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Pemakluman

Kepengerusian ASEAN-Malaysia 2025: Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) akan mempengerusikan Jawatankuasa Sistem Statistik Komuniti ASEAN Ke-15 (ACSS15) yang bertujuan untuk memperkukuh kerjasama statistik ke arah pembangunan serantau yang mampan.

Malaysia buat julung kalinya telah menduduki tangga pertama (1) di peringkat global dalam laporan dwi-tahunan *Open Data Inventory* (ODIN) 2024/25 yang dikeluarkan oleh *Open Data Watch* (ODW), mengatasi 198 negara lain. Pencapaian ini merupakan lonjakan ketara daripada kedudukan ke-67 dalam penilaian ODIN 2022/23.

Kerajaan Malaysia telah mengisytiharkan 20 Oktober sebagai Hari Statistik Negara (MyStats Day), dengan tema 'Statistik Nadi Kehidupan'. Sementara itu, Hari Statistik Dunia Keempat akan disambut pada 20 Oktober 2025 dengan tema '*Driving Change with Quality Statistics and Data for Everyone*'.

OpenDOSM NextGen adalah medium yang menyediakan katalog data dan visualisasi bagi memudahkan pengguna menganalisis pelbagai data dan boleh diakses melalui portal <https://open.dosm.gov.my>.

Announcement

ASEAN-Malaysia 2025 Chairmanship: The Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) will chair the 15th ASEAN Community Statistical System Committee (ACSS15) which aims to strengthen the statistical cooperation towards sustainable regional development.

Malaysia, for the first time, ranked as number one (1) globally in the biennial Open Data Inventory (ODIN) 2024/25 report released by Open Data Watch (ODW), surpassing 198 other countries. This achievement marks a significant leap from its 67th position in the ODIN 2022/23 assessment.

The Government of Malaysia has declared October 20th as National Statistics Day (MyStats Day), with the theme 'Statistics is the Essence of Life.' Meanwhile, the Fourth World Statistics Day will be celebrated on 20th October 2025, with the theme 'Driving Change with Quality Statistics and Data for Everyone'.

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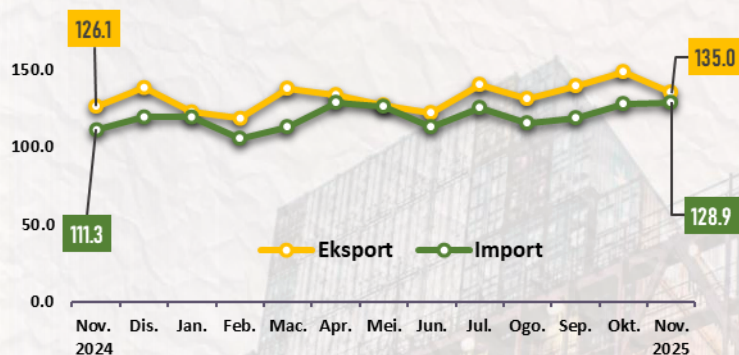

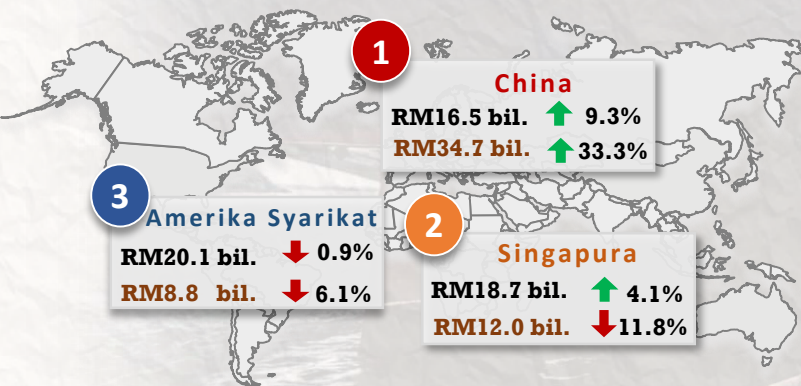

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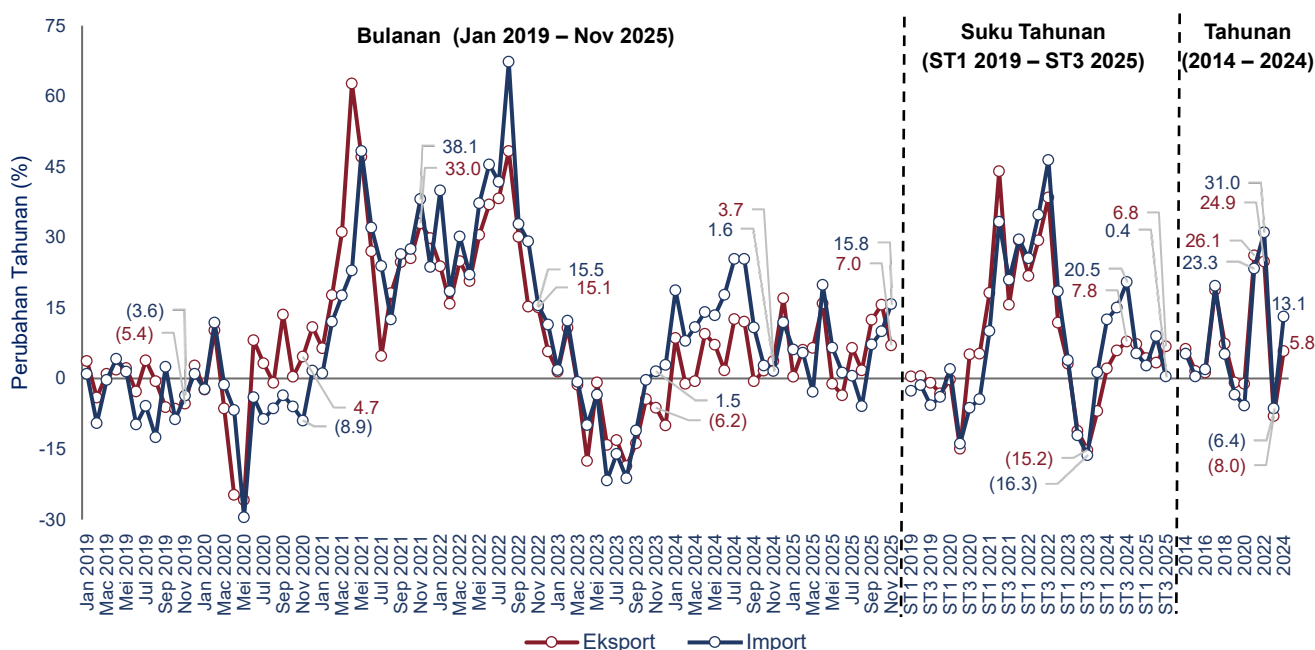
PRESTASI PERDAGANGAN LUAR NEGERI MALAYSIA, NOVEMBER 2025

Prestasi perdagangan Malaysia pada November 2025 kekal positif dengan peningkatan dua angka sejajar dengan pertumbuhan eksport dan import. Jumlah perdagangan bertambah RM26.5 bilion atau 11.1 peratus, tahun ke tahun, mencecah nilai RM263.8 bilion. Sebaliknya, imbalan dagangan menyusut 58.8 peratus kepada RM6.1 bilion berbanding RM14.8 bilion pada bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya.

Perbandingan secara bulanan menunjukkan jumlah perdagangan dan lebihan dagangan merosot masing-masing 4.5 peratus dan 70.0 peratus.

Bagi tempoh Januari hingga November 2025, eksport menokok 6.1 peratus, import berkembang 5.6 peratus, jumlah dagangan mengukuh 5.8 peratus dan imbalan dagangan meningkat 10.7 peratus.

Eksport Malaysia mengekalkan pertumbuhan positif pada November 2025

Prestasi Eksport

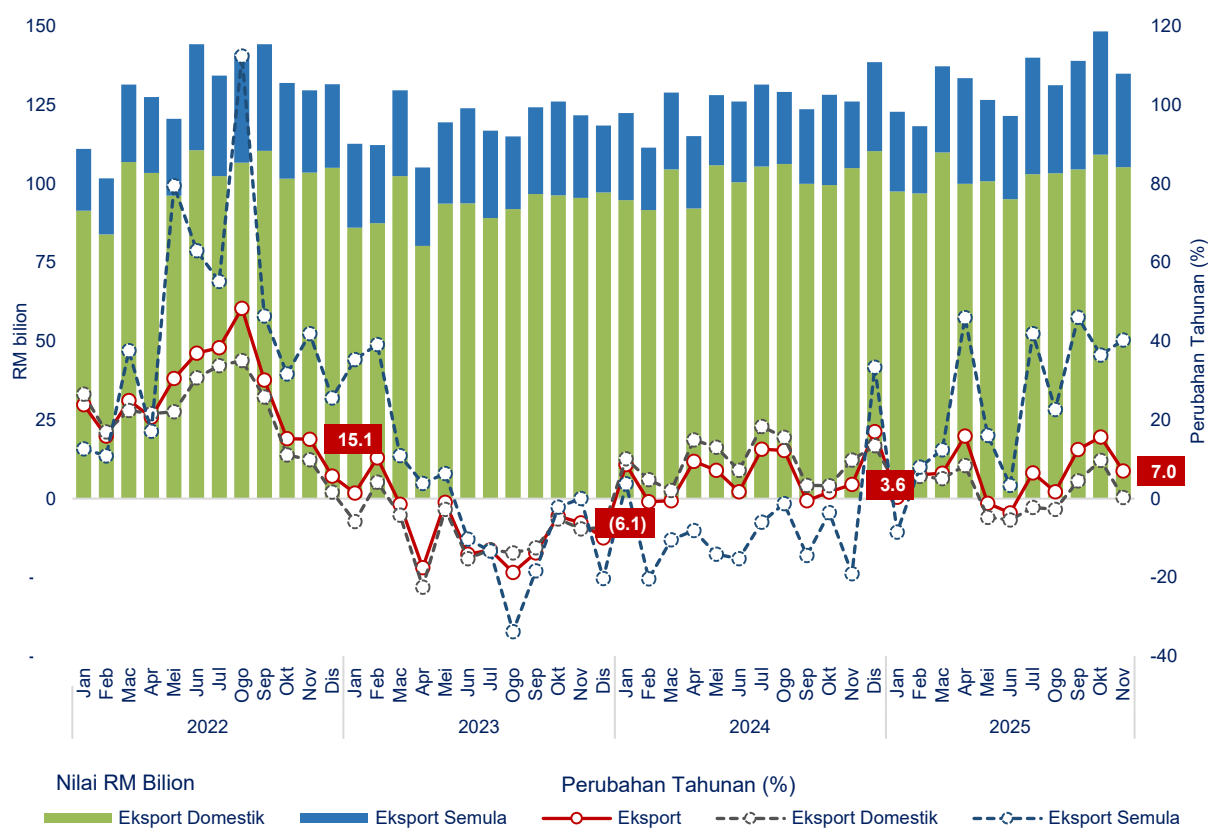
Pada November 2025, eksport Malaysia bertumbuh positif dengan peningkatan 7.0 peratus daripada RM126.1 bilion pada November 2024 kepada RM135.0 bilion.

Pertumbuhan ini sejajar dengan peningkatan ketara eksport semula yang merangkumi 22.0 peratus daripada jumlah eksport, melonjak 40.3 peratus kepada RM29.8 bilion.

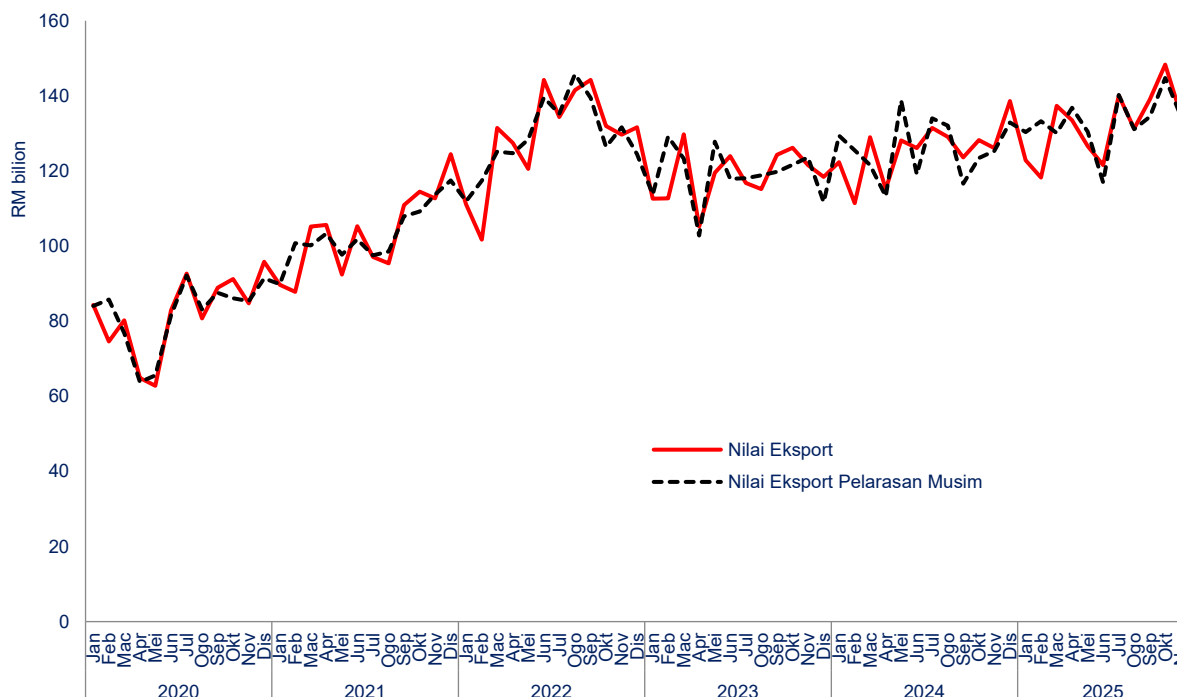
Manakala, eksport domestik bertumbuh secara marginal 0.3 peratus kepada RM105.2 bilion, mewakili 78.0 peratus daripada jumlah eksport.

Perbandingan bulan ke bulan menunjukkan eksport semula dan eksport domestik menyusut masing-masing 24.0 peratus dan 3.6 peratus. Analisis terma pelarasan musim bulan ke bulan menunjukkan eksport menguncup 7.0 peratus kepada RM134.6 bilion.

Prestasi Eksport mengikut Negara Destinasi Utama

Amerika Syarikat dan Singapura merupakan negara destinasi utama pada November 2025 dengan sumbangan berjumlah 28.8 peratus kepada nilai eksport Malaysia.

