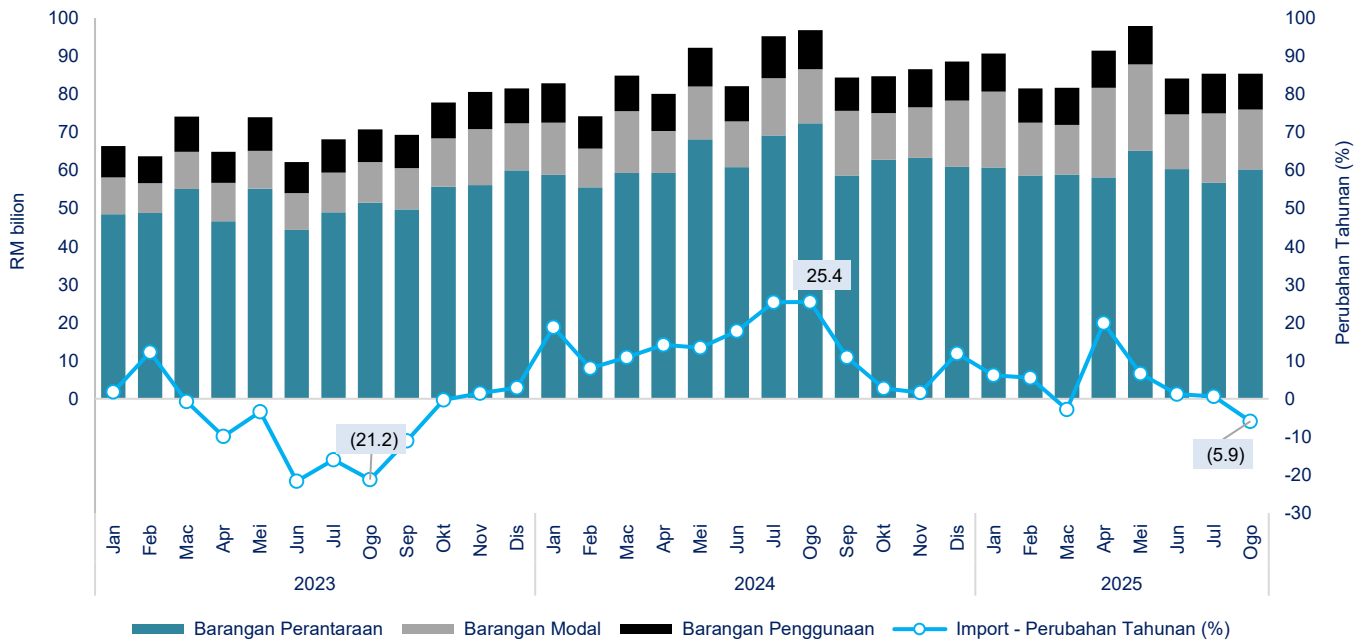
Import susut sebanyak 5.9 peratus kepada RM115.5 bilion

Prestasi Import

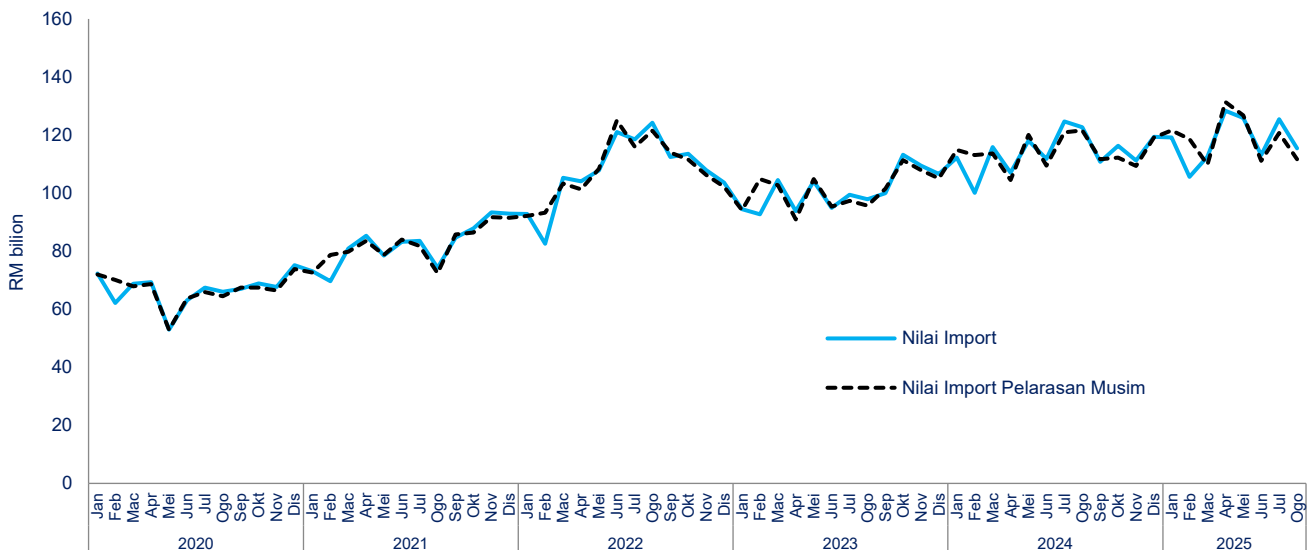
Nilai import Malaysia susut 5.9 peratus atau RM7.3 bilion kepada RM115.5 bilion pada Ogos 2025. Secara bulanan, import mencatatkan penurunan 8.0 peratus atau RM10.0 bilion. Berdasarkan analisis terma pelarasan musim bulan ke bulan, import mencatatkan penurunan 7.5 peratus kepada RM111.7 bilion.

Import mengikut Penggunaan Akhir mencatatkan kenaikan dalam barangan modal (+11.0%) dari tahun ke tahun. Manakala barangan perantara dan barangan penggunaan masing-masing menurun sebanyak 16.8 peratus dan 8.9 peratus.

Prestasi Import mengikut Negara Asal Utama

China dan Taiwan merupakan dua negara utama asal import Malaysia pada Ogos 2025 menyumbang 34.9 peratus daripada jumlah import.

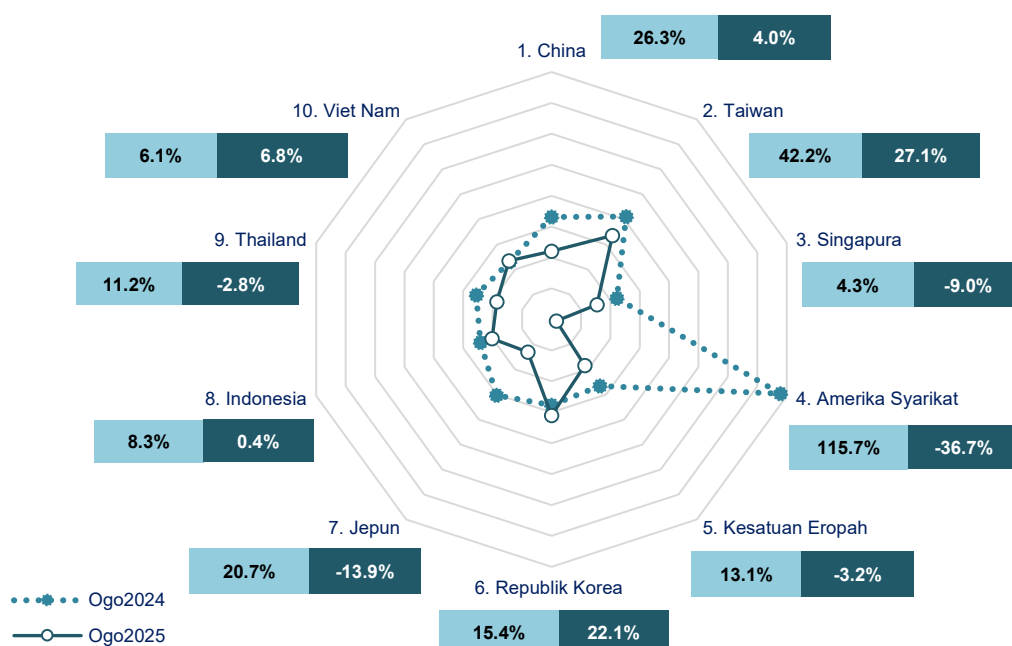
Import Malaysia dari China meningkat 4.0 peratus kepada RM27.5 bilion, merangkumi 23.8 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan import. Peningkatan ini didorong oleh keluaran petroleum yang mencatatkan lonjakan 68.9 peratus (+RM501.9 juta), diikuti oleh barangan perkilangan logam (+RM349.6 juta, +21.6%) dan kelengkapan pengangkutan (+RM271.3 juta, +23.7%).

Import dari Taiwan bernilai RM12.8 bilion, merangkumi 11.1 peratus daripada jumlah

import Malaysia, meningkat 27.1 peratus atau RM2.7 bilion berbanding tahun sebelumnya. Perkembangan ini didorong terutamanya oleh peningkatan import barangan elektrik & elektronik (+RM2.6 bilion, +30.7%) dan keluaran petroleum (+257.8 juta, +125.0%).

Import dari 10 negara asal utama menunjukkan peningkatan dari China, Taiwan, Republik Korea, Indonesia dan Viet Nam. Namun begitu, penurunan dicatatkan bagi Singapura, Amerika Syarikat, Kesatuan Eropah, Jepun dan Thailand berbanding tempoh yang sama pada tahun lalu.

Carta 8: Perubahan Tahunan Import bagi Negara Asal Utama, Ogos 2024 dan Ogos 2025

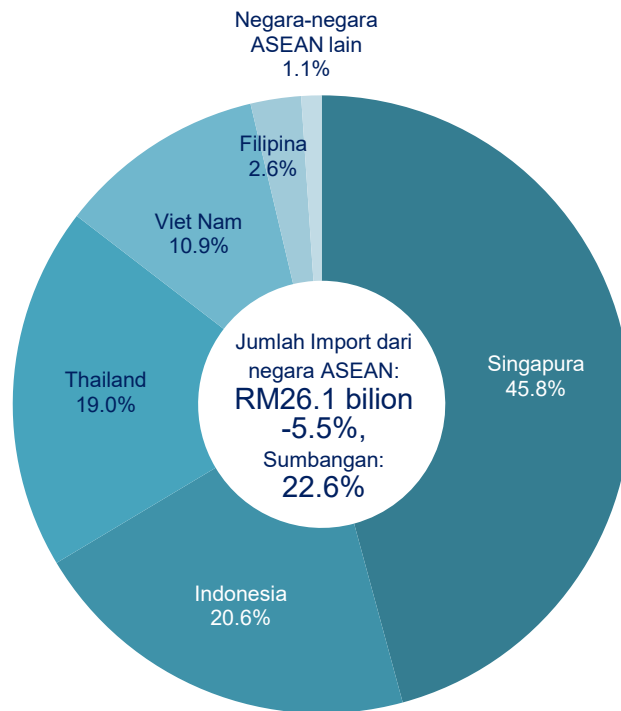


Import dari Negara ASEAN

Import dari negara-negara ASEAN menurun 5.5 peratus pada Ogos 2025, mencecah RM26.1 bilion dan merangkumi 22.6 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan import Malaysia. Penurunan ini didorong oleh pengurangan import hasil galian lain (-RM 541.3 juta, -41.8%), kimia dan bahan kimia (-RM473.7 juta, -22.9%).

Singapura kekal sebagai sumber import terbesar Malaysia dalam kalangan negara ASEAN, meskipun mencatatkan penurunan sebanyak 9.0 peratus (-RM1.2 bilion) berbanding tahun sebelumnya, dengan menyumbang 45.8 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan import.