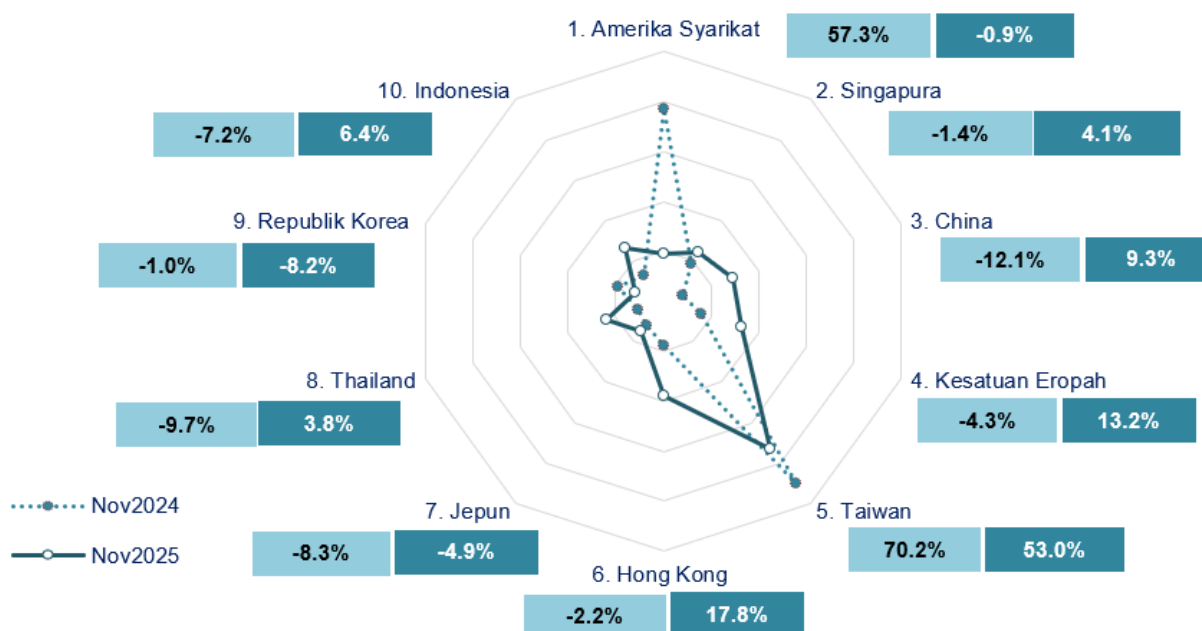
Eksport ke Amerika Syarikat bernilai RM20.1 bilion, mewakili 14.9 peratus daripada jumlah eksport, mencatatkan penurunan marginal 0.9 peratus atau RM173.0 juta, tahun ke tahun. Penguncupan ini disumbangkan terutamanya oleh pengurangan eksport keluaran perkilangan lain dengan penurunan RM648.0 juta atau 24.6 peratus.

Sementara itu, eksport ke Singapura sebagai negara destinasi kedua tertinggi, berjumlah RM18.7 bilion dan menyumbang 13.9 peratus

kepada jumlah eksport Malaysia, meningkat 4.1 peratus atau RM736.0 juta, tahun ke tahun. Peningkatan ini dipacu oleh eksport minyak kelapa sawit & hasil keluaran berasaskan minyak sawit yang lebih tinggi (+RM198.3 juta, +238.7%), petroleum mentah (+RM185.9 juta, +138.6%), barangan besi & keluli (+RM170.9 juta, +62.0%), barangan optik & saintifik (+RM149.0 juta, +28.2%) dan keluaran perkilangan lain (+RM114.5 juta, +25.8%).

Eksport ke tujuh negara destinasi utama mencatatkan pertumbuhan positif manakala eksport ke Amerika Syarikat, Jepun dan Republik Korea menguncup berbanding bulan yang sama tahun 2024.

Carta 4: Perubahan Tahunan Eksport bagi Negara Destinasi Utama, November 2024 dan November 2025



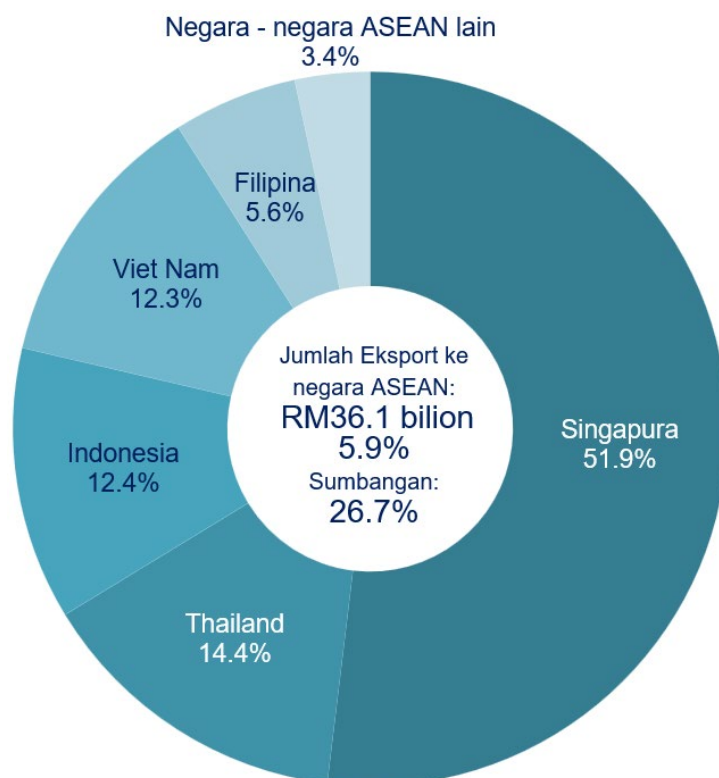
Eksport ke Negara ASEAN

Eksport ke negara ASEAN mewakili 26.7 peratus daripada jumlah eksport Malaysia dengan mencatatkan nilai RM36.1 bilion, bertumbuh 5.9 peratus berbanding bulan yang sama tahun 2024.

Kenaikan ini disumbangkan terutamanya oleh eksport keluaran petroleum yang meningkat 24.1 peratus atau RM1.2 bilion dan barangan elektrik & elektronik (+RM997.0 juta, +8.1%).

Singapura kekal menjadi destinasi utama dengan menyumbang lebih separuh daripada jumlah eksport keseluruhan ke negara anggota ASEAN dengan nilai RM18.7 bilion atau 51.9 peratus, meningkat 4.1 peratus berbanding tahun sebelumnya.

Carta 5: Peratusan Sumbangan Eksport ke Negara ASEAN, November 2025



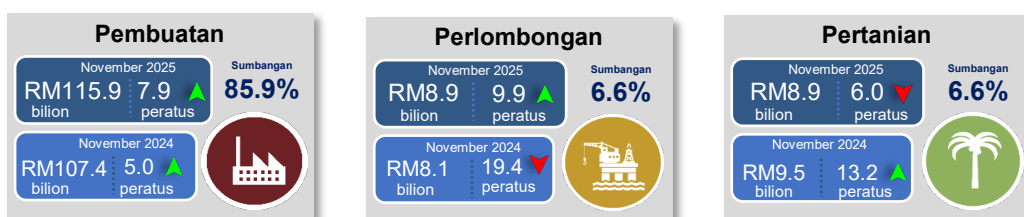
Prestasi Eksport mengikut Sektor Ekonomi

Eksport barangan perkilangan meningkat 7.9 peratus atau RM8.5 bilion pada November 2025, menyumbang 85.9 peratus kepada jumlah eksport untuk mencecah nilai RM115.9 bilion. Peningkatan ini didorong oleh pertambahan eksport barangan elektrik & elektronik (+RM7.7 bilion, +15.0%) dan barangan optik & saintifik (+RM1.6 bilion, +33.8%).

Eksport hasil perlombongan yang mewakili 6.6 peratus daripada jumlah eksport, menokok 9.9 peratus kepada RM8.9 bilion, berikutan eksport yang lebih tinggi bagi bijih logam & serpihan logam dengan peningkatan RM1.3 bilion atau 212.0 peratus.

Eksport keluaran pertanian yang mewakili 6.6 peratus daripada jumlah eksport mencatatkan penguncupan 6.0 peratus kepada RM8.9 bilion. Penurunan ini adalah sejajar dengan penyusutan eksport minyak kelapa sawit & hasil pertanian berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit (-RM686.2 juta, -9.3%).

Eksport mengikut Produk Utama Terpilih

Peningkatan ketara prestasi eksport pada November 2025 dipengaruhi oleh peningkatan dalam produk berikut:

- Barangan elektrik & elektronik, meliputi 43.6 peratus daripada jumlah eksport, berkembang 15.0 peratus, berjumlah RM51.1 bilion pada tahun sebelumnya kepada RM58.8 bilion;
- Petroleum mentah yang merangkumi 1.3 peratus daripada jumlah eksport, menokok RM97.7 juta atau 6.0 peratus kepada RM1.7 bilion sejajar dengan pertambahan volum eksport (+24.9%). Seajar dengan penurunan harga minyak Brent kepada RM264.3 setong menjana penurunan nilai purata seunit 15.1 peratus; dan
- Keluaran petroleum bertapis, merangkumi 6.2 peratus daripada jumlah eksport, meningkat 2.6 peratus atau RM216.5 juta kepada RM8.4 bilion, selaras dengan peningkatan volum eksport 19.7 peratus, sebaliknya nilai purata seunit menurun 14.3 peratus.

Walau bagaimanapun, penurunan telah direkodkan untuk produk berikut:

- Minyak kelapa sawit & hasil keluaran berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit (7.3% daripada jumlah eksport), menguncup 2.0 peratus atau RM201.6 juta kepada RM9.9 bilion seiring dengan penurunan nilai purata seunit (-59.9%). Prestasi ini seiring dengan pengurangan RM922.1 juta atau 15.0 peratus bagi eksport minyak sawit, komoditi utama dalam kumpulan produk ini. Seterusnya, harga minyak sawit mentah tempatan turut mencatatkan penyusutan 18.4 peratus kepada RM4,089.5 per tan metrik;
- Kayu & hasil keluaran kayu turun 10.6 peratus atau RM203.0 juta kepada RM1.7 bilion, seterusnya menyumbang 1.3 peratus kepada jumlah eksport; dan
- Getah asli yang mencakupi 0.2 peratus daripada jumlah eksport, menyusut 22.9 peratus atau RM85.3 juta kepada RM288.0 juta. Ia sejajar dengan pengurangan volum eksport (-14.7%) dan nilai purata seunit (-9.5%), selaras dengan penurunan harga getah SMR20 (-15.8%).
- Gas asli cecair menyumbang 3.5 peratus kepada jumlah eksport, menurun RM679.4 juta atau 12.5 peratus kepada RM4.8 bilion. Ia selaras dengan penurunan nilai purata seunit 19.2 peratus, namun volum eksport meningkat 8.3 peratus;

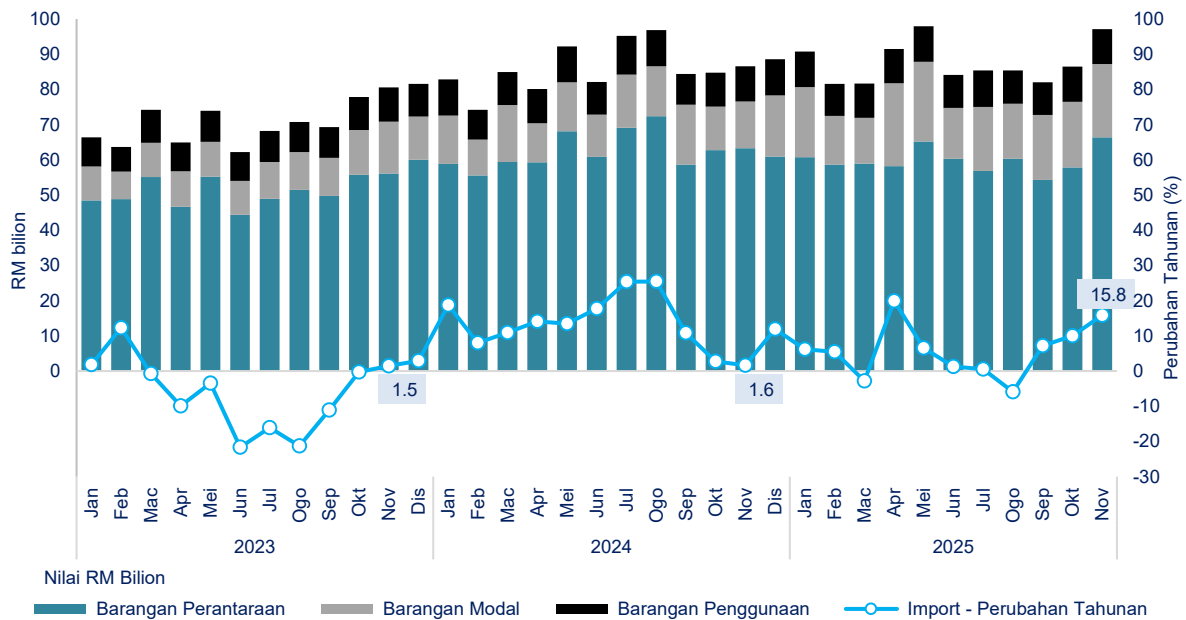
Import mencatatkan pertumbuhan dua angka pada November 2025

Prestasi Import

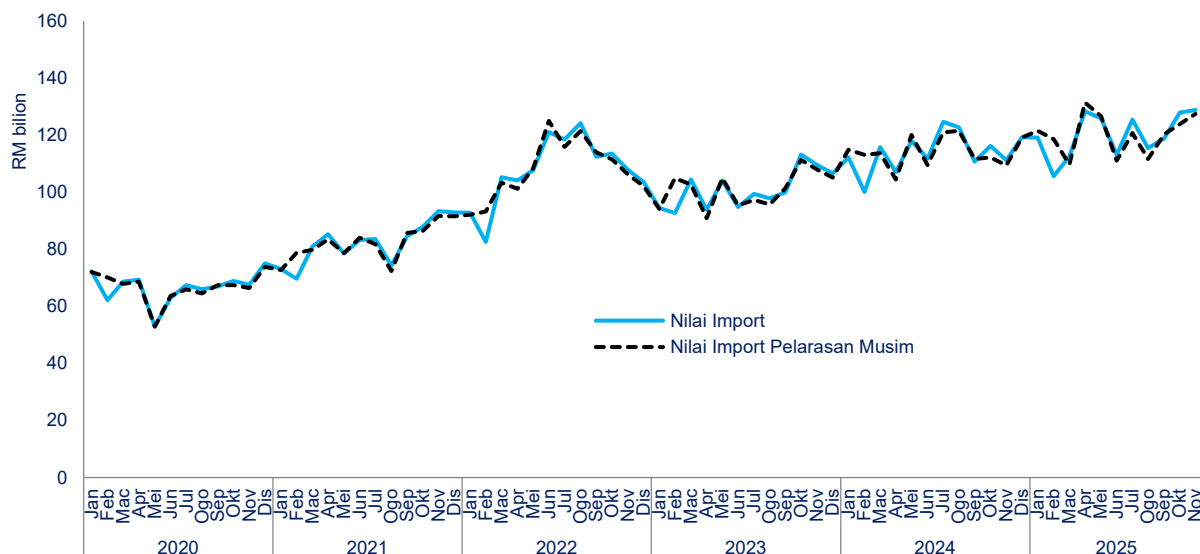
Import Malaysia pada November 2025 mengekalkan pertumbuhan positif 15.8 peratus atau RM17.6 bilion mencecah nilai RM128.9 bilion. Berdasarkan bulan ke bulan, import meningkat secara marginal 0.7 peratus atau RM945.8 juta. Merujuk kepada analisis terma pelarasan musim bulan ke bulan, import meningkat 3.0 peratus kepada RM127.5 bilion.

Perbandingan tahun ke tahun, import mengikut Penggunaan Akhir mencatatkan pertumbuhan positif dengan peningkatan dalam barangan modal (+56.8%) dan barangan perantaraan (+5.0%). Sebaliknya, barangan penggunaan merekodkan penurunan 1.7 peratus.

Prestasi Import Mengikut Negara Asal Utama

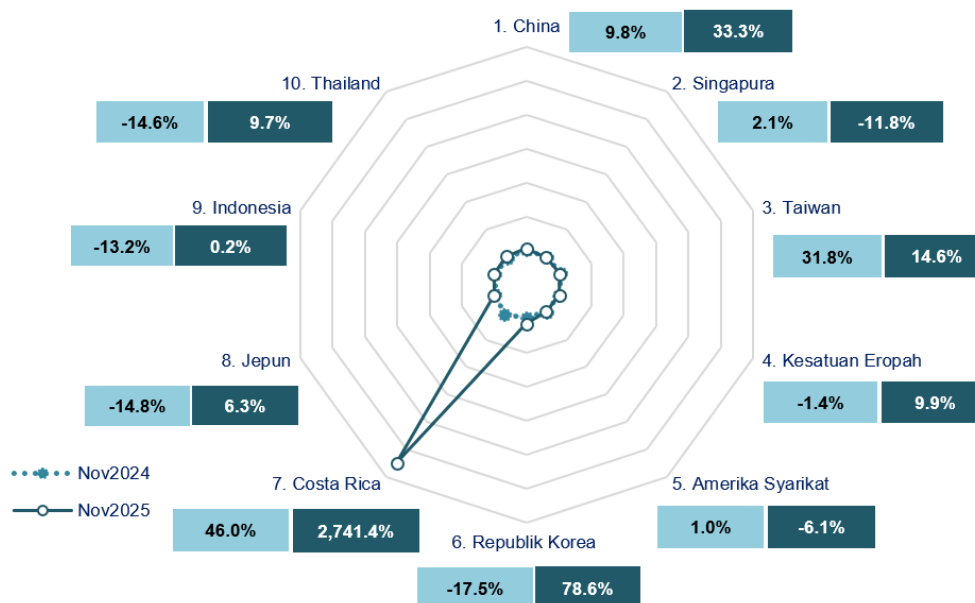
China dan Singapura merupakan dua negara asal utama bagi import Malaysia pada November 2025 dengan sumbangan 36.2 peratus kepada jumlah import.

Import dari China yang mewakili 27.0 peratus daripada import Malaysia, meningkat 33.3 peratus kepada RM34.7 bilion. Pertumbuhan ini dirangsang oleh import yang tinggi barangan elektrik & elektronik dengan peningkatan 52.9 peratus atau RM6.2 bilion, diikuti oleh jentera, kelengkapan & alat ganti (+RM894.3 juta, +31.4%), kelengkapan pengangkutan (+RM498.5 juta, +46.4%), keluaran perkilangan logam (+RM296.4 juta, +18.8%), keluaran petroleum (+RM197.7 juta, +39.2%), keluaran perkilangan lain (+RM159.3 juta, +20.0%), barangan besi & keluli (+RM148.6 juta, +17.7%) dan keluaran plastik (+RM137.1 juta, +24.7%).

Import dari Singapura bernilai RM12.0 bilion, merangkumi 9.3 peratus daripada import Malaysia, turun 11.8 peratus atau RM1.6 bilion, tahun ke tahun. Penyusutan ini disumbangkan terutamanya oleh import barangan elektrik & elektronik yang lebih rendah (-RM577.5 juta, -10.2%), tekstil, pakaian & kasut (-RM231.9 juta, -75.7%), keluaran perkilangan logam (-RM191.6 juta, -34.5%), keluaran petroleum (-RM189.1 juta, -6.9%), kimia & bahan kimia (-RM180.4 juta, -19.1%), jentera, kelengkapan & alat ganti (-RM153.0 juta, -17.3%) dan keluaran perkilangan lain (-RM120.8 juta, -28.7%).

Perubahan tahunan import dari lapan negara asal utama mencatatkan peningkatan, sebaliknya import dari Singapura dan Amerika Syarikat menyusut berbanding tempoh yang sama tahun lepas.

Import dari Negara ASEAN

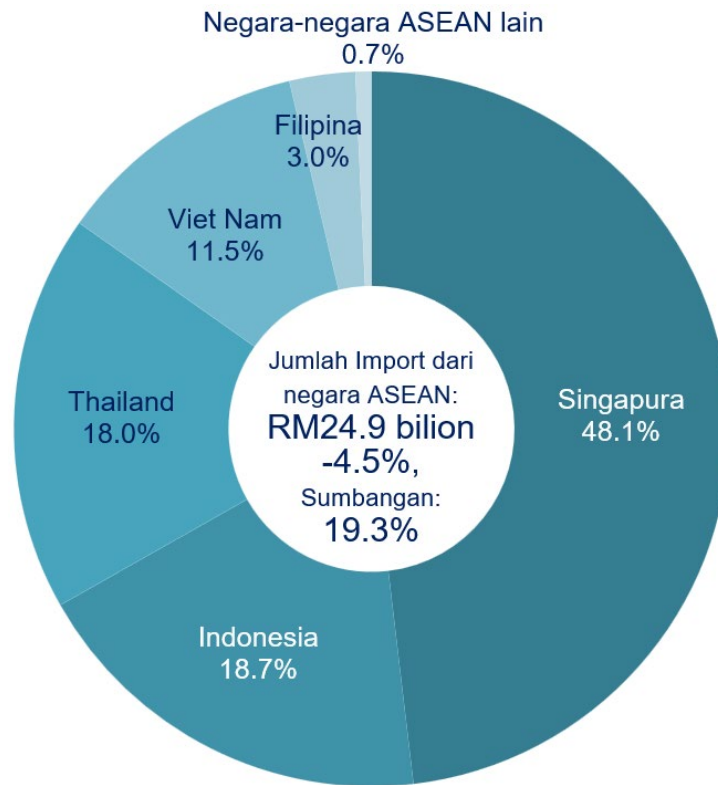
Import dari negara ASEAN mencatatkan penurunan 4.5 peratus pada November 2025 kepada RM24.9 bilion, mewakili 19.3 peratus daripada jumlah import Malaysia.

Penyusutan ini disumbangkan terutamanya oleh import yang rendah keluaran perkilangan logam (-RM367.8 juta, -31.0%), hasil perlombongan lain (-RM363.3 juta, -34.1%),

keluaran petroleum (-RM319.3 juta, -9.6%), getah asli (-RM267.3 juta, -52.4%), kimia & bahan kimia (-RM231.9 juta, -13.7%), tekstil, pakaian & kasut (-RM195.4 juta, -26.8%).

Dalam kalangan negara utama ASEAN, penurunan dilihat bagi import dari Singapura, Filipina, Kemboja, Myanmar dan Brunei.

Carta 9: Peratusan Sumbangan Import dari Negara ASEAN, November 2025



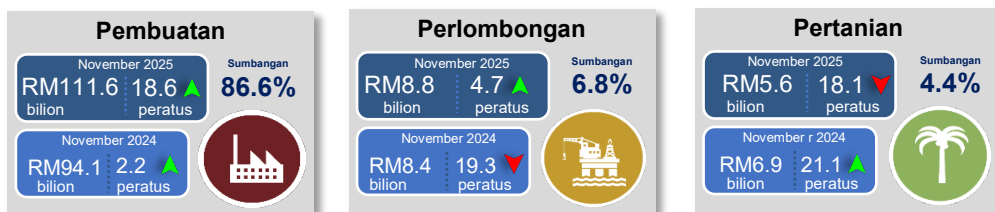
Prestasi Import Mengikut Sektor Ekonomi

Barangan perkilangan yang merangkumi 86.6 peratus daripada jumlah import, meningkat 18.6 peratus daripada RM94.1 bilion kepada RM111.6 bilion, tahun ke tahun. Prestasi ini didorong oleh import barangan elektrik & elektronik yang lebih tinggi (+RM17.5 bilion, +44.4%) dan jentera, kelengkapan & alat ganti (+RM1.3 bilion, +15.2%).

Import hasil perlombongan berjumlah RM8.8 bilion, naik 4.7 peratus berbanding tahun sebelumnya dan menyumbang 6.8 peratus kepada jumlah import Malaysia. Pertumbuhan ini disebabkan oleh import bijih logam & serpihan logam (+RM942.4 juta, +79.7%).

Import keluaran pertanian (4.4% daripada jumlah import) merosot 18.1 peratus atau RM1.2 bilion kepada RM5.6 bilion. Penurunan tersebut disumbangkan terutamanya oleh pengurangan keluaran pertanian lain (-RM579.7 juta, -12.9%), getah asli (-RM389.3 juta, -47.0%), minyak sayuran lain (-RM181.4 juta, -34.1%) dan minyak kelapa sawit & keluaran berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit (-RM141.2 juta, -30.4%).

Import mengikut Produk Utama Terpilih

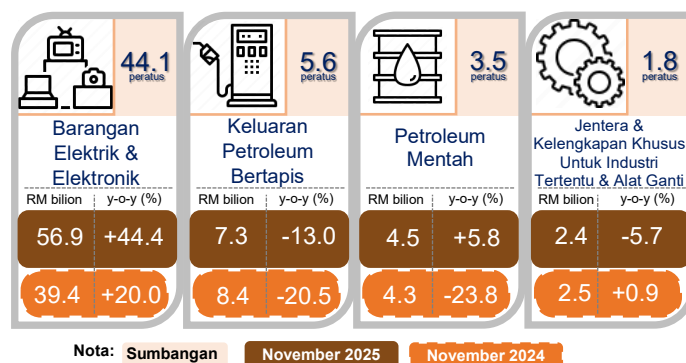
Import menunjukkan prestasi memberangsangkan pada November 2025, dengan pertumbuhan positif dilihat dalam produk berikut:

- Barangan elektrik & elektronik menyumbang 44.1 peratus kepada jumlah import, meningkat RM17.5 bilion atau 44.4 peratus kepada RM56.9 bilion; dan
- Petroleum mentah menyumbang 3.5 peratus kepada jumlah import, bertambah RM246.1 juta atau 5.8 peratus kepada RM4.5 bilion, selaras dengan kenaikan volum import (+18.9%). Namun sebaliknya, penurunan dilihat bagi nilai purata seunit (-11.1%) dan harga minyak Brent (-19.9%) kepada RM264.3 setong.

Walaupun bagaimanapun, pertumbuhan negatif direkodkan bagi produk berikut:

- Keluaran petroleum bertapis menyumbang 5.6 peratus kepada jumlah import, mencatatkan penurunan RM1.1 bilion atau 13.0 peratus kepada RM7.3 bilion dengan penyusutan nilai purata seunit (-13.1%); dan
- Jentera & kelengkapan khusus untuk industri tertentu & alat ganti yang menyumbang 1.8 peratus kepada jumlah import, jatuh 5.7 peratus atau RM142.0 juta kepada RM2.4 bilion.

Paparan 4: Import Produk Utama Terpilih, November 2024 dan November 2025



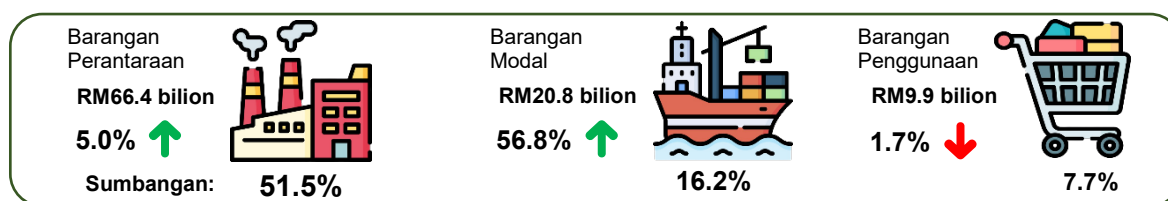
Import mengikut Klasifikasi Penggunaan Akhir & Kategori Ekonomi Umum

Jumlah import pada November 2025 bernilai RM128.9 bilion, meningkat 15.8 peratus berbanding bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Tiga kategori utama import mengikut Penggunaan Akhir yang merangkumi 75.4 peratus daripada jumlah import ialah:

Barangan perantaraan, bernilai RM66.4 bilion atau 51.5 peratus daripada jumlah import, berkembang 5.0 peratus disebabkan import yang lebih tinggi bagi alat ganti & aksesori barangan modal (kecuali peralatan pengangkutan) (+RM7.7 bilion, +33.4%) dan alat ganti & aksesori peralatan pengangkutan (+RM749.1 juta, +20.8%).

Barangan modal, berjumlah RM20.8 bilion (16.2% daripada jumlah import) meningkat 56.8 peratus, disebabkan oleh import yang lebih tinggi bagi barangan modal (kecuali alat kelengkapan pengangkutan) (+RM7.4 bilion, +62.0%) dan peralatan pengangkutan, perindustrian (+RM169.5 juta, +12.3%).

Barangan penggunaan, berjumlah RM9.9 bilion (7.7% daripada jumlah import), mencatatkan penyusutan 1.7 peratus, disumbangkan terutamanya oleh pengurangan import barangan tidak tahan lama (-RM205.2 juta, -10.1%).

Malaysia mencatatkan jumlah perdagangan bernilai RM263.8 bilion pada November 2025 dengan eksport dan import masing-masing bernilai RM135.0 bilion dan RM128.9 bilion.