Prestasi Import mengikut Sektor Ekonomi

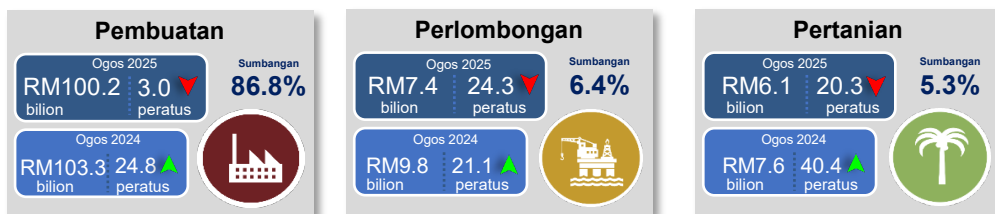
Barangan pembuatan, yang merangkumi 86.8 peratus daripada jumlah import, jatuh 3.0 peratus dari RM103.3 bilion kepada RM100.2 bilion, tahun ke tahun. Prestasi ini didorong oleh penurunan import kimia dan bahan kimia (-RM1.6 bilion, -16.3%); keluaran petroleum (-RM790.6 juta, -8.7%); serta barangan perkilangan logam (+RM637.2 juta, -10.2%).

Import barangan pertanian (5.3% daripada jumlah import) menurun 20.3 peratus (-RM1.6 bilion) tahun ke tahun kepada RM6.1 bilion, didorong

oleh pengurangan import keluaran pertanian lain (-RM1.6 bilion, -28.1%), getah asli (-RM116.1 juta, -20.2%) dan minyak sayuran lain (-RM86.2 juta, -18.4%).

Import barangan perlombongan berjumlah RM7.4 bilion, susut 24.3 peratus berbanding tahun sebelumnya dan menyumbang 6.4 peratus daripada keseluruhan import Malaysia. Penurunan ini didorong oleh pengurangan import hasil galian lain (-RM871.2 juta, -42.6%) dan gas asli cecair (-RM807.2 juta, -83.8%).

Import mengikut Produk Utama Terpilih

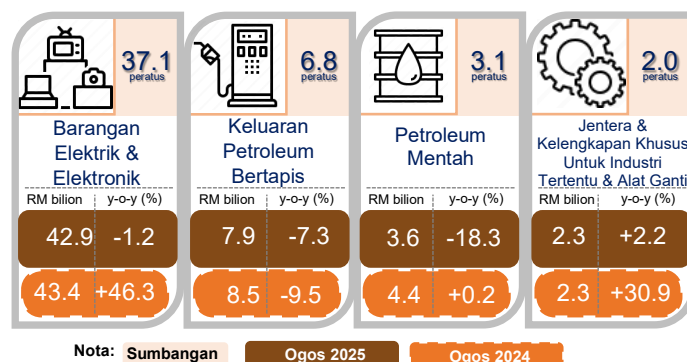
Import menunjukkan kurang memberangsangkan pada Ogos 2025, dengan pertumbuhan positif dilihat dalam produk berikut:

- Jentera & kelengkapan khusus untuk industri tertentu & alat ganti, yang menyumbang 2.0 peratus daripada jumlah import, naik RM51.0 juta atau 2.2 peratus kepada RM2.3 bilion.

Walau bagaimanapun, pertumbuhan negatif direkodkan bagi produk berikut:

- Barangan elektrik & elektronik merangkumi 37.1 peratus daripada jumlah import dan menurun 1.2 peratus atau RM505.0 juta kepada RM42.9 bilion;
- Keluaran petroleum bertapis menyumbang 6.8 peratus daripada jumlah import, menurun RM621.8 juta atau 7.3 peratus kepada RM7.9 bilion. Manakala, Nilai purata seunit mencatatkan penurunan 21.9 peratus; dan
- Import petroleum mentah jatuh 18.3 peratus atau RM802.3 juta kepada RM3.6 bilion, menyumbang 3.1 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan import. Penurunan ini sejajar dengan kejatuhan nilai purata seunit penurunan 22.7 peratus.

Import mengikut Klasifikasi Penggunaan Akhir & Kategori Ekonomi Umum

Jumlah import pada Ogos 2025 bernilai RM115.5 bilion, mencatatkan penurunan sebanyak 5.9 peratus berbanding tahun sebelumnya. Tiga kategori utama import mengikut Penggunaan Akhir, yang merangkumi 73.9 peratus daripada jumlah import, ialah;

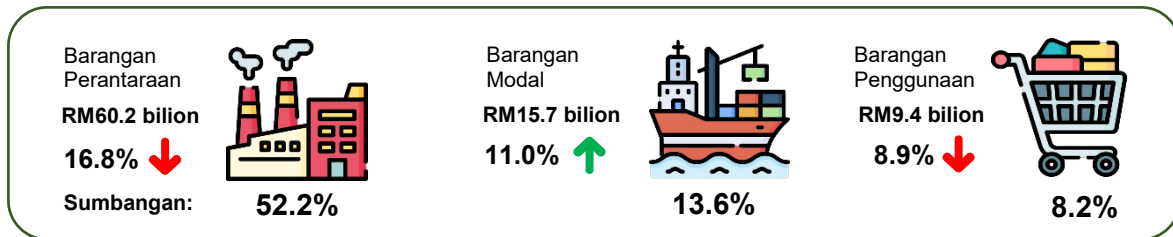
Barangan perantaraan, menyumbang RM60.2 bilion atau 52.2 peratus daripada jumlah import, jatuh 16.8 peratus. Kejatuhan ini disebabkan oleh pengurangan import alat ganti & aksesori barang modal (kecuali alat kelengkapan pengangkutan (-RM4.1 bilion, -15.1%) dan bekalan perindustrian, t.s.t.l., diproses (-RM4.0 bilion, -16.6%).

Barangan modal, meningkat 11.0 peratus kepada RM15.7 bilion (13.6 peratus daripada

jumlah import), didorong oleh peningkatan alat kelengkapan pengangkutan perindustrian 134.8 peratus kepada RM1.9 bilion.

Barangan penggunaan, menurun 8.9 peratus kepada RM9.4 bilion (8.2 peratus daripada jumlah import), disebabkan oleh penurunan makanan dan minuman, diproses, khusus untuk penggunaan isirumah (-RM395.3 juta, -11.6%).

EKSPORT DAN IMPORT MENGIKUT LOKASI

Malaysia mencatatkan jumlah perdagangan bernilai RM247.1 bilion pada Ogos 2025 dengan eksport dan import masing-masing bernilai RM131.6 bilion dan RM115.5 bilion.

Eksport bernilai RM131.6 bilion pada Ogos 2025, meningkat sebanyak RM2.5 bilion (+1.9%) berbanding bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Peningkatan eksport dipengaruhi oleh eksport yang lebih tinggi di Pulau Pinang (+RM5.9 bilion), Johor (+RM1.0 bilion), Sabah (+RM355.3 juta), W.P. Labuan (+RM80.7 juta), Melaka (+RM48.4 juta), Kelantan (+RM37.7 juta) dan Perlis (+RM5.9 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai eksport menurun di Kedah sebanyak RM1.4 bilion, Sarawak (-RM1.1 bilion), Pahang (-RM553.8 juta), Terengganu (-RM411.9 juta), Perak (-RM405.5 juta), Negeri Sembilan (-RM339.5 juta), Selangor (-RM263.0 juta) dan W.P. Kuala Lumpur (-RM197.4 juta).

Pulau Pinang kekal sebagai pengekspor utama dengan sumbangan 36.8 peratus, diikuti oleh

Johor (20.8%), Selangor (17.3%), Sarawak (6.2%) dan W.P. Kuala Lumpur (4.3%).

Sebaliknya, import pada bulan Ogos 2025 menurun RM7.3 bilion (-5.9%) berbanding bulan yang sama pada tahun 2024. Penurunan import disebabkan oleh import yang lebih rendah di kebanyakan negeri iaitu Kedah (-RM4.9 bilion), Melaka (-RM1.3 bilion), Pahang (-RM1.0 bilion), Johor (-RM949.8 juta), Sabah (-RM862.5 juta), W.P. 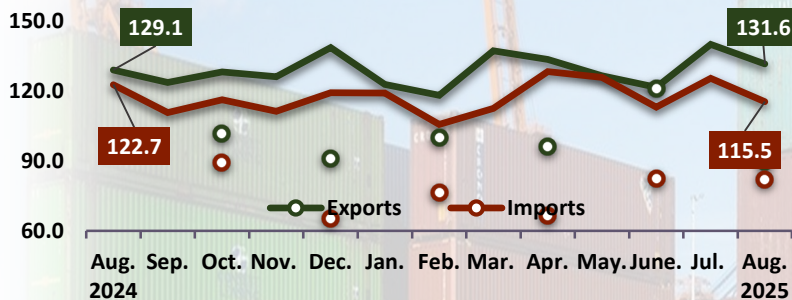

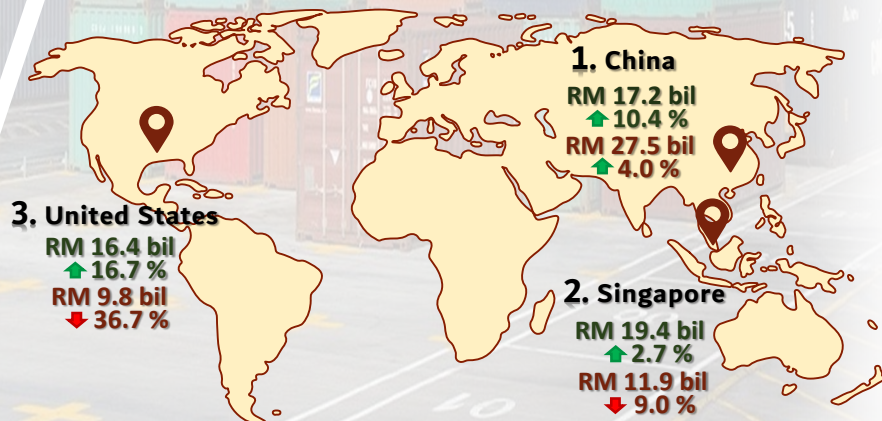

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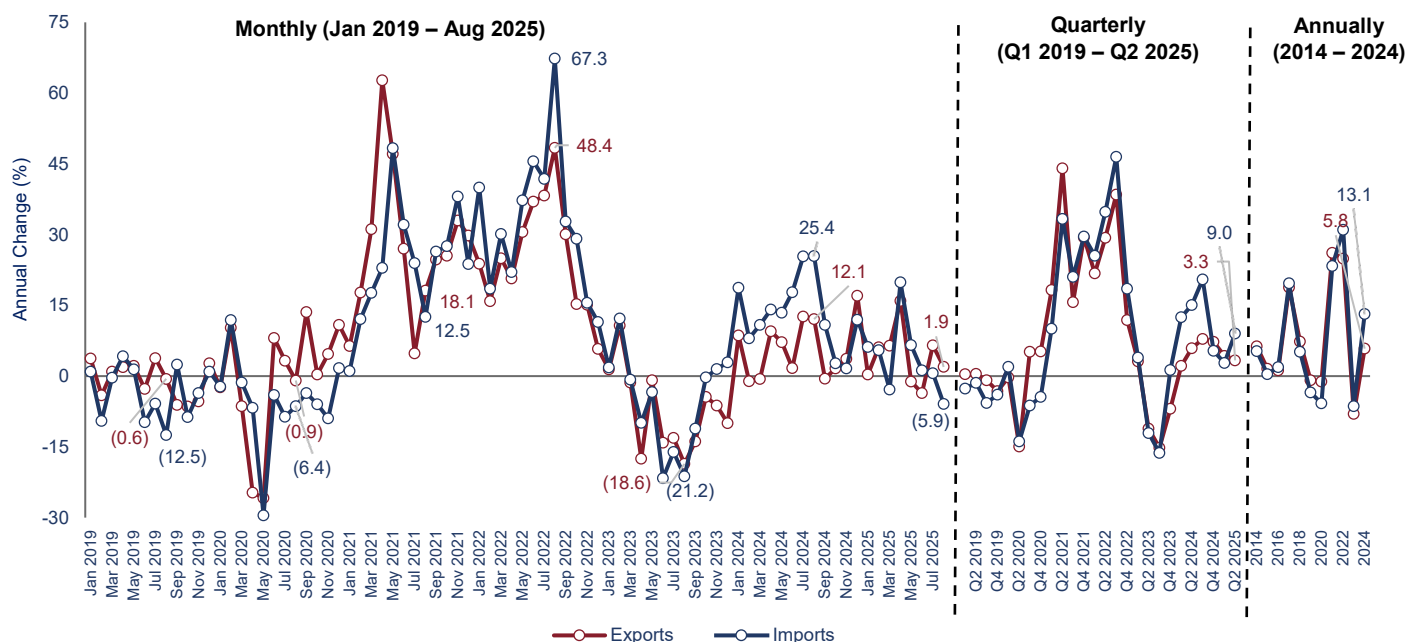
MALAYSIA'S TRADE PERFORMANCE, AUGUST 2025