Eksport bernilai RM135.0 bilion pada November 2025, meningkat sebanyak RM8.9 bilion (+7.0%) berbanding bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Peningkatan eksport dipengaruhi oleh eksport yang lebih tinggi di Pulau Pinang (+RM6.9 bilion), Johor (+RM5.2 bilion), Perak (+RM699.1 juta), Sabah (+RM36.3 juta), dan Negeri Sembilan (+RM17.7 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai eksport menurun di Selangor sebanyak RM1.4 bilion, Sarawak (-RM1.0 bilion), Pahang (-RM658.8 juta), W.P. Labuan (-RM445.4 juta), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (-RM348.0 juta), Kedah (-RM272.5 juta), Kelantan (-RM266.2 juta), Terengganu (-RM66.9 juta), Perlis (-RM23.9 juta) dan Melaka (-RM4.5 juta).

Pulau Pinang kekal sebagai pengeksport utama dengan sumbangan 39.2 peratus, diikuti oleh

Johor (21.1%), Selangor (15.2%), Sarawak (6.7%) dan W.P. Kuala Lumpur (3.3%).

Pada masa yang sama, import pada bulan November 2025 meningkat RM17.6 bilion (+15.8%) berbanding bulan yang sama pada tahun 2024. Peningkatan import disebabkan oleh import yang lebih tinggi di Pulau Pinang (+RM9.4 bilion), Selangor (+RM5.0 bilion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM3.2 bilion), Johor (+RM707.8 juta), Perak (+RM681.3 juta), Melaka (+RM398.3 juta) dan Sabah (+RM165.2 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai import menurun di Negeri Sembilan sebanyak RM368.3 juta, W.P. Labuan (-RM266.8 juta), Sarawak (-RM193.7 juta), Pahang (-RM140.7 juta), Kelantan (-RM91.3 juta), Perlis (-RM57.4 juta), Kedah (-RM48.6 juta) dan Terengganu (-RM27.3 juta).

Pulau Pinang mendominasi import Malaysia dengan sumbangan 28.6 peratus, diikuti oleh Selangor (26.2%), Johor (18.3%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (9.6%) dan Kedah (4.9%).

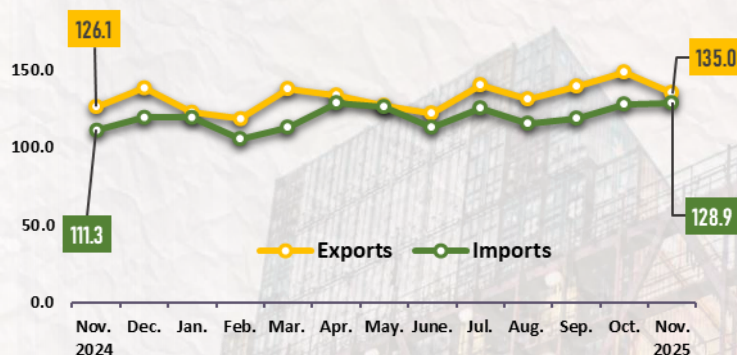

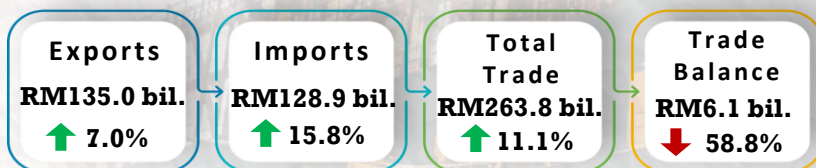
Malaysia External Trade Statistics
November 2024 – November 2025 (RM billion)



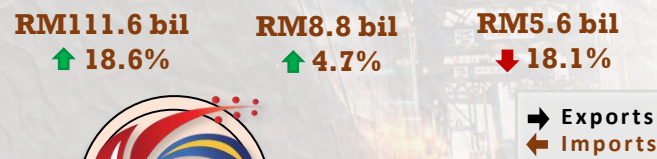
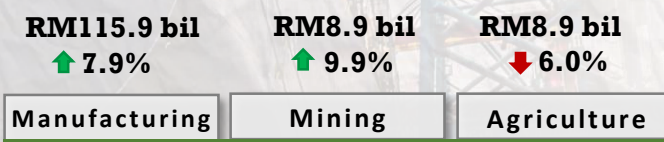
Imports By Broad Economic Categories & End Use

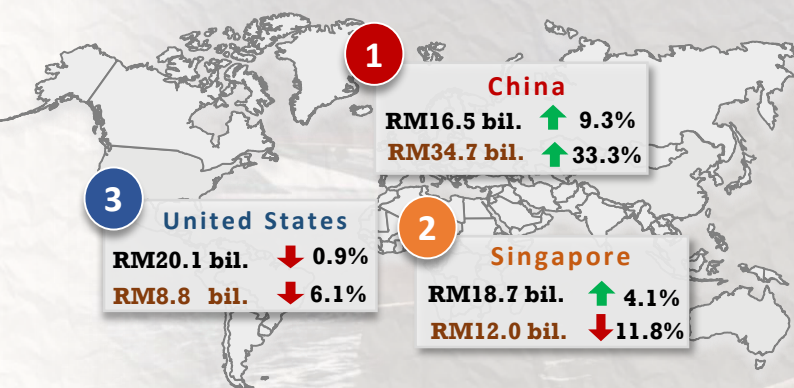

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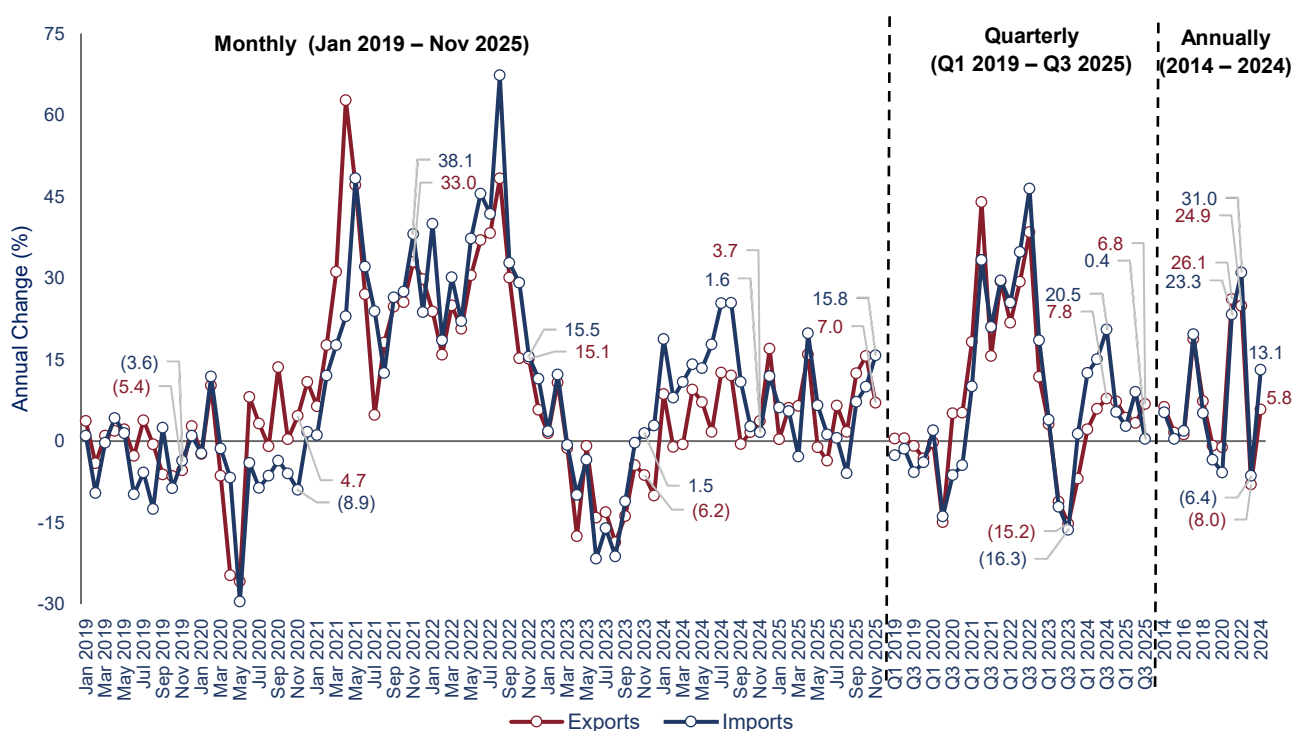
MALAYSIA'S EXTERNAL TRADE PERFORMANCE, NOVEMBER 2025

Malaysia's trade performance in November 2025 remained positive, recording double-digit growth in line with the expansion of both exports and imports. Total trade increased by RM26.5 billion, or 11.1 per cent year-on-year (y-o-y), to reach a value of RM263.8 billion. In contrast, the trade balance declined by 58.8 per cent to RM6.1 billion compared with RM14.8 billion in the same month of the previous year.

On a month-on-month (m-o-m) basis, total trade and the trade surplus decreased by 4.5 per cent and 70.0 per cent, respectively.

For the period from January to November 2025, exports rose by 6.1 per cent, imports grew by 5.6 per cent, total trade strengthened by 5.8 per cent, and the trade balance increased by 10.7 per cent.

EXPORTS

Malaysia's exports maintained positive growth in November 2025

Performance of Exports

In November 2025, Malaysia's exports recorded positive growth, increased by 7.0 per cent from RM126.1 billion in November 2024 to RM135.0 billion.

This growth was in line with a significant increase in re-exports, which accounted for 22.0 per cent of total exports and surged by 40.3 per cent to RM29.8 billion.

Meanwhile, domestic exports grew marginally by 0.3 per cent to RM105.2 billion, representing 78.0 per cent of total exports.

On a m-o-m basis, re-exports and domestic exports declined by 24.0 per cent and 3.6 per cent, respectively. Seasonally adjusted terms m-o-m analysis showed that exports contracted by 7.0 per cent to RM134.6 billion.

Chart 2: Domestic Exports, Re-Exports (RM billion) and Annual Change (%)

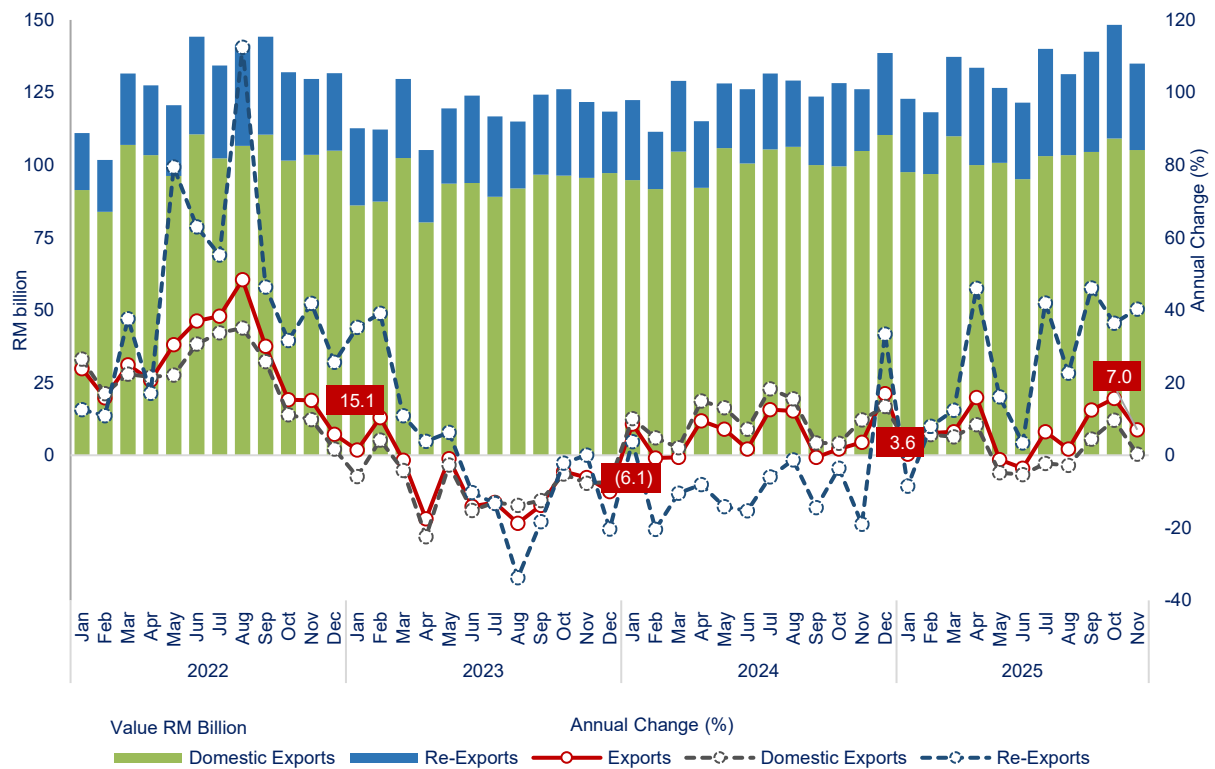
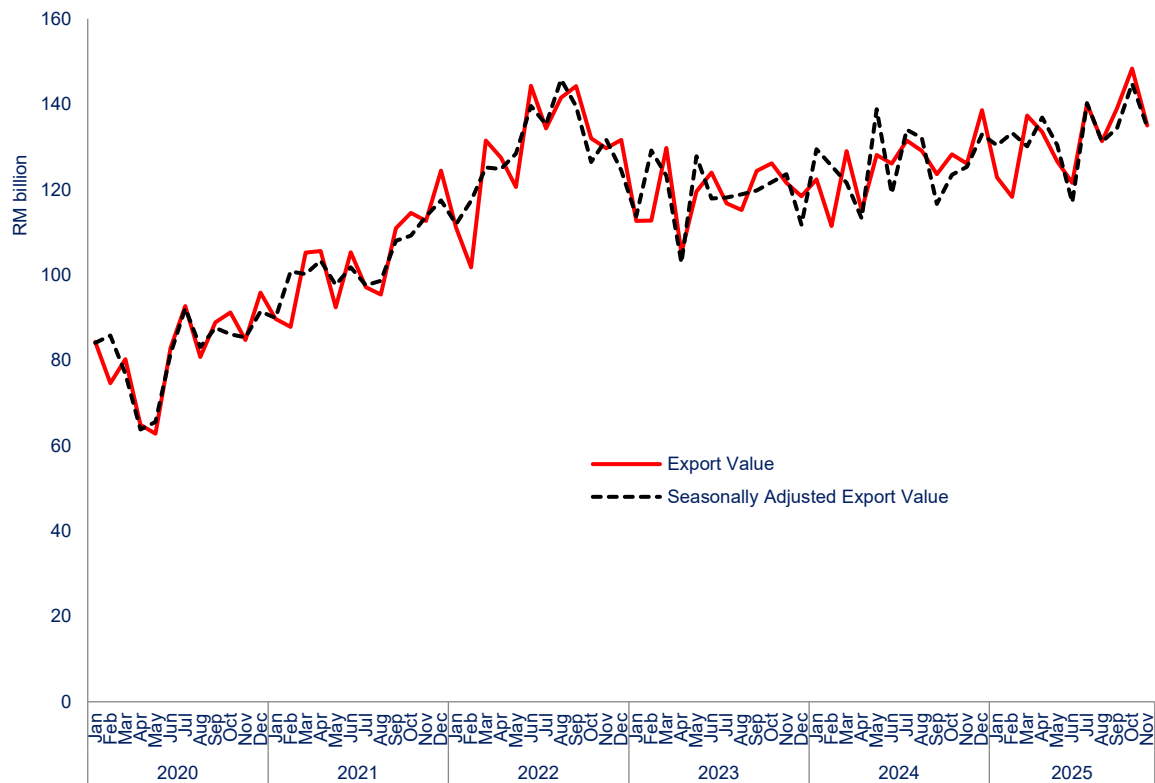


Chart 3: Actual Export Value and Seasonally Adjusted Export Value, RM billion



Export Performance for Major Country of Destination

The United States and Singapore were Malaysia's main export destinations in November 2025, accounting for a combined share of 28.8 per cent to Malaysia's exports value.