Malaysia's trade performance in August 2025 showed mixed findings across key sectors. Export value recorded RM131.6 billion, representing an increase of RM2.5 billion or 1.9 per cent compared to the same period last year. Conversely, imports declined to RM115.5 billion, decreasing by RM7.3 billion or 5.9 per cent year-on-year. Total trade fell to RM247.1 billion, down by RM4.8 billion or 1.9 per cent compared to August 2024. Meanwhile, the trade balance recorded a surplus of RM16.1 billion, rising significantly by RM9.8 billion or 153.8 per cent year-on-year.

The monthly comparison showed declines in exports, imports and total trade of 6.0 per cent, 8.0 per cent and 6.9 per cent, respectively. However, the trade surplus recorded an increase of 10.4 per cent or RM1.5 billion.

Exports, imports, total trade and trade surplus from January to August 2025 increased by 3.9 per cent, 3.6 per cent, 3.8 per cent and 7.4 per cent respectively compared to the same period the previous year.

EXPORTS

Malaysia's export performance grew positively by 1.9 per cent to RM131.6 billion in August 2025

Performance of Exports

Malaysia's exports rose by 1.9 per cent in August 2025, rising from RM129.1 billion in August 2024 to RM131.6 billion.

This growth was in line with a 22.6 per cent increase in re-exports, which expanded to RM28.0 billion from RM22.8 billion, accounting for 21.2 per cent of total exports. However, domestic exports, which contributed 78.8 per cent of total

exports, declined by 2.5 per cent to RM103.6 billion.

In addition, on a month-on-month (m-o-m) comparison, exports drop by 6.0 per cent or RM8.5 billion. Based on seasonally adjusted m-o-m terms, exports recorded a fell of 6.3 per cent to RM131.4 billion.

Chart 2: Domestic Exports, Re-Exports (RM billion) and Annual Change (%)

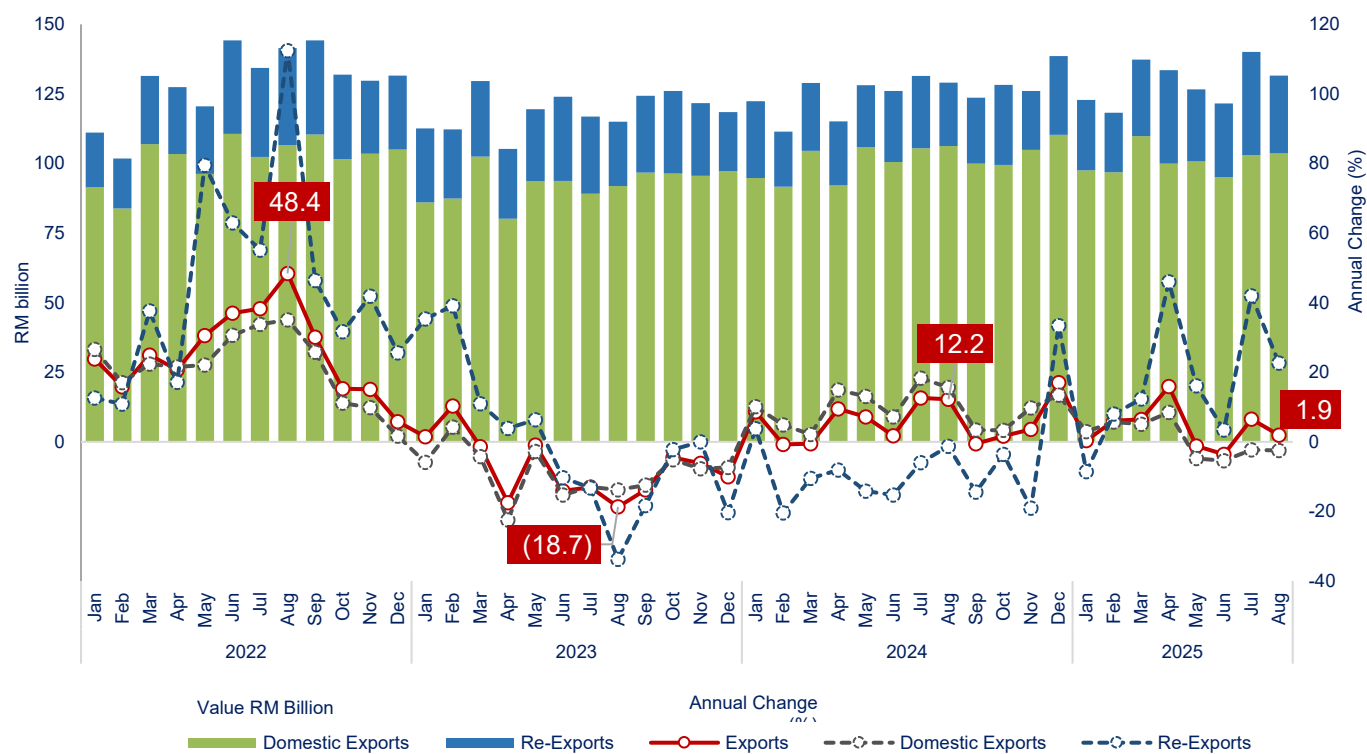
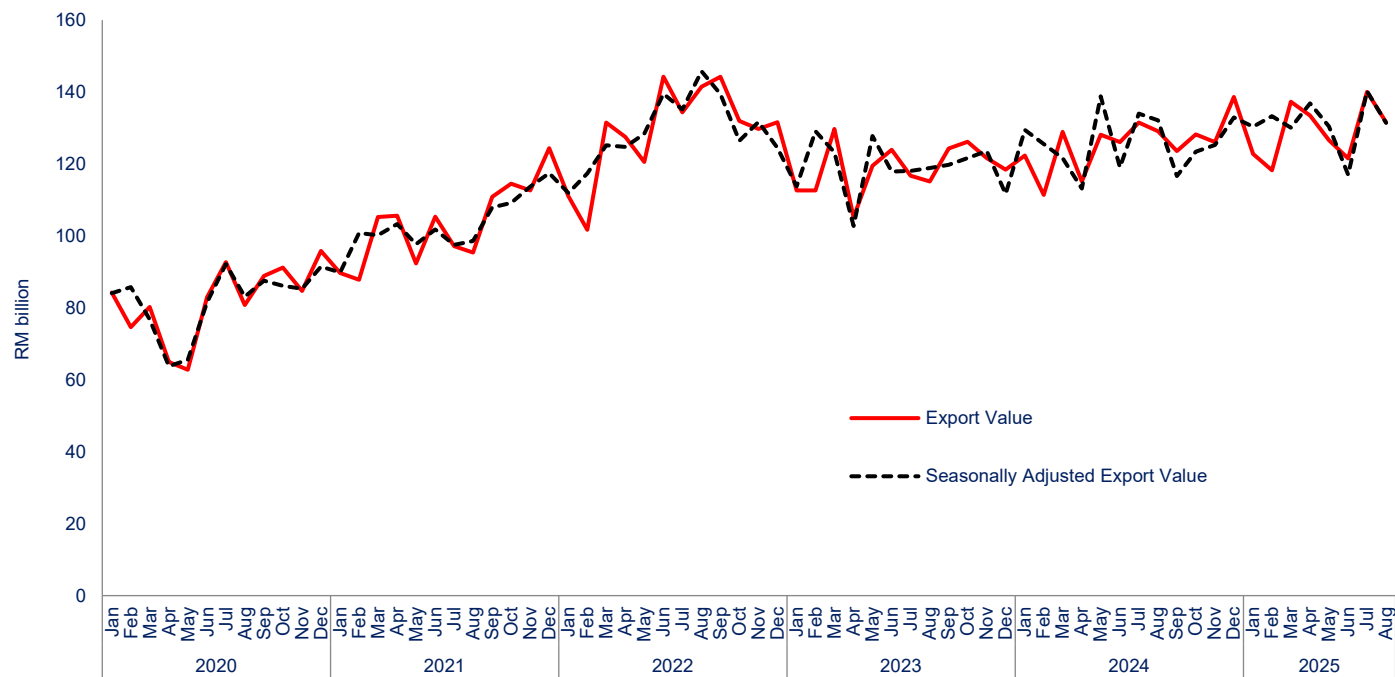


Chart 3: Actual Export Value and Seasonally Adjusted Export Value, RM billion



Export Performance for Major Country of Destination

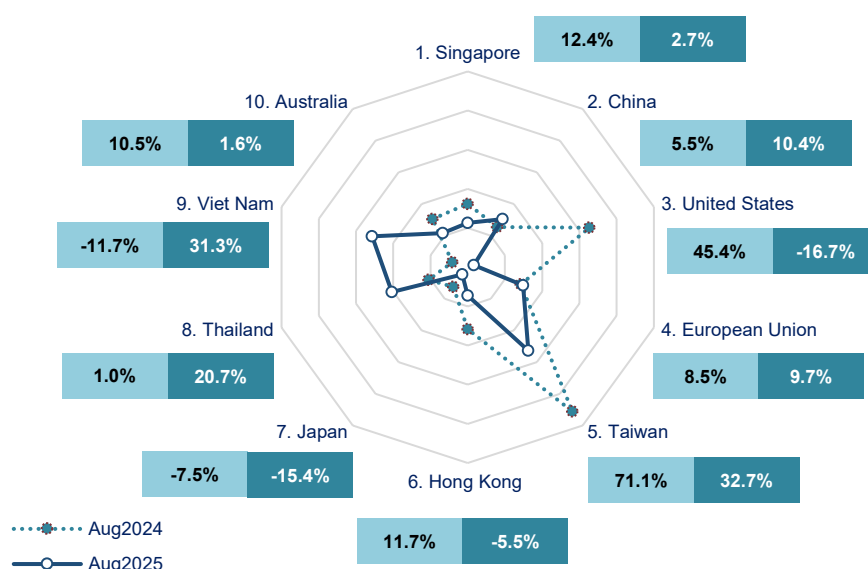
Singapore and China were the main export destinations, contributing a combined 27.8 per cent to Malaysia's total exports in August 2025.

Singapore remained the top export destination, accounting for 14.7 per cent of total exports. Exports to Singapore were valued at RM19.4 billion, an increase of 2.7 per cent or RM509.8 million compared to the previous year. This growth was driven by higher exports of electrical & electronic products (+RM952.0 million, +10.9%) as well as machinery, equipment and parts (+RM255.2 million, +15.2%).

Meanwhile, exports to the China, which made up 13.1 per cent of total exports, amounted to RM17.2 billion, up RM1.6 billion or 10.4 per cent. The increase was supported by higher exports of electrical & electronic products (+RM580.5 million, +10.2%) and metalliferous ores and metal scrap (+RM498.1 million, +106.7%).

Among the top ten export destinations, positive export growth was recorded for Singapore, China, the European Union, Taiwan, Thailand, Viet Nam and Australia. In contrast, the United States, Hong Kong and Japan registered declines in August 2025.

Exports to ASEAN Countries

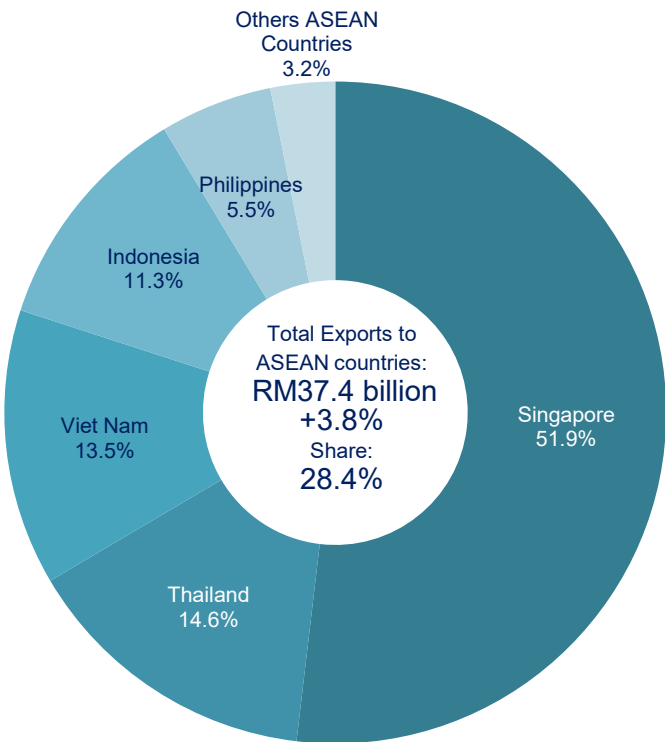
Malaysia's exports to ASEAN countries accounted for 28.4 per cent of total exports, valued at RM37.4 billion, registering an increase of 3.8 per cent.

This growth was mainly driven by higher exports of electrical & electronic products (+RM2.6 billion, +20.7%), followed by optical &

scientific equipment (+RM216.1 million, +23.1%) and other manufactures (+RM191.9 million, +22.1%).

Singapore led among ASEAN member states in overall exports, contributing 51.9 per cent with a value of RM19.4 billion, surging 2.7 per cent compared to the previous year.

Export Performance for Economic Sectors

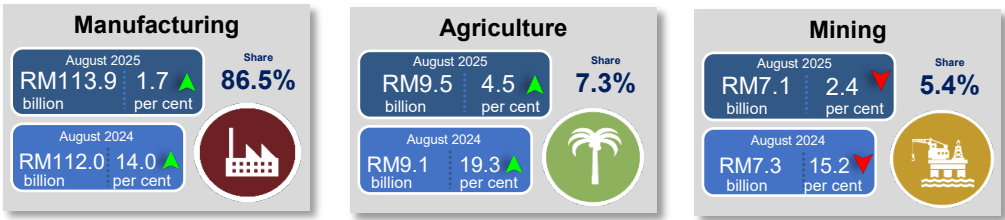
Manufactured goods exports registered an increase of 1.7 per cent (+RM1.9 billion), accounting for 86.5 per cent of total exports. The main contributors to this positive growth were electrical & electronic products (+RM5.1 billion, +10.1%), machinery, equipment & parts (+RM871.7 million, +14.5%), as well as optical & scientific equipment (+RM778.7 million, +14.7%).

Exports of agricultural products increased by 4.5 per cent to RM9.5 billion, accounting for 7.3 per cent of total exports. This increase was

in line with higher exports of palm oil and palm based agriculture products (+RM650.0 million, +9.7%) and other vegetables oil (+RM36.1 million, +11.6%).

Exports of mining products, which accounted for 5.4 per cent of total exports, fell by 2.4 per cent to RM7.1 billion. The decline was attributed to lower exports of crude petroleum (-RM496.4 million, -28.8%), tin (-RM156.2 million, -54.9%) and liquefied natural gas (-RM108.2 million, -2.6%).

Exports of Selected Major Products

Export performance declined in August 2025, however, there was positive growth in the following products:

- Electrical and electronic products, accounting for 42.2 per cent of total exports, grew by 10.1 per cent, from RM50.4 billion to RM55.5 billion; and
- Palm oil & palm-based agricultural products, which accounted for 8.2 per cent of total exports, rose by 9.1 per cent or

RM897.7 million, in line with the increase in palm oil exports. The main commodity in this product group increased by RM183.9 million or 3.3 per cent, driven by a 10.7 per cent rise in local palm oil prices (RM4,329.0 per metric tonne) and a 3.7 per cent increase in average unit value. However, there was a 0.4 per cent decline in export volume.

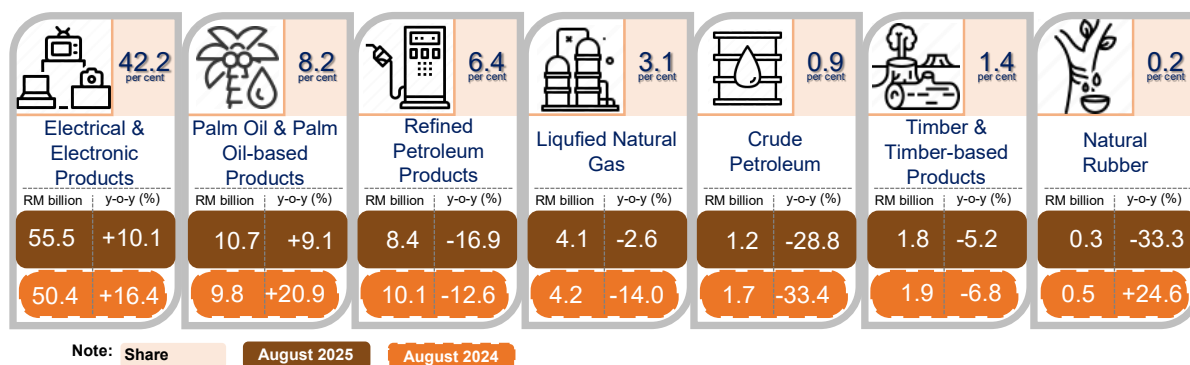
Nonetheless, declines were recorded in the following products:

- Refined petroleum products, which accounted for 6.4 per cent of total exports, declined by 16.9 per cent or RM1.7 billion to RM8.4 billion;
- Liquefied natural gas (LNG), contributing 3.1 per cent to total exports, declined by RM108.2 million or 2.6 per cent to RM4.1 billion. In addition, export volume increased by 21.0 per cent, while the average unit value declined by 19.5 per cent;
- Crude petroleum accounted for 0.9 per cent of total exports, declining by RM496.4 million or 28.8 per cent to RM1.2 billion. This decrease aligned with a drop in export volume (-2.5%) and average

unit value (-27.0%), consistent with the fall in Brent crude oil prices to RM288.3 per barrel;

- Timber & timber-based products decreased by 5.2 per cent or RM101.7 million to RM1.8 billion, contributing 1.4 per cent to total exports; and
- Natural rubber contributed 0.2 per cent to total exports, declining by 33.3 per cent or RM152.6 million to RM305.1 million. This decrease was in line with a reduction in export volume (-31.4%), a 2.8 per cent drop in average unit value and a 6.4 per cent decline in the price of SMR20 rubber.

IMPORTS

Imports declined by 5.9 per cent to RM115.5 billion

Performance of Imports

Malaysia's import value declined by 5.9 per cent or RM7.3 billion to RM115.5 billion in August 2025. On a monthly basis, imports registered a decrease of 8.0 per cent or RM10.0 billion. Based on seasonally adjusted month-on-month terms, imports recorded a decrease of 7.5 per cent to RM111.7 billion.

Imports by End Use registered an increase in capital goods (+11.0%) year-on-year. In contrast, intermediate goods and consumption goods recorded declines of 16.8 per cent and 8.9 per cent, respectively.

Chart 6: Imports Value (RM billion) and Annual Change (%)

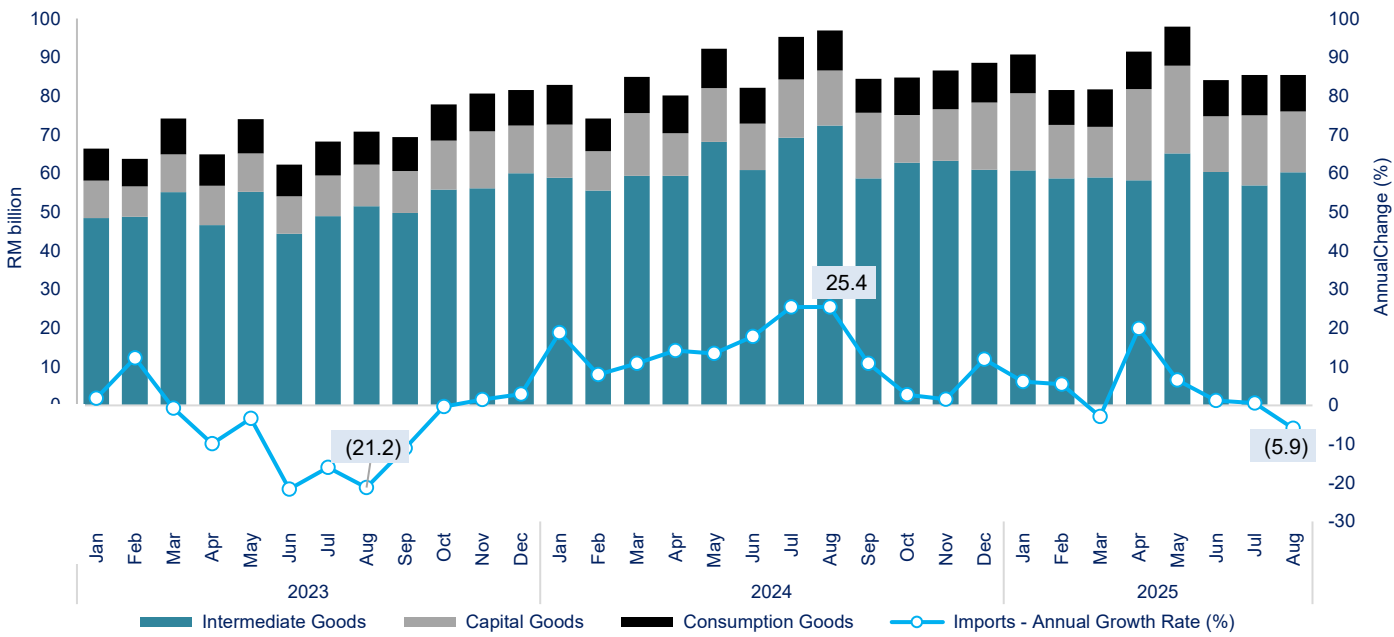
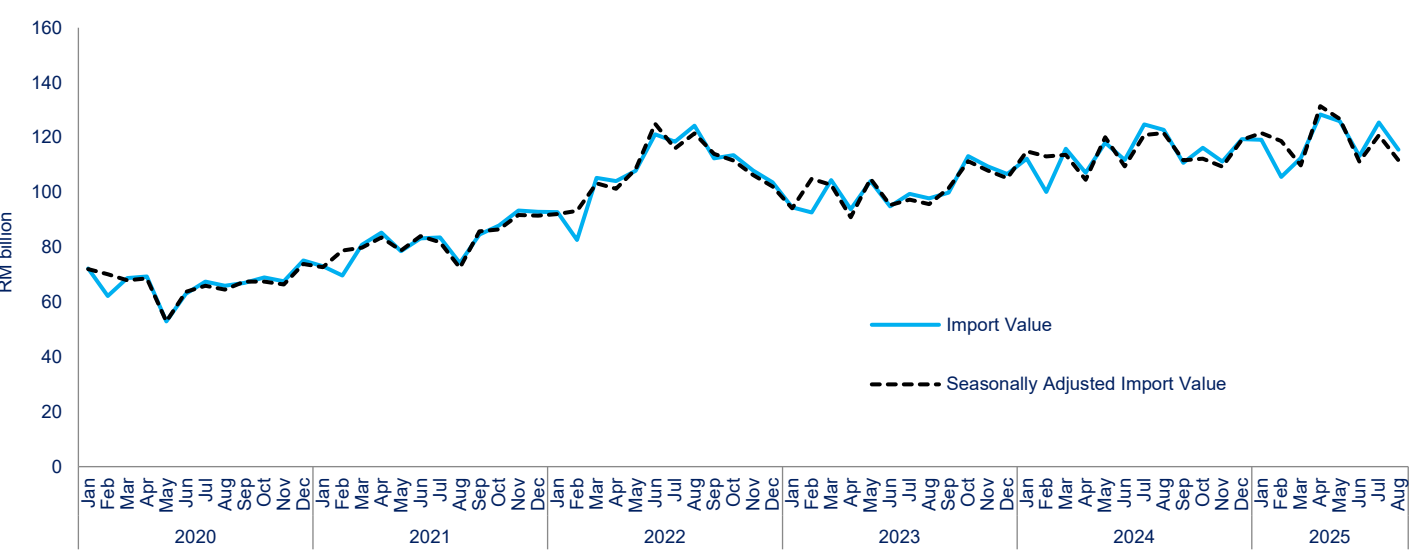