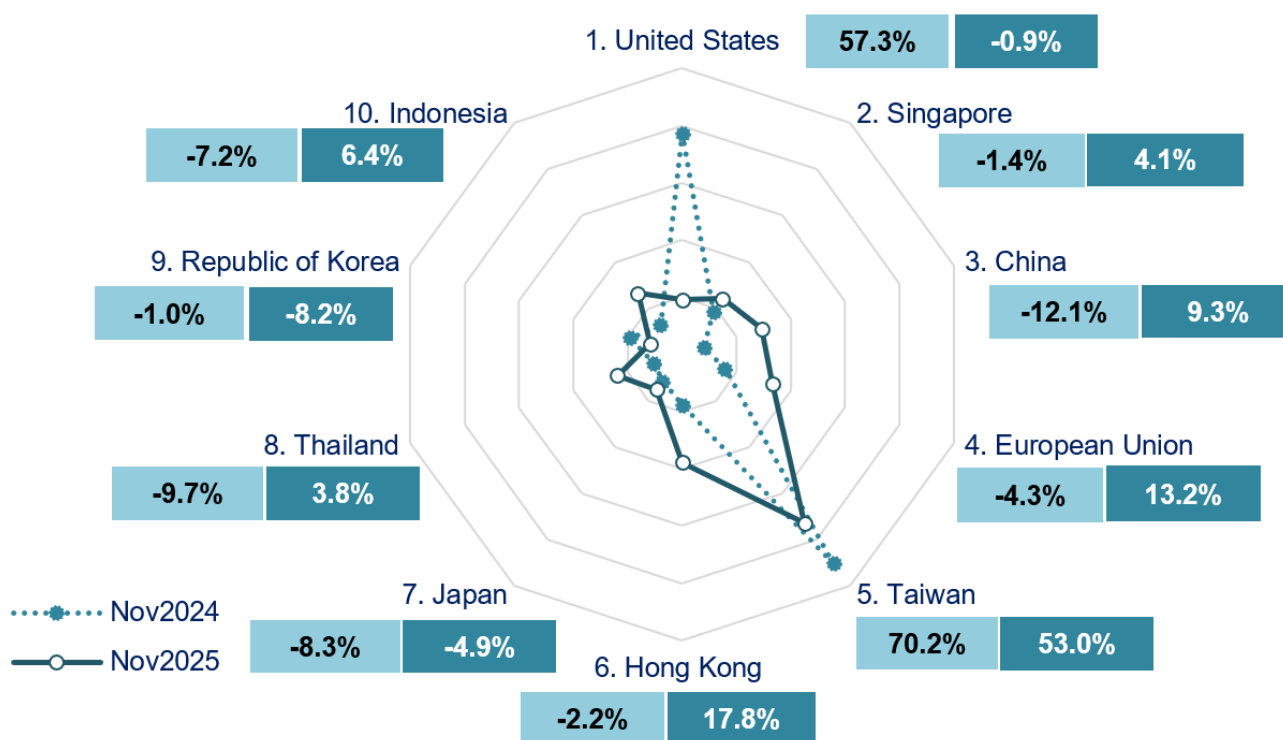
Exports to the United States amounted to RM20.1 billion, representing 14.9 per cent of total exports, and recorded a marginal y-o-y decline of 0.9 per cent, or RM173.0 million. This contraction was mainly attributed to a reduction in exports of other manufactures, which fell by RM648.0 million or 24.6 per cent.

Meanwhile, exports to Singapore, the second-largest export destination, totalled RM18.7 billion and contributed 13.9 per cent to

Malaysia's total exports, increased by 4.1 per cent, or RM736.0 million, y-o-y. This increase was driven by higher exports of palm oil and palm-based products (+RM198.3 million, +238.7%), crude petroleum (+RM185.9 million, +138.6%), iron & steel products (+RM170.9 million, +62.0%), optical & scientific equipment (+RM149.0 million, +28.2%) and other manufactures (+RM114.5 million, +25.8%).

Exports to seven major destination countries recorded positive growth, while exports to the United States, Japan, and the Republic of Korea declined compared with the same month in 2024.

Exports to ASEAN Countries

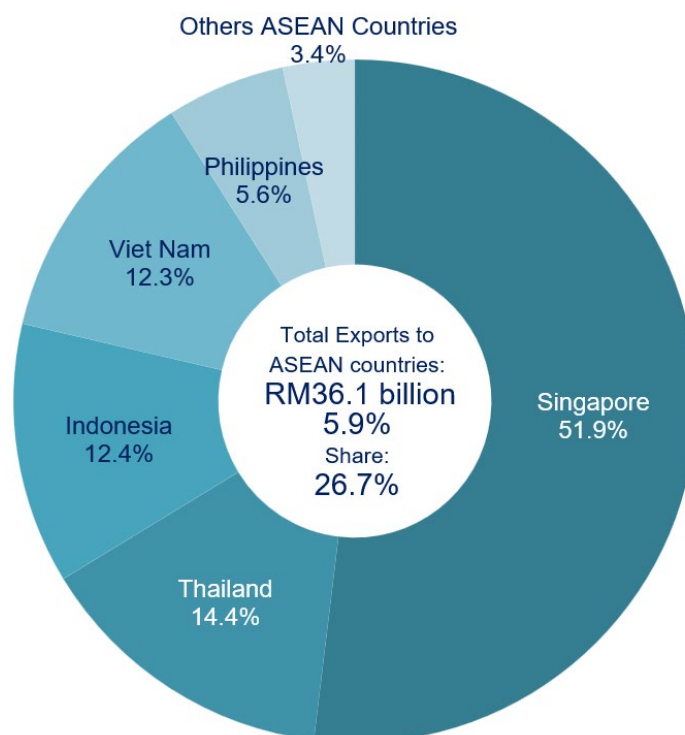
Exports to ASEAN countries accounted for 26.7 per cent of Malaysia's total exports, amounting to RM36.1 billion, and recorded a growth of 5.9 per cent compared to the same month in 2024.

This increase was mainly driven by higher exports of petroleum products, which rose by 24.1 per cent or RM1.2 billion, as well as electrical & electronic (E&E) products (+RM997.0 million, +8.1%).

Singapore remained the main destination, accounting for more than half of Malaysia's total exports to ASEAN countries, valued at

RM18.7 billion or 51.9 per cent, registering an increase of 4.1 per cent compared with the previous year.

Chart 5: Percentage Share of Exports to ASEAN Countries, November 2025



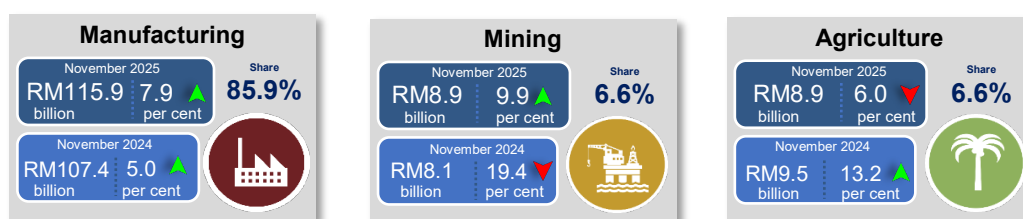
Export Performance for Economic Sectors

Exports of manufactured products increased by 7.9 per cent, or RM8.5 billion, in November 2025, accounting for 85.9 per cent of total exports and reaching a value of RM115.9 billion. This increase was driven by higher exports of E&E products (+RM7.7 billion, +15.0%) and optical & scientific equipment (+RM1.6 billion, +33.8%).

Exports of mining products, which represented 6.6 per cent of total exports, rose by 9.9 per cent to RM8.9 billion, supported by higher exports of metalliferous ores & metal scrap, which increased by RM1.3 billion or 212.0 per cent.

Exports of agriculture products, accounting for 6.6 per cent of total exports, recorded a contraction of 6.0 per cent to RM8.9 billion. This decline was in line with lower exports of palm oil & palm-based agriculture products (-RM686.2 million, -9.3%).

Exports of Selected Major Products

The significant improvement in export performance in November 2025 was influenced by increases in the following products:

- E&E products, which accounted for 43.6 per cent of total exports, expanded by 15.0 per cent, rising from RM51.1 billion in the previous year to RM58.8 billion;
- Crude petroleum, which represented 1.3 per cent of total exports, increased by RM97.7 million or 6.0 per cent to RM1.7 billion, in line with higher export volume (+24.9%). This occurred alongside a decline in Brent oil price to RM264.3 per barrel, resulting in a 15.1 per cent decrease in the average unit value; and
- Refined petroleum products, accounting for 6.2 per cent of total exports, rose by 2.6 per cent or RM216.5 million to RM8.4 billion, consistent with a 19.7 per cent increase in export volume, although the average unit value declined by 14.3 per cent.

However, declines were recorded for the following products:

- Palm oil & palm oil-based agriculture products (7.3% of total exports) contracted by 2.0 per cent or RM201.6 million to RM9.9 billion, in line with a sharp decline in the average unit value (-59.9%). This performance reflected a reduction of RM922.1 million or 15.0 per cent in palm oil exports, the main commodity within this product group. In addition, domestic crude palm oil prices declined by 18.4 per cent to RM4,089.5 per metric tonne;
- Liquefied natural gas (LNG), contributed 3.5 per cent to total exports, decreased by RM679.4 million or 12.5 per cent to RM4.8 billion. This was consistent with a 19.2 per cent decline in the average unit value, although export volume increased by 8.3 per cent;
- Timber & timber-based products fell by 10.6 per cent or RM203.0 million to RM1.7 billion, accounting for 1.3 per cent of total exports; and
- Natural rubber, which accounted for 0.2 per cent of total exports, declined by 22.9 per cent or RM85.3 million to RM288.0 million. This was in line with reductions in export volume (-14.7%) and the average unit value (-9.5%), consistent with a decline in SMR20 rubber prices (-15.8%).

IMPORTS

Imports recorded double-digit growth in November 2025

Performance of Imports

Malaysia's imports in November 2025 maintained positive growth, rising by 15.8 per cent or RM17.6 billion to reach RM128.9 billion. On a m-o-m basis, imports increased marginally by 0.7 per cent, or RM945.8 million. With regards to analysis of the seasonally adjusted terms m-o-m, imports rose by 3.0 per cent to RM127.5 billion.

On a y-o-y basis, imports by End Use recorded positive growth, driven by increases in capital goods (+56.8%) and intermediate goods (+5.0%). In contrast, consumption goods registered a decline of 1.7 per cent.

Chart 6: Imports, Value (RM billion) and Annual Change (%)

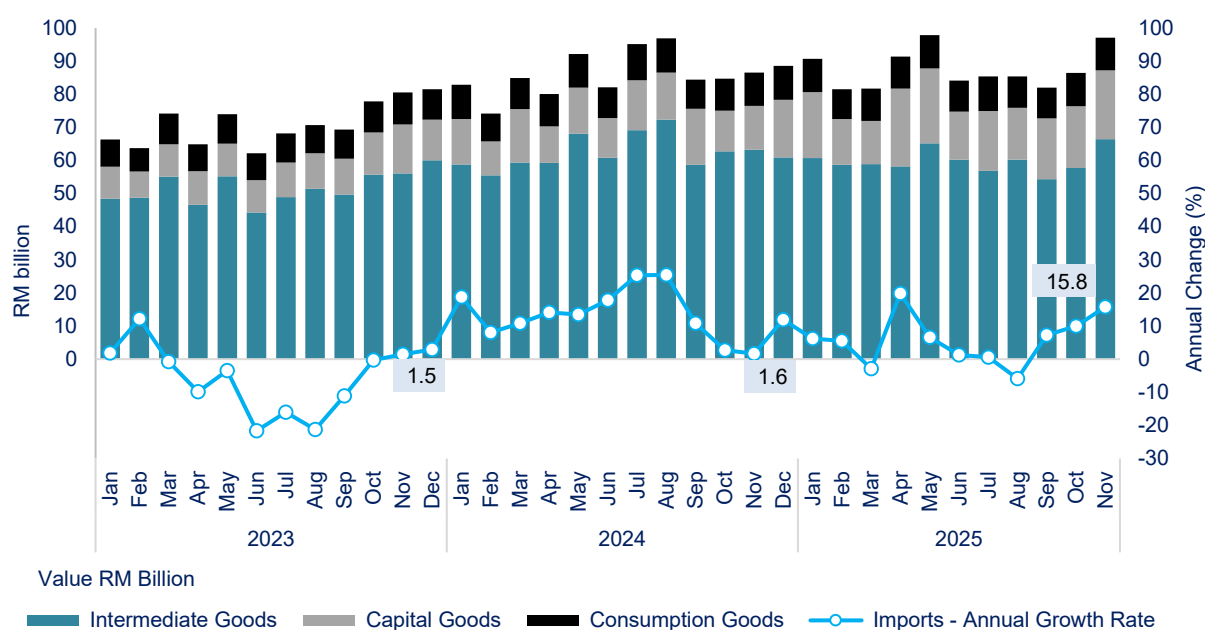
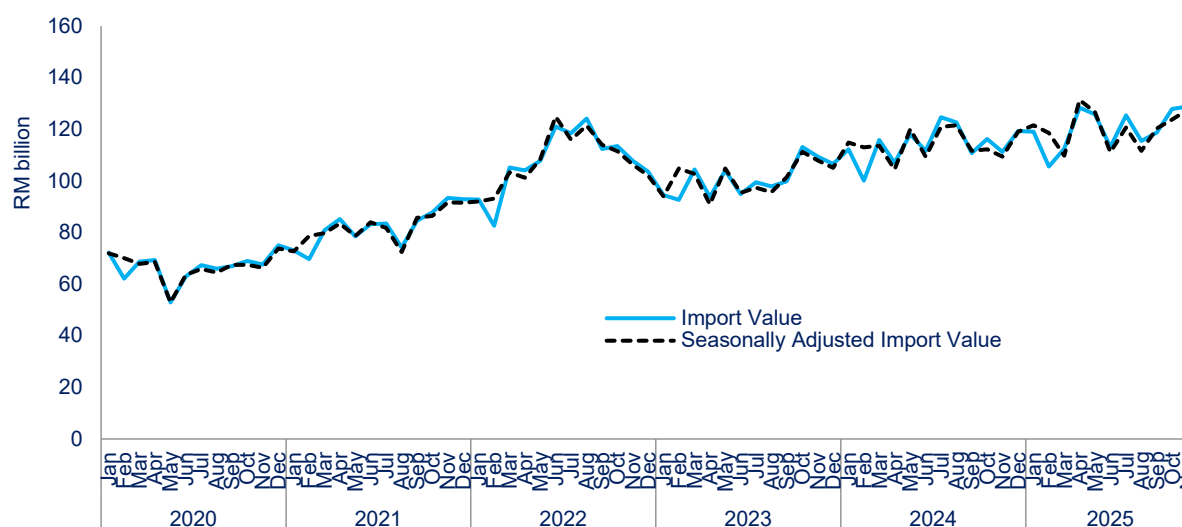