Chart 7: Actual Import Value and Seasonally Adjusted Imports Value, RM billion



Import Performance for Major Country of Origin

China and Taiwan were Malaysia's two major country of origin in August 2025, contributing 34.9 per cent of total imports.

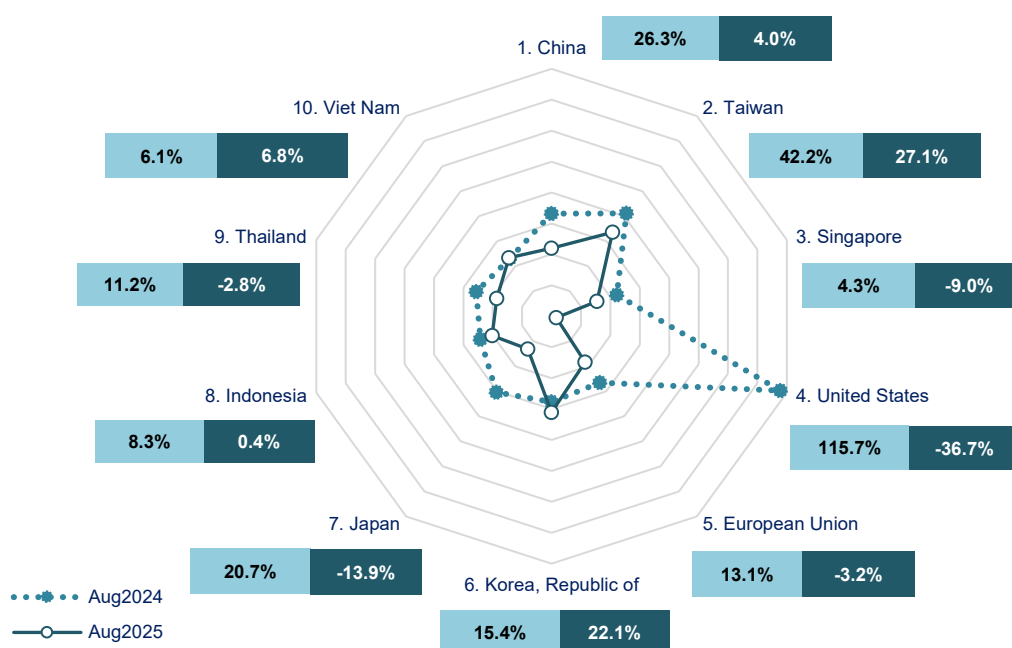
Malaysia's imports from China rose by 4.0 per cent to RM27.5 billion, accounting for 23.8 per cent of total imports. This increase was driven by higher imports of petroleum products by 68.9 per cent (+RM501.9 million), followed by manufacture of metal (+RM349.6 million, +21.6%) and transport equipment (+RM271.3 million, +23.7%).

Imports from Taiwan were valued at RM12.8 billion, representing 11.1 per cent of

Malaysia's total imports, up 27.1 per cent or RM2.7 billion from a year earlier. This growth was mainly driven by higher imports of electrical and electronic products (+RM2.6 billion, +30.7%) and petroleum products (+RM257.8 million, +125.0%).

Among Malaysia's top 10 import sources, increases were recorded from China, Taiwan, Republic of Korea, Indonesia and Viet Nam. However, declines were noted from Singapore, the United States, the European Union, Japan and Thailand compared to the same period last year.

Chart 8: Annual Change for Imports for Major Country of Origin, August 2024 dan August 2025



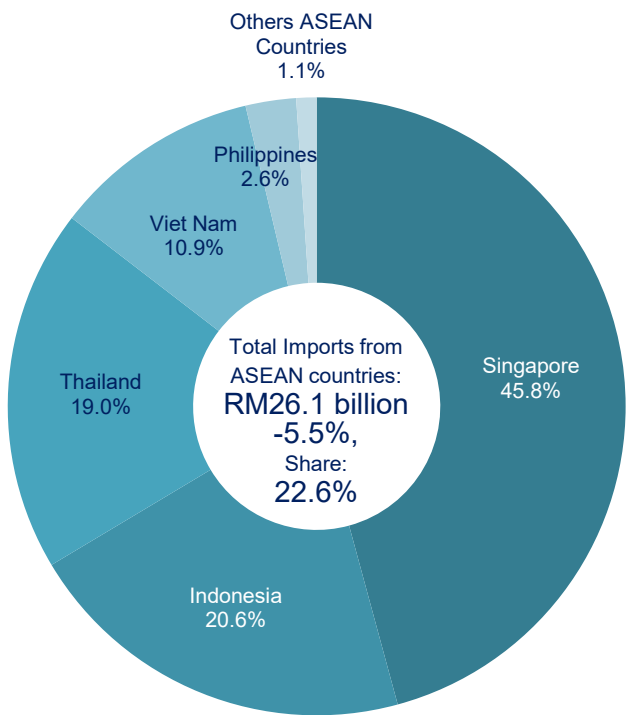
Imports from ASEAN Countries

Imports from ASEAN countries fell by 5.5 per cent in August 2025, amounting to RM26.1 billion and accounting for 22.6 per cent of Malaysia's total imports. The decline was mainly attributed to lower imports of other mining (-RM541.3 million, -41.8%) and

chemical and chemical products (-RM473.7 million, -22.9%).

Singapore remained Malaysia's largest import source within ASEAN, despite a 9.0 per cent decline (-RM1.2 billion) from the previous year, accounting for 45.8 per cent of total imports.

Import Performance for Economic Sectors

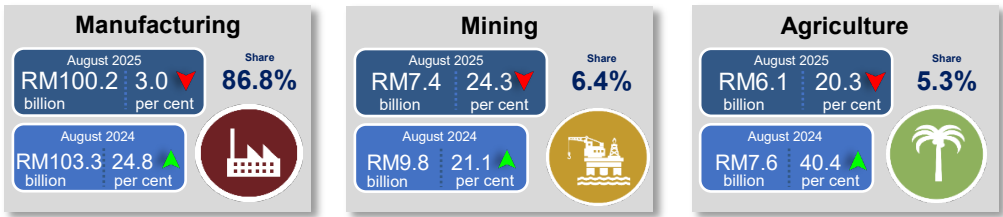
Manufactured goods, which accounted for 86.8 per cent of total imports, fell by 3.0 per cent from RM103.3 billion to RM100.2 billion year on year. This performance was driven by dropped imports of chemical and chemical products (-RM1.6 billion, -16.3%), petroleum products (-RM790.6 million, -8.7%), and manufacture of metal (-RM637.2 million, -10.2%).

Agricultural products (5.3 per cent of total imports), declined by 20.3 per cent (-RM1.6 billion) year-on-year to RM6.1 billion,

mainly due to lower imports of other agricultural products (-RM1.6 billion, -28.1%), natural rubber (-RM116.1 million, -20.2%), and other vegetables oil (-RM86.2 million, -18.4%).

Imports of mining goods totalled RM7.4 billion, down 24.3 per cent from a year earlier and representing 6.4 per cent of Malaysia's total imports. The decrease was mainly attributed to lower imports of other mining products (-RM871.2 million, -42.6%) and liquefied natural gas (-RM807.2 million, -83.8%).

Imports of Selected Major Products

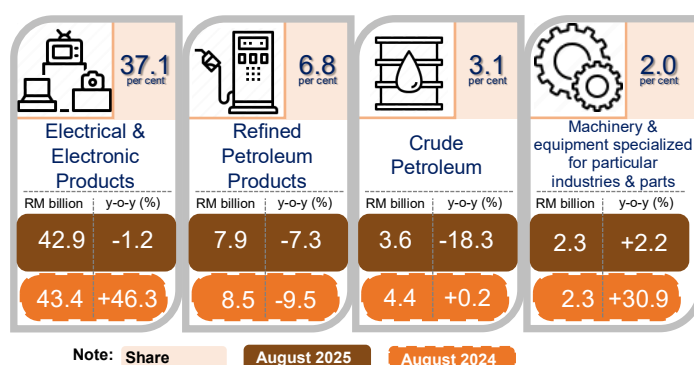
Import performance in August 2025 was not encouraging, with positive growth was recorded for the following products:

- Machinery & equipment specialized for particular industries & parts, representing 2.0 per cent of total imports, rose by RM51.0 million or 2.2 per cent to RM2.3 billion;

Meanwhile, negative growth was noted for the following products:

- Electrical & electronic products, accounting for 37.1 per cent of total imports, dropped by 1.2 per cent or RM505.0 million to RM42.9 billion;
- Refined petroleum products accounted for 6.8 per cent of total imports, fell by RM621.8 million or 7.3 per cent to RM7.9 billion. While, average unit value decreased by 21.9 per cent; and
- Crude petroleum imports decreased by 18.3 per cent or RM802.3 million to RM3.6 billion, representing 3.1 per cent of total imports. This decline is in line with a 22.7 per cent drop in the average unit value.