Chart 7: Actual Import Value and Seasonally Adjusted Imports Value, RM billion



Import Performance for Major Country of Origin

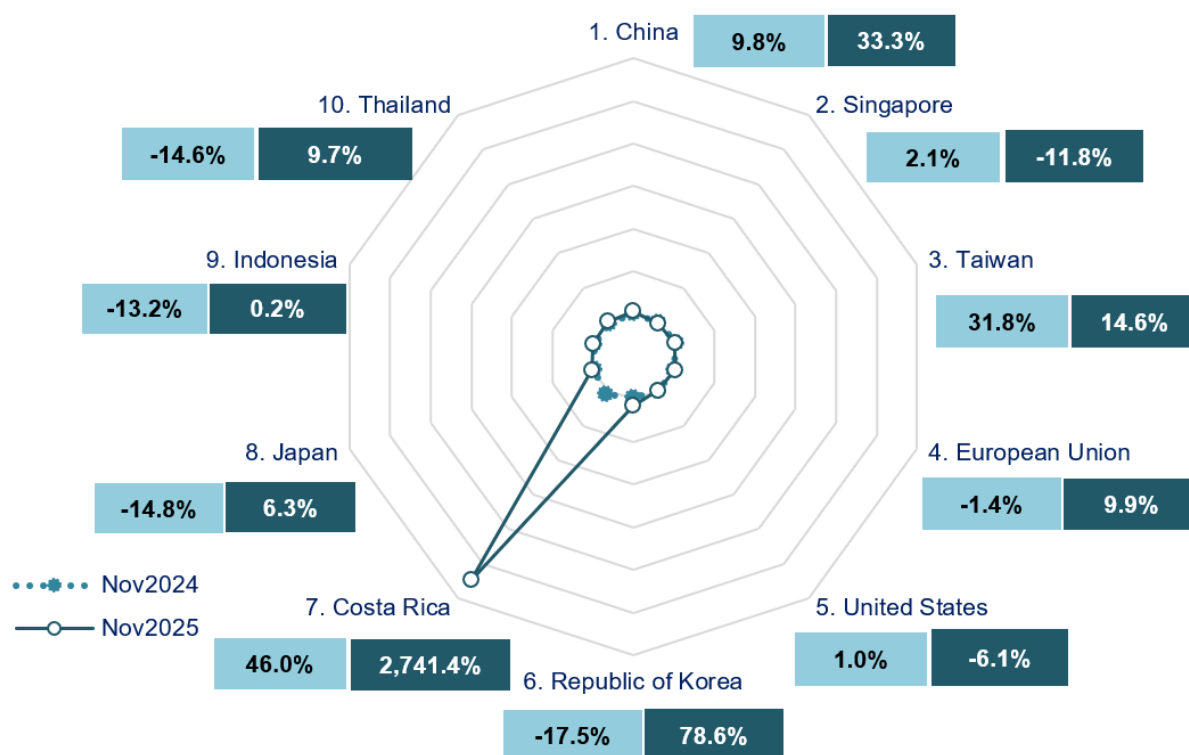
China and Singapore were the two main countries of origin for Malaysia's imports in November 2025, accounting for a combined share of 36.2 per cent of total imports.

Imports from China, which represented 27.0 per cent of Malaysia's imports, increased by 33.3 per cent to RM34.7 billion. This growth was driven by higher imports of E&E products, which rose by 52.9 per cent or RM6.2 billion, followed by machinery, equipment & parts (+RM894.3 million, +31.4%), transport equipment (+RM498.5 million, +46.4%), manufactures of metal (+RM296.4 million, +18.8%), petroleum products (+RM197.7 million, +39.2%), other manufactures (+RM159.3 million, +20.0%), iron & steel products (+RM148.6 million, +17.7%), and manufacture of plastics (+RM137.1 million, +24.7%).

Imports from Singapore amounted to RM12.0 billion, accounting for 9.3 per cent of Malaysia's imports, and declined by 11.8 per cent, or RM1.6 billion, y-o-y. This contraction was mainly due to lower imports of E&E products (-RM577.5 million, -10.2%), textiles, apparels & footwear (-RM231.9 million, -75.7%), manufactures of metal (-RM191.6 million, -34.5%), petroleum products (-RM189.1 million, -6.9%), chemical & chemical products (-RM180.4 million, -19.1%), machinery, equipment & parts (-RM153.0 million, -17.3%), and other manufactures (-RM120.8 million, -28.7%).

The annual change in imports from eight major countries of origin recorded increases, while imports from Singapore and the United States declined compared to the same period last year.

Imports from ASEAN Countries

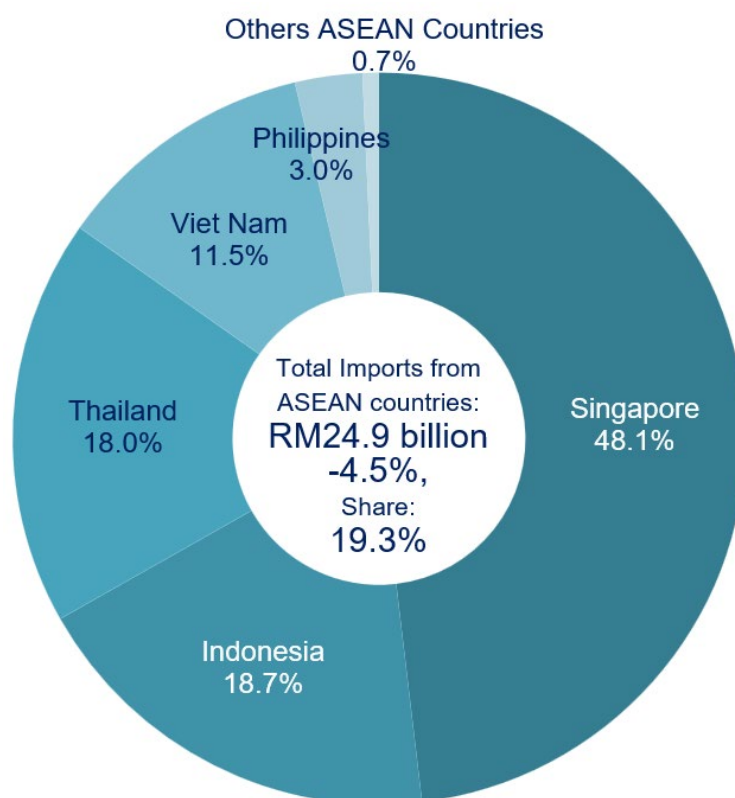
Imports from ASEAN countries declined by 4.5 per cent in November 2025 to RM24.9 billion, accounting for 19.3 per cent of Malaysia's total imports.

The contraction was mainly due to lower imports of manufactures of metal (-RM367.8 million, -31.0%), other mining (-RM363.3 million, -34.1%), petroleum products

(-RM319.3 million, -9.6%), natural rubber (-RM267.3 million, -52.4%), chemical & chemical products (-RM231.9 million, -13.7%), as well as textiles, apparels & footwear (-RM195.4 million, -26.8%).

Among the major ASEAN countries, declines were recorded in imports from Singapore, Philippines, Cambodia, Myanmar and Brunei.

Import Performance for Economic Sectors

Manufactured goods, which accounted for 86.6 per cent of total imports, increased by 18.6 per cent y-o-y, rising from RM94.1 billion to RM111.6 billion. This performance was driven by higher imports of E&E products (+RM17.5 billion, +44.4%) and machinery, equipment & parts (+RM1.3 billion, +15.2%).

Imports of mining products totalled RM8.8 billion, up 4.7 per cent compared to the previous year and accounted for 6.8 per cent of Malaysia's total imports. This growth was attributable to higher imports of metalliferous ores & metal scrap (+RM942.4 million, +79.7%).

Imports of agriculture products (4.4% of total imports) declined by 18.1 per cent or RM1.2 billion to RM5.6 billion. The contraction was mainly attributed to lower imports of other agriculture (-RM579.7 million, -12.9%), natural rubber (-RM389.3 million, -47.0%), other vegetable oils (-RM181.4 million, -34.1%) and palm oil & palm oil-based agriculture products (-RM141.2 million, -30.4%).

Imports of Selected Major Products

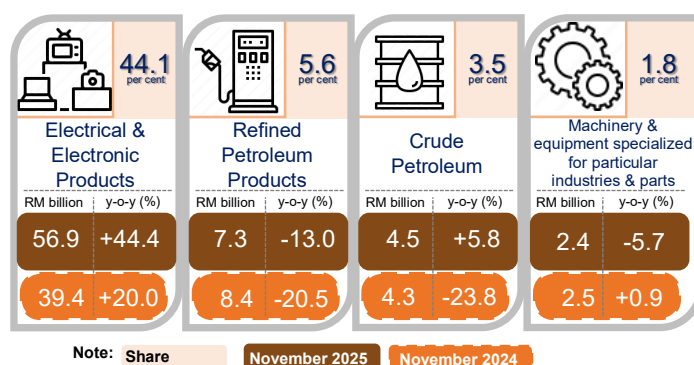
Imports recorded a strong performance in November 2025, with positive growth observed in the following products:

- E&E products accounted for 44.1 per cent of total imports, increasing by RM17.5 billion or 44.4 per cent to RM56.9 billion; and
- Crude petroleum contributed 3.5 per cent to total imports, rising by RM246.1 million or 5.8 per cent to RM4.5 billion, in line with an increase in import volume (+18.9%). However, a decline was recorded in the average unit value (-11.1%) and Brent oil prices (-19.9%) to RM264.3 per barrel.

Nevertheless, negative growth was recorded for the following products:

- Refined petroleum products, which accounted for 5.6 per cent of total imports, declined by RM1.1 billion or 13.0 per cent to RM7.3 billion, due to a contraction in the average unit value (-13.1%); and
- Machinery & equipment specialized for particular industries & parts, accounting for 1.8 per cent of total imports, fell by 5.7 per cent or RM142.0 million to RM2.4 billion.

Exhibit 4: Imports of Selected Major Product, November 2024 and November 2025



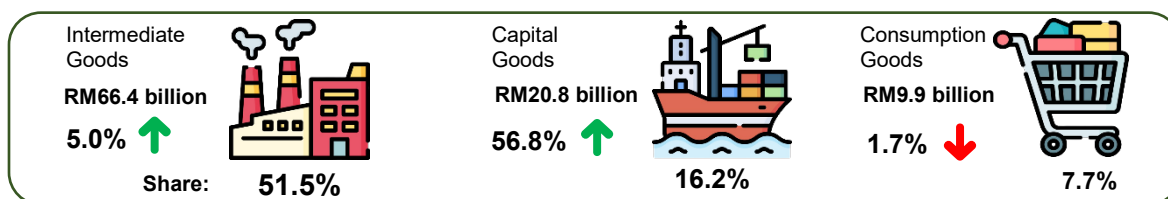
Imports for End Use & Broad Economic Categories (BEC) Classification

Total imports in November 2025 amounted to RM128.9 billion, recording an increase of 15.8 per cent compared to the same month of the previous year. The three main categories of imports by End Use, which accounted for 75.4 per cent of total imports, were as follows:

Intermediate goods, valued at RM66.4 billion or 51.5 per cent of total imports, expanded by 5.0 per cent due to higher imports of parts & accessories for capital goods (except transport equipment) (+RM7.7 billion, +33.4%) and parts & accessories of transport equipment (+RM749.1 million, +20.8%).

Capital goods, amounting to RM20.8 billion (16.2% of total imports), increased by 56.8 per cent, driven by higher imports of capital goods (except transport equipment) (+RM7.4 billion, +62.0%) and transport equipment, industrial (+RM169.5 million, +12.3%).

Consumption goods, totalling RM9.9 billion (7.7% of total imports), declined by 1.7 per cent, mainly due to lower imports of non-durable goods (-RM205.2 million, -10.1%).

Malaysia's total trade for November 2025 amounted to RM263.8 billion with exports and imports recording RM135.0 billion and RM128.9 billion, respectively.

Exports was valued at RM135.0 billion in November 2025, increased RM8.9 billion (+7.0%) as compared to the same month of the previous year. The increase in exports was attributed to the higher exports in Pulau Pinang (+RM6.9 billion), Johor (+RM5.2 billion), Perak (+RM699.1 million), Sabah (+RM36.3 million), and Negeri Sembilan (+RM17.7 million). However, exports decreased in Selangor by RM1.4 billion, Sarawak (-RM1.0 billion), Pahang (-RM658.8 million), W.P. Labuan (-RM445.4 million), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (-RM348.0 million), Kedah (-RM272.5 million), Kelantan (-RM266.2 million), Terengganu (-RM66.9 million), Perlis (-RM23.9 million) and Melaka (-RM4.5 million).

Pulau Pinang remained as the top exporter with a contribution of 39.2 per cent, followed by Johor

(21.1%), Selangor (15.2%), Sarawak (6.7%) and W.P. Kuala Lumpur (3.3%).