Imports for End Use & Broad Economic Categories (BEC) Classification

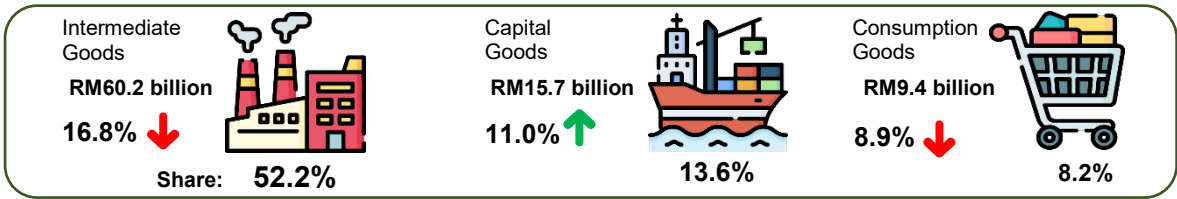
Total imports in August 2025 were valued at RM115.5 billion, recording a decrease of 5.9 per cent compared to the previous year. The three main categories of imports by End Use, which accounted for 73.9 per cent of total imports, were:

Intermediate goods, accounting for RM60.2 billion or 52.2 per cent of total imports, declined by 16.8 per cent. This decrease was due to lower imports of parts & accessories of capital goods (except transport equipment) (-RM4.1 billion, -15.1%) and industrial supplies, n.e.s., processed (-RM4.0 billion, -16.6%).

Capital goods, climbed by 11.0 per cent to RM15.7 billion (13.6 per cent of total imports), driven by higher imports of transport equipment, industrial 134.8 per cent to RM1.9 billion.

Consumption goods, decreased by 8.9 per cent to RM9.4 billion (8.2 per cent of total imports), mainly due to a drop in imports of food & beverages, process, mainly for household consumption (-RM395.3 million, -11.6%).

EXPORTS AND IMPORTS BY LOCATION

Malaysia’s total trade for August 2025 amounted to RM247.1 billion with exports and imports recording RM131.6 billion and RM115.5 billion, respectively.

Exports was valued at RM131.6 billion in August 2025, increased RM2.5 billion (+1.9%) as compared to the same month of the previous year. The increase in exports was attributed to the higher exports in Pulau Pinang (+RM5.9 billion), Johor (+RM1.0 billion), Sabah (+RM355.3 million), W.P. Labuan (+RM80.7 million), Melaka (+RM48.4 million), Kelantan (+RM37.7 million) and Perlis (+RM5.9 million). However, exports decreased in Kedah by RM1.4 billion, Sarawak (-RM1.1 billion), Pahang (-RM553.8 million), Terengganu (-RM411.9 million), Perak (-RM405.5 million), Negeri Sembilan (-RM339.5 million), Selangor (-RM263.0 million) and W.P. Kuala Lumpur (-RM197.4 million).

Pulau Pinang remained as the top exporter with a contribution of 36.8 per cent, followed by

Johor (20.8%), Selangor (17.3%), Sarawak (6.2%) and W.P. Kuala Lumpur (4.3%).

On the contrary, imports in August 2025 decreased RM7.3 billion (-5.9%) as compared to the same month in year 2024. The decrease in imports was attributed by the lower imports in most states such as Kedah (-RM4.9 billion), Melaka (-RM1.3 billion), Pahang (-RM1.0 billion), Johor (-RM949.8 million), Sabah (-RM862.5 million), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (-RM859.2 million), Negeri Sembilan (-RM418.0 million), Sarawak (-RM380.8 million), Terengganu (-RM348.0 million), Perlis (-RM78.8 million), W.P. Labuan (-RM50.6 million) and Kelantan (-RM6.1 million). However, imports increased in Pulau Pinang by RM3.2 billion, Perak (+RM125.5 million) and Selangor (+RM0.1 million).

Selangor dominates Malaysia’s imports with a share of 27.2 per cent, followed by Pulau Pinang (25.1%), Johor (22.1%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (7.6%) and Kedah (4.7%).

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NOTA TEKNIKAL

1. PENGENALAN

Penerbitan ini mengandungi Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri Malaysia (barangan) berkaitan dengan import dan eksport (termasuk eksport semula) mengikut seksyen dan Bahagian barangan, negara asal dan yang dituju, barangan utama / terpilih, Klasifikasi Kategori Ekonomi Umum (BEC) dan penggunaan akhir serta data pelarasan musim.

Statistik ini juga meliputi Perdagangan Luar Negeri Malaysia (barangan) berkaitan import dan eksport di peringkat negeri (mengikut pintu keluar dan masuk) dengan seluruh dunia.

2. OBJEKTIF

Objektif utama penerbitan ini untuk membekalkan statistik tentang prestasi perdagangan Malaysia dengan negara-negara lain dari segi nilai dan volum barangan. Penerbitan ini menjadi input kepada penggubalan dasar, rujukan penting dalam pelaksanaan keputusan, pemantauan dan penilaian keberkesanan program pembangunan negara serta penyelidikan.

3. BIDANG DAN LIPUTAN

3.1 Malaysia menggunakan 'sistem perdagangan umum' dalam penyusunan Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri. Di bawah sistem ini, sempadan negara digunakan sebagai sempadan perangkaan. Semua barang yang dibawa masuk atau keluar dari negara (selain pengecualian yang disebutkan di para 11 di bawah) direkodkan, sama ada barangan itu tertakluk kepada kelulusan tertentu atau pun tidak. Barangan yang dibawa masuk atau keluar dari gudang-gudang simpanan kastam, Zon Bebas direkodkan di dalam perangkaan ini.

3.2 Butir-butir tentang kapal dan kapal terbang dagangan dan persendirian turut **diambil kira** jika ianya diimport atau dieksport sebagai barang yang dibeli, dijual atau disewa (kewangan) tidak kira sama ada ianya tiba atau berlepas dengan kuasanya sendiri.

3.3 Eksport mengikut lokasi adalah berdasarkan negeri asal (iaitu negeri dalam Malaysia di mana peringkat akhir pengeluaran atau pembuatan berlaku). Sebaliknya, import mengikut lokasi berdasarkan negeri destinasi terakhir (iaitu negeri di mana barangan dikeluarkan daripada kawalan Kastam, tetapi tidak semestinya di mana barangan itu akhirnya dijual atau digunakan).

Ketepatan dalam pelaporan negeri asal dan negeri destinasi akhir dalam dokumentasi oleh pihak Jabatan Kastam Diraja Malaysia (JKDM) memberi kesan kepada kualiti statistik perdagangan barangan mengikut lokasi. Dalam hal ini, lokasi pemuatan/pelepasan akan digunakan sebagai proksi bagi negeri asal/destinasi akhir yang sebenar.

3.4 Aktiviti eksport dan import yang berlaku di kawasan Supra (merangkumi aktiviti pengeluaran yang melangkaui pusat kepentingan ekonomi utama bagi mana- mana negeri) atau periklanan yang dilakukan oleh ejen penghantar tidak termasuk dalam penyusunan statistik import dan eksport mengikut lokasi. Nilai import atau eksport bagi W.P. Kuala Lumpur adalah termasuk W.P. Putrajaya.

4. SUMBER DATA

- 4.1 Pengikraran import dan eksport (*hard/soft copy*) yang diluluskan oleh Jabatan Kastam Diraja Malaysia (JKDM) dan Pihak Berkuasa Zon Bebas.
- 4.2 Keterangan mengenai pengiraman bungkusan pos/courier yang dibekalkan oleh Pos Malaysia Berhad.
- 4.3 Penyata dan pengikraran eksport mengenai *bunkers* dan *stores* yang dibekalkan kepada kapal terbang yang dikeluarkan/diluluskan oleh syarikat-syarikat petroleum.
- 4.4 Penyata penjualan barangan yang dibekalkan oleh pengusaha-pengusaha kedai bebas cukai.
- 4.5 Penyata jualan dan belian elektrik yang dikeluarkan oleh syarikat pengeluar

5. KONSEP DAN DEFINISI

- 5.1 Penyusunan statistik ini selaras dengan garis panduan dalam **International Merchandise Trade Statistics: Concepts and Definitions (IMTS) 2010** daripada Pertubuhan Bangsa-Bangsa Bersatu.

5.2 Import

Sesuatu barangan dianggap sebagai import apabila ianya dibawa **masuk** ke dalam negara, sama ada terus ataupun disimpan di gudang dalam kawasan yang dikawalselia oleh pihak Kastam tanpa mengira sama ada barangan tersebut adalah untuk kegunaan sendiri, diproses, digunakan dalam pembuatan ataupun untuk dieksport semula ke negara lain.

5.3 Eksport

Sesuatu barangan (keluaran atau buatan tempatan atau diimport untuk dieksport semula) dianggap sebagai eksport apabila ianya dibawa **keluar** dari negara.

5.4 Eksport Domestik

Sesuatu barangan (keluaran atau buatan tempatan) dianggap sebagai eksport domestik apabila ianya dibawa **keluar** dari negara.

5.5 Eksport Semula

Sesuatu barangan dianggap sebagai eksport semula apabila ianya dibawa **keluar** dari negara dalam keadaan seperti mana ianya **diimport** tanpa mengalami sebarang **perubahan**. Proses membungkus semula, menyisih atau menggred tidak dikira sebagai satu proses perubahan.

5.6 Imbangan Perdagangan

Imbangan perdagangan ialah perbezaan antara nilai eksport dan import. Apabila eksport melebihi import **lebih** direkodkan manakala **defisit** pula dicatatkan apabila import melebihi eksport.

6. ASAS PENILAIAN

- 6.1 **WTO Valuation Agreement (1994)** digunakan sebagai asas penilaian untuk semua transaksi barangan.
- 6.2 **Nilai** ditunjukkan dalam Ringgit Malaysia.
- 6.3 **Import** dinilai mengikut **cif (cost, insurance and freight – kos, insuran dan tambang)** iaitu nilai barangan di pasaran di sempadan statistik/kastam negara pengimport termasuk semua perbelanjaan insuran dan tambang semasa dalam perjalanan **tetapi** kos pemunggahan dari alat pengangkutan tidak diambil kira **kecuali** kos tersebut ditanggung sendiri oleh pengangkut.
- 6.4 **Eksport** dinilai mengikut **fob (free on board)** iaitu nilai barangan di pasaran di sempadan statistik/kastam negara pengeksport termasuk semua perbelanjaan pengangkutan ke sempadan tersebut, duti eksport dan duti lain yang perlu dibayar serta kos untuk memunggah barang ke atas alat pengangkutan **kecuali** kos terakhir itu ditanggung sendiri oleh pengangkut.

7. KLASIFIKASI BARANG DAGANGAN

- 7.1 Penyusunan Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri (barangan) bagi bulan rujukan Januari 2022 hingga Mei 2022 menggunakan Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System (HS) 2017 yang juga dikenali sebagai Perintah Duti Kastam (PDK) 2017. Bermula bulan rujukan Jun 2022, HS2022 yang juga dikenali sebagai PDK2022 telah digunakan menggantikan HS2017. Walau bagaimanapun, pengelasan mengikut Standard International Trade Classification (S.I.T.C) Rev.4 masih digunakan dengan penyesuaian.
- 7.2 Selepas perbincangan dan perundingan dengan Lembaga Minyak Sawit Malaysia (MPOB), pilihan kod untuk minyak kelapa sawit dan hasil keluaran berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit adalah berdasarkan minyak kelapa sawit tulen dan hasil keluaran berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit serta kod-kod yang berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit dan hasil keluaran berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit (melebihi 50%).

8. VOLUM

Volum merupakan berat bersih atau ukuran lain bagi barangan itu, tidak termasuk kontena. Jika barangan itu dilaporkan dalam pelbagai unit ukuran, maka unit ukuran tersebut tidak dapat diselaraskan. Oleh itu, hanya nilai barangan sahaja dipaparkan.