At the same time, imports in November 2025 increased RM17.6 billion (+15.8%) as compared to the same month in year 2024. The increase in imports was attributed by the higher imports in Pulau Pinang (+RM9.4 billion), Selangor (+RM5.0 billion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+3.2 billion), Johor (+RM707.8 million), Perak (+RM681.3 million), Melaka (+RM398.3 million) and Sabah (+RM165.2 million). However, imports decreased in Negeri Sembilan by RM368.3 million, W.P. Labuan (-RM266.8 million), Sarawak (-RM193.7 million), Pahang (-RM140.7 million), Kelantan (-RM91.3 million), Perlis (-RM57.4 million), Kedah (-RM48.6 million) and Terengganu (-RM27.3 million).

Pulau Pinang dominates Malaysia's imports with a share of 28.6 per cent, followed by Selangor (26.2%), Johor (18.3%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (9.6%) and Kedah (4.9%).

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NOTA TEKNIKAL

1. PENGENALAN

Penerbitan ini mengandungi Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri Malaysia (barangan) berkaitan dengan import dan eksport (termasuk eksport semula) mengikut seksyen dan Bahagian barangan, negara asal dan yang dituju, barangan utama / terpilih, Klasifikasi Kategori Ekonomi Umum (BEC) dan penggunaan akhir serta data pelarasan musim.

Statistik ini juga meliputi Perdagangan Luar Negeri Malaysia (barangan) berkaitan import dan eksport di peringkat negeri (mengikut pintu keluar dan masuk) dengan seluruh dunia.

2. OBJEKTIF

Objektif utama penerbitan ini untuk membekalkan statistik tentang prestasi perdagangan Malaysia dengan negara-negara lain dari segi nilai dan volum barangan. Penerbitan ini menjadi input kepada penggubalan dasar, rujukan penting dalam pelaksanaan keputusan, pemantauan dan penilaian keberkesanan program pembangunan negara serta penyelidikan.

3. BIDANG DAN LIPUTAN

3.1 Malaysia menggunakan 'sistem perdagangan umum' dalam penyusunan Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri. Di bawah sistem ini, sempadan negara digunakan sebagai sempadan perangkaan. Semua barang yang dibawa masuk atau keluar dari negara (selain pengecualian yang disebutkan di para 11 di bawah) direkodkan, sama ada barangan itu tertakluk kepada kelulusan tertentu atau pun tidak. Barangan yang dibawa masuk atau keluar dari gudang-gudang simpanan kastam, Zon Bebas direkodkan di dalam perangkaan ini.

3.2 Butir-butir tentang kapal dan kapal terbang dagangan dan persendirian turut **diambil kira** jika ianya diimport atau dieksport sebagai barang yang dibeli, dijual atau disewa (kewangan) tidak kira sama ada ianya tiba atau berlepas dengan kuasanya sendiri.

3.3 Eksport mengikut lokasi adalah berdasarkan negeri asal (iaitu negeri dalam Malaysia di mana peringkat akhir pengeluaran atau pembuatan berlaku). Sebaliknya, import mengikut lokasi berdasarkan negeri destinasi terakhir (iaitu negeri di mana barangan dikeluarkan daripada kawalan Kastam, tetapi tidak semestinya di mana barangan itu akhirnya dijual atau digunakan).

Ketepatan dalam pelaporan negeri asal dan negeri destinasi akhir dalam dokumentasi oleh pihak Jabatan Kastam Diraja Malaysia (JKDM) memberi kesan kepada kualiti statistik perdagangan barangan mengikut lokasi. Dalam hal ini, lokasi pemuatan/pelepasan akan digunakan sebagai proksi bagi negeri asal/destinasi akhir yang sebenar.

3.4 Aktiviti eksport dan import yang berlaku di kawasan Supra (merangkumi aktiviti pengeluaran yang melangkaui pusat kepentingan ekonomi utama bagi mana- mana negeri) atau periklanan yang dilakukan oleh ejen penghantar tidak termasuk dalam penyusunan statistik import dan eksport mengikut lokasi. Nilai import atau eksport bagi W.P. Kuala Lumpur adalah termasuk W.P. Putrajaya.

4. SUMBER DATA

- 4.1 Pengikraran import dan eksport (*hard/soft copy*) yang diluluskan oleh Jabatan Kastam Diraja Malaysia (JKDM) dan Pihak Berkuasa Zon Bebas.
- 4.2 Keterangan mengenai pengiraman bungkusan pos/courier yang dibekalkan oleh Pos Malaysia Berhad.
- 4.3 Penyata dan pengikraran eksport mengenai *bunkers* dan *stores* yang dibekalkan kepada kapal terbang yang dikeluarkan/diluluskan oleh syarikat-syarikat petroleum.
- 4.4 Penyata penjualan barangan yang dibekalkan oleh pengusaha-pengusaha kedai bebas cukai.
- 4.5 Penyata jualan dan belian elektrik yang dikeluarkan oleh syarikat pengeluar

5. KONSEP DAN DEFINISI

- 5.1 Penyusunan statistik ini selaras dengan garis panduan dalam **International Merchandise Trade Statistics: Concepts and Definitions (IMTS) 2010** daripada Pertubuhan Bangsa-Bangsa Bersatu.

5.2 Import

Sesuatu barangan dianggap sebagai import apabila ianya dibawa **masuk** ke dalam negara, sama ada terus ataupun disimpan di gudang dalam kawasan yang dikawalselia oleh pihak Kastam tanpa mengira sama ada barangan tersebut adalah untuk kegunaan sendiri, diproses, digunakan dalam pembuatan ataupun untuk dieksport semula ke negara lain.

5.3 Eksport

Sesuatu barangan (keluaran atau buatan tempatan atau diimport untuk dieksport semula) dianggap sebagai eksport apabila ianya dibawa **keluar** dari negara.

5.4 Eksport Domestik

Sesuatu barangan (keluaran atau buatan tempatan) dianggap sebagai eksport domestik apabila ianya dibawa **keluar** dari negara.

5.5 Eksport Semula

Sesuatu barangan dianggap sebagai eksport semula apabila ianya dibawa **keluar** dari negara dalam keadaan seperti mana ianya **diimport** tanpa mengalami sebarang **perubahan**. Proses membungkus semula, menyisih atau menggred tidak dikira sebagai satu proses perubahan.

5.6 Imbangan Perdagangan

Imbangan perdagangan ialah perbezaan antara nilai eksport dan import. Apabila eksport melebihi import **lebih** direkodkan manakala **defisit** pula dicatatkan apabila import melebihi eksport.

6. ASAS PENILAIAN

- 6.1 **WTO Valuation Agreement (1994)** digunakan sebagai asas penilaian untuk semua transaksi barangan.
- 6.2 **Nilai** ditunjukkan dalam Ringgit Malaysia.
- 6.3 **Import** dinilai mengikut **cif (cost, insurance and freight – kos, insuran dan tambang)** iaitu nilai barangan di pasaran di sempadan statistik/kastam negara pengimport termasuk semua perbelanjaan insuran dan tambang semasa dalam perjalanan **tetapi** kos pemunggaan dari alat pengangkutan tidak diambil kira **kecuali** kos tersebut ditanggung sendiri oleh pengangkut.
- 6.4 **Eksport** dinilai mengikut **fob (free on board)** iaitu nilai barangan di pasaran di sempadan statistik/kastam negara pengeksport termasuk semua perbelanjaan pengangkutan ke sempadan tersebut, duti eksport dan duti lain yang perlu dibayar serta kos untuk memunggah barang ke atas alat pengangkutan **kecuali** kos terakhir itu ditanggung sendiri oleh pengangkut.

7. KLASIFIKASI BARANG DAGANGAN

- 7.1 Penyusunan Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri (barangan) bagi bulan rujukan Januari 2022 hingga Mei 2022 menggunakan Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System (HS) 2017 yang juga dikenali sebagai Perintah Duti Kastam (PDK) 2017. Bermula bulan rujukan Jun 2022, HS2022 yang juga dikenali sebagai PDK2022 telah digunakan menggantikan HS2017. Walau bagaimanapun, pengkelasan mengikut Standard International Trade Classification (S.I.T.C) Rev.4 masih digunakan dengan penyesuaian.
- 7.2 Selepas perbincangan dan perundingan dengan Lembaga Minyak Sawit Malaysia (MPOB), pilihan kod untuk minyak kelapa sawit dan hasil keluaran berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit adalah berdasarkan minyak kelapa sawit tulen dan hasil keluaran berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit serta kod-kod yang berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit dan hasil keluaran berasaskan minyak kelapa sawit (melebihi 50%).

8. VOLUM

Volum merupakan berat bersih atau ukuran lain bagi barangan itu, tidak termasuk kontena. Jika barangan itu dilaporkan dalam pelbagai unit ukuran, maka unit ukuran tersebut tidak dapat diselaraskan. Oleh itu, hanya nilai barangan sahaja dipaparkan.

9. NEGARA ASAL DAN YANG DITUJU

- 9.1 **Negara asal** merujuk kepada lokasi / negara barangan yang dibawa masuk ke dalam negara. Jika maklumat negara asalnya tidak dapat ditentukan. Sebagai contoh, bagi barangan melalui Singapura, maka import berkenaan dilaporkan dari Singapura.
- 9.2 **Negara yang dituju** merujuk kepada destinasi/negara akhir barangan itu dijangka akan digunakan. Bagi barangan yang dihantar dengan *optional bill of lading*, negara di mana pelabuhan pertama diketahui akan dilaporkan sebagai negara yang dituju. Jika maklumat negara yang dituju tidak dapat ditentukan. Sebagai contoh, bagi

barangan yang dieksport melalui Singapura, maka eksport berkenaan dilaporkan ke Singapura.

- 9.3 **Bagi bunkers dan stores yang dibekalkan kepada kapal dan kapal terbang,** negara yang dituju ditentukan mengikut lokasi/negara residen syarikat pengendali kapal atau kapal terbang tersebut.

10. TRANSAKSI BERNILAI RENDAH (TBR)

Mulai bulan rujukan Januari 2023, transaksi tunggal 'di bawah RM1,000' bagi Semenanjung Malaysia telah diliputi dalam penyusunan Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri dan transaksi bernilai 'di bawah RM5,000' telah dilaporkan mengikut kod HS yang diikrar. Manakala mulai bulan rujukan Januari 2024, transaksi tunggal 'di bawah RM2,000' untuk Sabah dan Sarawak telah dilaporkan mengikut kod HS yang diikrar.

11. PENGECEUALIAN

Barang-barang yang tidak termasuk dalam Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri adalah:

- 11.1 barangan transit, iaitu pengangkutan barangan di bawah kawalan kastam dari sebuah stesen kastam ke sebuah stesen kastam yang lain. Misalnya, pergerakan barangan dari Thailand ke Singapura melalui Semenanjung Malaysia dan pergerakan barangan dari sebuah zon bebas ke sebuah zon bebas yang lain di Malaysia. Barang dalam transit yang diliputi *through bills of lading / air-way bills* juga termasuk di bawah kategori ini;
- 11.2 barangan pindah kapal, iaitu pemindahan barangan di bawah kawalan pihak yang berkuasa, dari suatu pengangkutan yang digunakan untuk pengimportan kepada suatu pengangkutan lain yang digunakan untuk pengeksporan **dalam** kawasan kawalan pihak berkuasa yang sama. Stesen ini merupakan stesen pengimportan dan juga pengeksporan. Sebagai contoh, barangan dari Myanmar yang dibawa masuk ke kawasan kastam Pulau Pinang yang semata-mata bertujuan untuk dihantar ke negara ketiga (misalnya ke Hong Kong). Satu lagi contoh adalah barangan dari India yang dibawa masuk melalui Kawasan Bebas Pelabuhan Klang yang semata-mata bertujuan untuk dihantar ke Negara Ketiga (misalnya ke Sepanyol);
- 11.3 emas (kewangan) dan wang kertas serta duit syiling dalam edaran;
- 11.4 barangan yang diimport dan dieksport oleh, atau bagi pihak perkhidmatan diplomatik dan Angkatan Tentera Bukan Malaysia;
- 11.5 filem wayang untuk disewa;
- 11.6 kemasukan barangan untuk sementara waktu dan ianya tertakluk kepada pengeksporan semula dalam keadaan yang sama. Barangan ini diimport untuk tujuan tertentu dan dieksport semula dalam masa yang telah ditentukan tanpa mengalami sebarang perubahan, kecuali susut nilai yang biasa. Contohnya, binatang dan motokar bagi pertunjukan sarkas, perlumbaan, pertandingan dan pameran serta peralatan-peralatan bunyi untuk pertunjukan muzikal;
- 11.7 *barges (lash)* yang digunakan untuk mengangkut kargo dari kapal ke pantai atau sebaliknya;

- 11.8 ikan dan hasil laut lain yang dibawa oleh kapal laut berdaftar di Malaysia dan mendarat terus dari laut.
 - 11.9 bekas untuk menyimpan sesuatu barang/benda, silinder, botol dan seumpamanya yang dinyatakan sebagai 'dikembalikan';
 - 11.10 bekalan dan minyak yang dibekalkan kepada kapal laut dan kapal terbang yang dikendalikan oleh operator yang menetap di Malaysia;
 - 11.11 semua sampel, pemberian dan bahan untuk ujian atau analisa tanpa mengira nilai transaksi yang terlibat;
 - 11.12 tiket loteri & toto;
 - 11.13 pergerakan barangan di antara Negeri di dalam Semenanjung Malaysia tanpa mengira cara pengangkutan serta pergerakan barangan melalui **darat** di antara Sabah dan Sarawak;
 - 11.14 disket atau CD-ROM yang mengandungi perisian komputer dan / atau data, dibuat mengikut pesanan, audio dan videotapes yang mengandungi perakaman asal dan customised blueprints, dll; dan
 - 11.15 barangan untuk **dibaiki**.
12. **KEMASKINI TERHADAP NEGARA-NEGARA KESATUAN EROPAH (EU)**
- 12.1 Mulai 1 Julai 2013, Croatia menganggotai EU. Perkembangan ini telah dirangkumkan di dalam penerbitan mulai bulan Julai 2013 dan seterusnya.
 - 12.2 Bermula 1 Februari 2020, United Kingdom secara rasminya keluar daripada EU. Perkembangan ini telah diambilkira di dalam penerbitan mulai bulan Februari 2020 dan seterusnya.
13. Bermula rujukan Januari 2022, Statistik Eksport Produk Halal mengikut Pengelasan Barangan disusun daripada hasil gabungan pangkalan data Perdagangan Luar Negeri dengan senarai syarikat berstatus halal yang diperoleh daripada Jabatan Kemajuan Islam Malaysia (JAKIM).
14. **PELARASAN MUSIM**
- Data siri masa adalah amat berguna untuk ahli ekonomi, pembuat dasar dan polisi serta penganalisis siri masa untuk mengenal pasti ciri-ciri penting siri ekonomi seperti arah, *turning point* dan konsistensi antara penunjuk ekonomi yang lain. Kadang-kadang ciri ini sukar untuk diperhatikan kerana pergerakan bermusim. Oleh itu, sekiranya kesan bermusim boleh disingkirkan, perilaku data siri ini dapat dilihat dengan lebih baik. Anggaran dan penyingkiran kesan bermusim dipanggil pelarasan bermusim.
- Pelarasan bermusim adalah satu proses untuk mengenal pasti dan menyingkirkan bentuk pola bermusim yang biasa berlaku dalam tempoh satu tahun, yang mungkin juga merangkumi pengaruh dari kesan cuti yang bergerak dan hari bekerja/ berdagang bagi suatu tempoh. Objektif utama proses ini adalah untuk menyerlahkan dasar arah aliran dan pergerakan-pergerakan jangka pendek dalam siri ini.