9. NEGARA ASAL DAN YANG DITUJU

- 9.1 **Negara asal** merujuk kepada lokasi / negara barangan yang dibawa masuk ke dalam negara. Jika maklumat negara asalnya tidak dapat ditentukan. Sebagai contoh, bagi barangan melalui Singapura, maka import berkenaan dilaporkan dari Singapura.
- 9.2 **Negara yang dituju** merujuk kepada destinasi/negara akhir barangan itu dijangka akan digunakan. Bagi barangan yang dihantar dengan *optional bill of lading*, negara di mana pelabuhan pertama diketahui akan dilaporkan sebagai negara yang dituju. Jika maklumat negara yang dituju tidak dapat ditentukan. Sebagai contoh, bagi

barangan yang dieksport melalui Singapura, maka eksport berkenaan dilaporkan ke Singapura.

- 9.3 **Bagi bunkers dan stores yang dibekalkan kepada kapal dan kapal terbang,** negara yang dituju ditentukan mengikut lokasi/negara residen syarikat pengendali kapal atau kapal terbang tersebut.

10. TRANSAKSI BERNILAI RENDAH (TBR)

Mulai bulan rujukan Januari 2023, transaksi tunggal 'di bawah RM1,000' bagi Semenanjung Malaysia telah diliputi dalam penyusunan Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri dan transaksi bernilai 'di bawah RM5,000' telah dilaporkan mengikut kod HS yang diikrar. Manakala mulai bulan rujukan Januari 2024, transaksi tunggal 'di bawah RM2,000' untuk Sabah dan Sarawak telah dilaporkan mengikut kod HS yang diikrar.

11. PENGECEUALIAN

Barang-barang yang tidak termasuk dalam Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri adalah:

- 11.1 barangan transit, iaitu pengangkutan barangan di bawah kawalan kastam dari sebuah stesen kastam ke sebuah stesen kastam yang lain. Misalnya, pergerakan barangan dari Thailand ke Singapura melalui Semenanjung Malaysia dan pergerakan barangan dari sebuah zon bebas ke sebuah zon bebas yang lain di Malaysia. Barang dalam transit yang diliputi *through bills of lading* / *air-way bills* juga termasuk di bawah kategori ini;
- 11.2 barangan pindah kapal, iaitu pemindahan barangan di bawah kawalan pihak yang berkuasa, dari suatu pengangkutan yang digunakan untuk pengimportan kepada suatu pengangkutan lain yang digunakan untuk pengeksportan **dalam** kawasan kawalan pihak berkuasa yang sama. Stesen ini merupakan stesen pengimportan dan juga pengeksportan. Sebagai contoh, barangan dari Myanmar yang dibawa masuk ke kawasan kastam Pulau Pinang yang semata-mata bertujuan untuk dihantar ke negara ketiga (misalnya ke Hong Kong). Satu lagi contoh adalah barangan dari India yang dibawa masuk melalui Kawasan Bebas Pelabuhan Klang yang semata-mata bertujuan untuk dihantar ke Negara Ketiga (misalnya ke Sepanyol);
- 11.3 emas (kewangan) dan wang kertas serta duit syiling dalam edaran;
- 11.4 barangan yang diimport dan dieksport oleh, atau bagi pihak perkhidmatan diplomatik dan Angkatan Tentera Bukan Malaysia;
- 11.5 filem wayang untuk disewa;
- 11.6 kemasukan barangan untuk sementara waktu dan ianya tertakluk kepada pengeksportan semula dalam keadaan yang sama. Barangan ini diimport untuk tujuan tertentu dan dieksport semula dalam masa yang telah ditentukan tanpa mengalami sebarang perubahan, kecuali susut nilai yang biasa. Contohnya, binatang dan motokar bagi pertunjukan sarkas, perlumbaan, pertandingan dan pameran serta peralatan-peralatan bunyi untuk pertunjukan muzikal;
- 11.7 *barges (lash)* yang digunakan untuk mengangkut kargo dari kapal ke pantai atau sebaliknya;

- 11.8 ikan dan hasil laut lain yang dibawa oleh kapal laut berdaftar di Malaysia dan mendarat terus dari laut.
- 11.9 bekas untuk menyimpan sesuatu barang/benda, silinder, botol dan seumpamanya yang dinyatakan sebagai 'dikembalikan';
- 11.10 bekalan dan minyak yang dibekalkan kepada kapal laut dan kapal terbang yang dikendalikan oleh operator yang menetap di Malaysia;
- 11.11 semua sampel, pemberian dan bahan untuk ujian atau analisa tanpa mengira nilai transaksi yang terlibat;
- 11.12 tiket loteri & toto;
- 11.13 pergerakan barangan di antara Negeri di dalam Semenanjung Malaysia tanpa mengira cara pengangkutan serta pergerakan barangan melalui **darat** di antara Sabah dan Sarawak;
- 11.14 disket atau CD-ROM yang mengandungi perisian komputer dan / atau data, dibuat mengikut pesanan, audio dan videotapes yang mengandungi perakaman asal dan customised blueprints, dll; dan
- 11.15 barangan untuk **dibaiki**.

12. KEMASKINI TERHADAP NEGARA-NEGARA KESATUAN EROPAH (EU)

Bermula 1 Februari 2020, United Kingdom secara rasminya keluar daripada EU. Perkembangan ini telah diambil kira di dalam penerbitan mulai bulan Februari 2020 dan seterusnya.

- 13. Bermula rujukan Januari 2022, Statistik Eksport Produk Halal mengikut Pengelasan Barangan disusun daripada hasil gabungan pangkalan data Perdagangan Luar Negeri dengan senarai syarikat berstatus halal yang diperoleh daripada Jabatan Kemajuan Islam Malaysia (JAKIM).

14. PELARASAN MUSIM

Data siri masa adalah amat berguna untuk ahli ekonomi, pembuat dasar dan polisi serta penganalisis siri masa untuk mengenal pasti ciri-ciri penting siri ekonomi seperti arah, *turning point* dan konsistensi antara penunjuk ekonomi yang lain. Kadang-kadang ciri ini sukar untuk diperhatikan kerana pergerakan bermusim. Oleh itu, sekiranya kesan bermusim boleh disingkirkan, perilaku data siri ini dapat dilihat dengan lebih baik. Anggaran dan penyingkiran kesan bermusim dipanggil pelarasan bermusim.

Pelarasan bermusim adalah satu proses untuk mengenal pasti dan menyingkirkan bentuk pola bermusim yang biasa berlaku dalam tempoh satu tahun, yang mungkin juga merangkumi pengaruh dari kesan cuti yang bergerak dan hari bekerja/ berdagang bagi suatu tempoh. Objektif utama proses ini adalah untuk menyerlahkan dasar arah aliran dan pergerakan-pergerakan jangka pendek dalam siri ini.

Di Malaysia, kebanyakan data siri masa terjejas oleh kesan bermusim. Oleh itu, untuk menghapuskan kesan bermusim dan juga melaraskan musim data siri masa ekonomi Malaysia, pakej pelarasan bermusim standard, X-12 ARIMA telah digunakan oleh Jabatan Perangkaan, Malaysia.

Data siri masa ekonomi Malaysia kerap dipengaruhi oleh perayaan agama utama seperti Aidilfitri bagi umat Islam, Tahun Baru Cina untuk kaum Cina dan Deepavali untuk kaum India. Tarikh perayaan-perayaan ini tetap mengikut tahun lunar tetapi berbeza-beza mengikut kalendar Gregorian. Oleh itu, untuk menganggar dan menyingkirkan kesan cuti yang bergerak dari data siri masa, satu prosedur telah dibangunkan iaitu *Seasonal Adjustment for Malaysia* (SEAM).

Kaedah SEAM digunakan untuk membuang kesan bermusim bagi data Perdagangan Luar Negeri Malaysia. Pelarasan musim dibuat ke atas data bulanan bagi jumlah eksport dan import. Data siri pelarasan bermusim untuk tiga tahun sebelumnya akan disemak setiap tahun apabila data untuk 12 bulan lengkap.

15. KLASIFIKASI MENGIKUT KATEGORI EKONOMI UMUM (BEC)

- 15.1 Klasifikasi mengikut Kategori Ekonomi Umum (BEC) diwujudkan adalah untuk meringkaskan Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri (PPLN) mengikut kelas komoditi ekonomi yang luas. Di samping itu, ia dibentuk sebagai pengantara untuk menukarkan data PPLN yang disusun berdasarkan HS kepada kategori penggunaan akhir yang lebih bermakna dalam konteks Sistem Akaun Negara (SNA) iaitu barang modal, barang pengantara dan barang penggunaan. Penyusunan ini membolehkan data PPLN dihubungkan dengan perangkaan ekonomi umum seperti perangkaan akaun negara dan perangkaan perindustrian bagi tujuan penganalisan ekonomi di peringkat negara, kawasan dan dunia.
- 15.2 BEC termasuk sembilan belas kategori asas. Setiap kategori BEC didefinisikan dari segi bahagian, kumpulan, sub-kumpulan dan tajuk HS. Setiap tajuk asas HS ditetapkan secara khusus kepada satu kategori BEC. Penetapan ini dibuat berasaskan penggunaan akhir yang utama bagi sesuatu komoditi dalam setiap tajuk HS, walaupun erdapat banyak komoditi yang didagangkan di peringkat antarabangsa boleh dikelaskan kepada pelbagai kegunaan.
- 15.3 Statistik dalam Jadual 16: Import Barangan Mengikut Klasifikasi Kategori Ekonomi Umum dijana berdasarkan import tertangguh iaitu import tolak eksport semula. Angka tersebut boleh menjadi negatif bagi bulan rujukan tertentu jika eksport semula melebihi daripada import.

16. KERAHSIAAN DATA

Data perdagangan telah disusun di bawah peruntukan ***Statistics Act 1965 (Revised-1989)***. Akta ini mensyaratkan bahawa kandungan penyata individu adalah sulit. Selaras dengan peruntukan tersebut, hanya angka agregat diterbitkan.

17. DASAR PINDAAN

Data pada bulan semasa adalah sementara (provisional) dan tertakluk kepada pindaan sehingga ia dimuktamadkan. Pindaan dibuat sekiranya wujud maklumat tambahan. Bermula tahun 2021, data muktamad akan dikeluarkan 7 (tujuh) bulan selepas tahun rujukan. Perangkaan muktamad perdagangan luar negeri bagi tahun rujukan 2021 telah digunakan mulai bulan rujukan Jun 2022.

18. PEMBUNDARAN

Jumlah-jumlah kecil, apabila dicampurkan, **mungkin** tidak bersamaan dengan jumlah besar disebabkan oleh pembundaran.

TECHNICAL NOTES

1. INTRODUCTION

This publication contains statistics of Malaysia's External trade (merchandise) pertaining to imports and exports (including re-exports) by sections, divisions and groups of commodity, country of origin and destination, selected/major commodities, Broad Economic Category (BEC) classification and end-use as well as seasonally adjusted data.

This publication also contains statistics of Malaysia's External Trade (merchandise) on imports and exports at the state level (based on exit and entry points) with the rest of the world.

2. OBJECTIVE

The main objective of compiling Malaysia's external trade statistics is to provide information on Malaysia's trade performance vis-a-vis the rest of the world in terms of volume and value of merchandise goods. The trade statistics, therefore, serve as a tool in assisting the government in formulating policies and monitoring economic performance as well as for development planning. The data can also be used by the private sector and individuals for specific purposes such as for economic projection and analysis.

3. SCOPE AND COVERAGE

3.1 *The 'general trade system' of recording is adopted in compiling Malaysian external trade statistics. Under this system, the national boundary of the country is used as the statistical frontier. All goods entering or leaving the country (except specific exclusions mentioned in paragraph 11 below) are recorded, whether or not such goods are subject to clearance. Accordingly, goods entering or leaving customs bonded warehouses, Free Zones are recorded in the statistics.*

3.2 *Details of commercial and private ships and aircraft are also **included** in these statistics if they were imported or exported as goods purchased, sold or leased (financial) whether or not they arrived or departed under their own power.*

3.3 *Exports by location based on the state of origin (i.e. state of Malaysia where the final stage of production or manufacturing occurs). On the other hand, imports by location based on the state of final destination (i.e. the state of Malaysia in which goods are released from Customs controls, but not necessarily where they are ultimately sold or consumed).*

The accuracy in reporting the actual State of origin and State of final destination on Royal Malaysian Customs Department documentation affects the quality of State merchandise trade statistics. In this case, the location of loading/discharge may be used as a proxy for the actual state of origin/final destination.

3.4 *Export and import activities that are taking place in the Supra area (including production activities beyond the centre of predominant economic interest for any state) or declarations made by the agent are not included in the compilation of imports and exports statistics by location. Imports or exports value for the W.P. Kuala Lumpur includes the W.P. Putrajaya.*

4. SOURCE OF DATA

- 4.1 *Import and export declarations (hard/soft copy) approved by the Royal Malaysian Customs Department (RMCD) and Free Zone Authorities.*
- 4.2 *Particulars on postal/courier packages are provided by Pos Malaysia Berhad.*
- 4.3 *Statements and export declarations on bunkers and stores supplied to aircraft issued/approved by the petroleum companies.*
- 4.4 *Statements on goods sold are supplied by the operators of duty-free shops.*
- 4.5 *Statements on the sale and purchase of electricity issued by 'power producer company'.*

5. CONCEPTS AND DEFINITIONS

- 5.1 *The compilation of these statistics is in accordance with the guidelines of the **International Merchandise Trade Statistics: Concepts and Definitions (IMTS) 2010** from the **United Nations**.*

5.2 **Imports**

*Goods are regarded as imports when they are brought **into** the country either directly or into bonded warehouses, irrespective of whether such goods are for consumption, to be processed, use in manufacturing or subsequent re-exports to other countries.*

5.3 **Exports**

*Goods (locally produced or manufactured or imported for subsequent re-exports) are regarded as exports when they are taken **out** of the country.*

5.4 **Domestic Exports**

*Goods (locally produced or manufactured) are regarded as domestic exports when they are taken **out** of the country.*

5.5 **Re-exports**

*Goods are regarded as re-exports when they are taken **out** of the country in the same form as they were **imported** without any **transformation**. Re-packing, sorting or grading processes are not considered as part of the transformation process.*

5.6 **Balance of Trade**

*The balance of trade is the difference between the value of exports and imports. When exports exceed imports it is recorded as a **surplus** while a **deficit** is registered when imports exceed exports.*

6. BASIS OF VALUATION

- 6.1 *The **WTO Valuation Agreement (1994)** is used as the basis of valuation for all transactions of goods.*
- 6.2 ***Values** are shown in Malaysian Ringgit.*

- 6.3 **Imports** are valued on a **c.i.f. (cost, insurance and freight)** basis, that is, the value of the goods in the market at the statistical / customs frontier of the importing country, including all charges for transport and insurance whilst in transit **but** excluding the cost of unloading from the carrier **unless** it is borne by the carrier.
- 6.4 **Exports** are valued on a **f.o.b. (free on board)** basis, that is, the value of the goods in the market at the statistical / customs frontier of the exporting country, including all costs of transporting the goods to the statistical / customs frontier, export and other duties payable as well as the cost of loading the goods onto the carrier **unless** the latter cost is borne by the carrier.

7. CLASSIFICATION OF COMMODITIES

- 7.1 The compilation of External Trade Statistics (merchandise) for the reference month of January 2022 to May 2022 used the Harmonised Commodity description and Coding system (HS) 2017, also known as Customs Duties Order (PDK) 2017. Commencing from the reference month of June 2022, HS2022 also known as PDK2022 has been used to replace HS2017. However, Standard International Trade Classification (S.I.T.C) Rev.4 is still in use with appropriate updates.
- 7.2 After discussion and consultation with Malaysian Palm Oil Board (MPOB), the selection of codes for palm oil and palm oil-based products is based on pure palm oil and palm oil-based products as well as those codes which are predominantly palm oil and palm oil-based products (more than 50%).

8. VOLUME

Volume, where shown, represent the nett weight or other measurement of the goods exclusive of packing containers. Where a commodity item comprises different kinds of commodities for which a common unit of measurement cannot be used, only values are shown.

9. COUNTRY OF ORIGIN AND DESTINATION

- 9.1 **Country of origin** refers to the location/country of goods brought into the country. If the country of origin information cannot be determined, for example, for goods via Singapore, then the import is reported from Singapore.
- 9.2 **Country of destination** refers to the final destination/country where the goods are expected to be used. For goods sent with a country where the first port is known will be reported as the country of destination. if the destination country information cannot be determined, for example, for goods exported through Singapore, then the exports is reported to Singapore.
- 9.3 **For bunkers and stores supplied to ships and aircraft**, the country of destination is determined according to the country of residence of the operator of the ship or aircraft.

10. LOW VALUE TRANSACTIONS (LVT)

With effect from reference month of January 2023, single transactions with a value 'below RM1,000' for Peninsular Malaysia have been covered in the compilation of External Trade Statistics and transactions worth 'below RM5,000' have been reported according to the pledged HS code. Meanwhile with effect from reference month of January 2024, single transactions with a value 'below RM2,000' for Sabah and Sarawak have been reported according to the pledged HS code.

11. EXCLUSIONS

Classes of goods excluded from external trade statistics are: -

- 11.1 transit cargo, that is goods transported under customs control from one Customs office to another. Examples are the movement of goods from Thailand bound for Singapore through Peninsular Malaysia and the movement of goods within Malaysia from one free trade zone to another. All goods in transit covered through bills of lading/air-way bills are also included in this category;*
- 11.2 transshipment cargo, that is goods transferred under the control of the relevant authorities from the importing means of transport to the exporting means of transport **within** the area of control of the same authorities, which is the office of both importation and exportation. For example, goods from Myanmar brought into the Pulau Pinang Customs area for the sole purpose of transport to a third country (e.g. to Hong Kong). Another example is goods from India brought into the Port Klang Free Zone for the sole purpose of transport to a third country (e.g. to Spain);*
- 11.3 gold bullion (monetary) and issued currency notes and coins;*
- 11.4 goods imported and exported by, or on behalf of, diplomatic services and non-Malaysian Armed Forces;*
- 11.5 exposed cinematographic films on a rental basis;*
- 11.6 temporary admission of goods subject to re-exportation in the same state. Such goods must be imported for a specific purpose and must be intended for re-exportation within a specified period without having undergone any change except normal depreciation. Examples are animals and cars for circuses, races, competitions and exhibitions and instruments/sound equipment for musical performances;*
- 11.7 barges (lash) used for the transportation of cargo from vessel to shore or vice-versa;*
- 11.8 fish and other marine produce landed by Malaysian registered vessels direct from the sea;*
- 11.9 containers, cylinders, bottles, crates and the like specified as returnable;*
- 11.10 stores and fuel supplied to ships and aircraft handled by operators of Malaysian residence;*
- 11.11 samples, gifts and specimens for test or analysis, irrespective of value;*
- 11.12 toto & lottery tickets;*

11.13 movement of goods by any mode of transportation between states within Peninsular Malaysia and movement of goods by **land** between Sabah and Sarawak;

11.14 diskettes or CD-ROMs with stored computer software and/or data, developed to order, audio and videotapes containing original recordings and customised blueprints, etc; and

11.15 goods for **repair**.

12. **UPDATE TO EUROPEAN UNION (EU) COUNTRIES**

From 1st July 2013, Croatia has joined EU. This development has been incorporated in the publication from July 2013 onwards.

13. *Commencing from January 2022, statistics on Exports of Halal Products by Commodity Classification is compiled from an integrated external trade database with list of Halal certified companies which obtained from the Department of Islamic Development Malaysia (JAKIM).*

14. **SEASONAL ADJUSTMENT**

Time-series data are very useful for economists, policy & decision makers and time-series analysts to identify the important features of economic series such as direction, turning point and consistency between other economic indicators. Sometimes this feature is difficult to observe because of seasonal movements. Thus, if the seasonal effect can be removed, the behaviour of the series would be better viewed. The estimation and removal of the seasonal effects is called seasonal adjustment.

Seasonal adjustment is a process to identify and to remove the regular within-a-year seasonal pattern, which may also include the influences of moving holidays and working / trading days effect in each period. The ultimate objective of the process is to highlight the underlying trends and short-term movements in the series.

In Malaysia, most of the time series data are affected by seasonal effects. Hence, to eliminate the seasonal effect as well as to seasonally adjust the Malaysian economic time series data, a standard seasonal adjustment package, X-12 ARIMA was used by Department of Statistics, Malaysia.

Malaysian economic time series data are often affected by major religious festivals such as Eid-ul Fitr of the Muslims, Chinese New Year of the Chinese and Deepavali of the Indians. These festivals' dates are fixed according to the lunar year but vary according to the Gregorian calendar. Therefore, to estimate and remove moving holiday effect from time-series data, a procedure was developed, namely Seasonal Adjustment for Malaysia (SEAM).

The SEAM method is used to remove seasonal effect for Malaysia's merchandise external trade data. The seasonal adjustment is carried out on monthly total exports and total imports. The seasonally adjusted series data for the preceding three years are revised each year when the figures for complete 12 months become available.

15. CLASSIFICATION BY BROAD ECONOMIC CATEGORIES (BEC)

- 15.1 The BEC was originally devised mainly for the summarization of data on international trade by large economic classes of commodities. In addition, it was designed to serve as a means for converting external trade data compiled on the HS into end use categories that are meaningful within the framework of the System of National Accounts (SNA) namely capital goods, intermediate goods, and consumption goods. This aggregation permits external trade statistics to be considered jointly with other sets of general economic statistics such as national accounts and industrial statistics for national, regional or world level economic analysis.
- 15.2 The BEC includes nineteen basic categories. Each category of the BEC is defined in terms of divisions, groups, sub-groups and basic headings of HS. Each HS basic heading is allocated entirely to one BEC category. The allocation is done on the basis of the main end use of the commodities in each HS basic heading, although it is recognised that many commodities that are traded internationally may be put to a variety of uses.
- 15.3 The statistics in Table 16: Imports of Commodities by Broad Economic Categories Classifications are generated based on retained imports i.e. imports minus re-exports. The figure could be negative for a reference month if re-exports are higher than imports.

16. CONFIDENTIALITY REQUIREMENTS

The trade data statistics have been compiled under the provisions of the **Statistics Act 1965 (Revised-1989)**. The Act stipulates that the contents of individual returns are **confidential**. In conformity with the said stipulation, only aggregated figures are published.

17. REVISION POLICY

Data for the current month is provisional and subject to revision until it is finalised. Revisions are made if there are additional information. Starting 2021, final data will be released by 7 (seven) months after reference year. Final external trade statistics for reference year 2021 was used from reference month June 2022.

18. ROUNDING

Sub-totals **may** not add up exactly to totals due to rounding.