Di Malaysia, kebanyakan data siri masa terjejas oleh kesan bermusim. Oleh itu, untuk menghapuskan kesan bermusim dan juga melaraskan musim data siri masa ekonomi Malaysia, pakej pelarasan bermusim standard, X-12 ARIMA telah digunakan oleh Jabatan Perangkaan, Malaysia.

Data siri masa ekonomi Malaysia kerap dipengaruhi oleh perayaan agama utama seperti Aidilfitri bagi umat Islam, Tahun Baru Cina untuk kaum Cina dan Deepavali untuk kaum India. Tarikh perayaan-perayaan ini tetap mengikut tahun lunar tetapi berbeza-beza mengikut kalendar Gregorian. Oleh itu, untuk menganggar dan menyingkirkan kesan cuti yang bergerak dari data siri masa, satu prosedur telah dibangunkan iaitu *Seasonal Adjustment for Malaysia* (SEAM).

Kaedah SEAM digunakan untuk membuang kesan bermusim bagi data Perdagangan Luar Negeri Malaysia. Pelarasan musim dibuat ke atas data bulanan bagi jumlah eksport dan import. Data siri pelarasan bermusim untuk tiga tahun sebelumnya akan disemak setiap tahun apabila data untuk 12 bulan lengkap.

15. KLASIFIKASI MENGIKUT KATEGORI EKONOMI UMUM (BEC)

- 15.1 Klasifikasi mengikut Kategori Ekonomi Umum (BEC) diwujudkan adalah untuk meringkaskan Perangkaan Perdagangan Luar Negeri (PPLN) mengikut kelas komoditi ekonomi yang luas. Di samping itu, ia dibentuk sebagai pengantara untuk menukarkan data PPLN yang disusun berdasarkan HS kepada kategori penggunaan akhir yang lebih bermakna dalam konteks Sistem Akaun Negara (SNA) iaitu barang modal, barang pengantara dan barang penggunaan. Penyusunan ini membolehkan data PPLN dihubungkan dengan perangkaan ekonomi umum seperti perangkaan akaun negara dan perangkaan perindustrian bagi tujuan penganalisan ekonomi di peringkat negara, kawasan dan dunia.
- 15.2 BEC termasuk sembilan belas kategori asas. Setiap kategori BEC didefinisikan dari segi bahagian, kumpulan, sub-kumpulan dan tajuk HS. Setiap tajuk asas HS ditetapkan secara khusus kepada satu kategori BEC. Penetapan ini dibuat berasaskan penggunaan akhir yang utama bagi sesuatu komoditi dalam setiap tajuk HS, walaupun erdapat banyak komoditi yang didagangkan di peringkat antarabangsa boleh dikelaskan kepada pelbagai kegunaan.
- 15.3 Statistik dalam Jadual 16: Import Barangan Mengikut Klasifikasi Kategori Ekonomi Umum dijana berdasarkan import tertangguh iaitu import tolak eksport semula. Angka tersebut boleh menjadi negatif bagi bulan rujukan tertentu jika eksport semula melebihi daripada import.

16. KERAHSIAAN DATA

Data perdagangan telah disusun di bawah peruntukan ***Statistics Act 1965 (Revised-1989)***. Akta ini mensyaratkan bahawa kandungan penyata individu adalah sulit. Selaras dengan peruntukan tersebut, hanya angka agregat diterbitkan.

17. DASAR PINDAAN

Data pada bulan semasa adalah sementara (provisional) dan tertakluk kepada pindaan sehingga ia dimuktamadkan. Pindaan dibuat sekiranya wujud maklumat tambahan. Bermula tahun 2021, data muktamad akan dikeluarkan 7 (tujuh) bulan selepas tahun rujukan.

Perangkaan muktamad perdagangan luar negeri bagi tahun rujukan 2021 telah digunakan mulai bulan rujukan Jun 2022.

18. **PEMBUNDARAN**

Jumlah-jumlah kecil, apabila dicampurkan, **mungkin** tidak bersamaan dengan jumlah besar disebabkan oleh pembundaran.

TECHNICAL NOTES

1. INTRODUCTION

This publication contains statistics of Malaysia's External trade (merchandise) pertaining to imports and exports (including re-exports) by sections, divisions and groups of commodity, country of origin and destination, selected/major commodities, Broad Economic Category (BEC) classification and end-use as well as seasonally adjusted data.

This publication also contains statistics of Malaysia's External Trade (merchandise) on imports and exports at the state level (based on exit and entry points) with the rest of the world.

2. OBJECTIVE

The main objective of compiling Malaysia's external trade statistics is to provide information on Malaysia's trade performance vis-a-vis the rest of the world in terms of volume and value of merchandise goods. The trade statistics, therefore, serve as a tool in assisting the government in formulating policies and monitoring economic performance as well as for development planning. The data can also be used by the private sector and individuals for specific purposes such as for economic projection and analysis.

3. SCOPE AND COVERAGE

3.1 The 'general trade system' of recording is adopted in compiling Malaysian external trade statistics. Under this system, the national boundary of the country is used as the statistical frontier. All goods entering or leaving the country (except specific exclusions mentioned in paragraph 11 below) are recorded, whether or not such goods are subject to clearance. Accordingly, goods entering or leaving customs bonded warehouses, Free Zones are recorded in the statistics.

*3.2 Details of commercial and private ships and aircraft are also **included** in these statistics if they were imported or exported as goods purchased, sold or leased (financial) whether or not they arrived or departed under their own power.*

3.3 Exports by location based on the state of origin (i.e. state of Malaysia where the final stage of production or manufacturing occurs). On the other hand, imports by location based on the state of final destination (i.e. the state of Malaysia in which goods are released from Customs controls, but not necessarily where they are ultimately sold or consumed).

The accuracy in reporting the actual State of origin and State of final destination on Royal Malaysian Customs Department documentation affects the quality of State merchandise trade statistics. In this case, the location of loading/discharge may be used as a proxy for the actual state of origin/final destination.

3.4 Export and import activities that are taking place in the Supra area (including production activities beyond the centre of predominant economic interest for any state) or declarations made by the agent are not included in the compilation of imports and

exports statistics by location. Imports or exports value for the W.P. Kuala Lumpur includes the W.P. Putrajaya.

4. SOURCE OF DATA

- 4.1 Import and export declarations (hard/soft copy) approved by the Royal Malaysian Customs Department (RMCD) and Free Zone Authorities.
- 4.2 Particulars on postal/courier packages are provided by Pos Malaysia Berhad.
- 4.3 Statements and export declarations on bunkers and stores supplied to aircraft issued/approved by the petroleum companies.
- 4.4 Statements on goods sold are supplied by the operators of duty-free shops.
- 4.5 Statements on the sale and purchase of electricity issued by 'power producer company'.

5. CONCEPTS AND DEFINITIONS

- 5.1 The compilation of these statistics is in accordance with the guidelines of the **International Merchandise Trade Statistics: Concepts and Definitions (IMTS) 2010** from the United Nations.

5.2 Imports

Goods are regarded as imports when they are brought **into** the country either directly or into bonded warehouses, irrespective of whether such goods are for consumption, to be processed, use in manufacturing or subsequent re-exports to other countries.

5.3 Exports

Goods (locally produced or manufactured or imported for subsequent re-exports) are regarded as exports when they are taken **out** of the country.

5.4 Domestic Exports

Goods (locally produced or manufactured) are regarded as domestic exports when they are taken **out** of the country.

5.5 Re-exports

Goods are regarded as re-exports when they are taken **out** of the country in the same form as they were **imported** without any **transformation**. Re-packing, sorting or grading processes are not considered as part of the transformation process.

5.6 Balance of Trade

The balance of trade is the difference between the value of exports and imports. When exports exceed imports it is recorded as a **surplus** while a **deficit** is registered when imports exceed exports.

6. BASIS OF VALUATION

- 6.1 The **WTO Valuation Agreement (1994)** is used as the basis of valuation for all transactions of goods.
- 6.2 **Values** are shown in Malaysian Ringgit.
- 6.3 **Imports** are valued on a **c.i.f. (cost, insurance and freight)** basis, that is, the value of the goods in the market at the statistical / customs frontier of the importing country, including all charges for transport and insurance whilst in transit **but** excluding the cost of unloading from the carrier **unless** it is borne by the carrier.
- 6.4 **Exports** are valued on a **f.o.b. (free on board)** basis, that is, the value of the goods in the market at the statistical / customs frontier of the exporting country, including all costs of transporting the goods to the statistical / customs frontier, export and other duties payable as well as the cost of loading the goods onto the carrier **unless** the latter cost is borne by the carrier.

7. CLASSIFICATION OF COMMODITIES

- 7.1 The compilation of External Trade Statistics (merchandise) for the reference month of January 2022 to May 2022 used the Harmonised Commodity description and Coding system (HS) 2017, also known as Customs Duties Order (PDK) 2017. Commencing from the reference month of June 2022, HS2022 also known as PDK2022 has been used to replace HS2017. However, Standard International Trade Classification (S.I.T.C) Rev.4 is still in use with appropriate updates.
- 7.2 After discussion and consultation with Malaysian Palm Oil Board (MPOB), the selection of codes for palm oil and palm oil-based products is based on pure palm oil and palm oil-based products as well as those codes which are predominantly palm oil and palm oil-based products (more than 50%).

8. VOLUME

Volume, where shown, represent the nett weight or other measurement of the goods exclusive of packing containers. Where a commodity item comprises different kinds of commodities for which a common unit of measurement cannot be used, only values are shown.

9. COUNTRY OF ORIGIN AND DESTINATION

- 9.1 **Country of origin** refers to the location/country of goods brought into the country. If the country of origin information cannot be determined, for example, for goods via Singapore, then the import is reported from Singapore.
- 9.2 **Country of destination** refers to the final destination/country where the goods are expected to be used. For goods sent with a country where the first port is known will be reported as the country of destination. if the destination country information cannot be determined, for example, for goods exported through Singapore, then the exports is reported to Singapore.
- 9.3 **For bunkers and stores supplied to ships and aircraft**, the country of destination is determined according to the country of residence of the operator of the ship or aircraft.

10. LOW VALUE TRANSACTIONS (LVT)

With effect from reference month of January 2023, single transactions with a value 'below RM1,000' for Peninsular Malaysia have been covered in the compilation of External Trade Statistics and transactions worth 'below RM5,000' have been reported according to the pledged HS code. Meanwhile with effect from reference month of January 2024, single transactions with a value 'below RM2,000' for Sabah and Sarawak have been reported according to the pledged HS code.

11. EXCLUSIONS

Classes of goods excluded from external trade statistics are: -

- 11.1 transit cargo, that is goods transported under customs control from one Customs office to another. Examples are the movement of goods from Thailand bound for Singapore through Peninsular Malaysia and the movement of goods within Malaysia from one free trade zone to another. All goods in transit covered through bills of lading/air-way bills are also included in this category;
- 11.2 transshipment cargo, that is goods transferred under the control of the relevant authorities from the importing means of transport to the exporting means of transport **within** the area of control of the same authorities, which is the office of both importation and exportation. For example, goods from Myanmar brought into the Pulau Pinang Customs area for the sole purpose of transport to a third country (e.g. to Hong Kong). Another example is goods from India brought into the Port Klang Free Zone for the sole purpose of transport to a third country (e.g. to Spain);
- 11.3 gold bullion (monetary) and issued currency notes and coins;
- 11.4 goods imported and exported by, or on behalf of, diplomatic services and non- Malaysian Armed Forces;
- 11.5 exposed cinematographic films on a rental basis;
- 11.6 temporary admission of goods subject to re-exportation in the same state. Such goods must be imported for a specific purpose and must be intended for re- exportation within a specified period without having undergone any change except normal depreciation.

Examples are animals and cars for circuses, races, competitions and exhibitions and instruments/sound equipment for musical performances;

- 11.7 *barges (lash) used for the transportation of cargo from vessel to shore or vice- versa;*
- 11.8 *fish and other marine produce landed by Malaysian registered vessels direct from the sea;*
- 11.9 *containers, cylinders, bottles, crates and the like specified as returnable;*
- 11.10 *stores and fuel supplied to ships and aircraft handled by operators of Malaysian residence;*
- 11.11 *samples, gifts and specimens for test or analysis, irrespective of value;*
- 11.12 *toto & lottery tickets;*
- 11.13 *movement of goods by any mode of transportation between states within Peninsular Malaysia and movement of goods by **land** between Sabah and Sarawak;*
- 11.14 *diskettes or CD-ROMs with stored computer software and/or data, developed to order, audio and videotapes containing original recordings and customised blueprints, etc; and*
- 11.15 *goods for **repair**.*

12. **UPDATE TO EUROPEAN UNION (EU) COUNTRIES**

- 12.1 *From 1st July 2013, Croatia has joined EU. This development has been incorporated in the publication from July 2013 onwards.*
- 12.2 *Starting from 1st February 2020, the United Kingdom officially leaves the EU. This development has been considered in the publication from February 2020 onwards.*

- 13. *Commencing from January 2022, statistics on Exports of Halal Products by Commodity Classification is compiled from an integrated external trade database with list of Halal certified companies which obtained from the Department of Islamic Development Malaysia (JAKIM).*

14. **SEASONAL ADJUSTMENT**

Time-series data are very useful for economists, policy & decision makers and time-series analysts to identify the important features of economic series such as direction, turning point and consistency between other economic indicators. Sometimes this feature is difficult to observe because of seasonal movements. Thus, if the seasonal effect can be removed, the behaviour of the series would be better viewed. The estimation and removal of the seasonal effects is called seasonal adjustment.

Seasonal adjustment is a process to identify and to remove the regular within-a-year seasonal pattern, which may also include the influences of moving holidays and working / trading days effect in each period. The ultimate objective of the process is to highlight the underlying trends and short-term movements in the series.

In Malaysia, most of the time series data are affected by seasonal effects. Hence, to eliminate the seasonal effect as well as to seasonally adjust the Malaysian economic time series data, a standard seasonal adjustment package, X-12 ARIMA was used by Department of Statistics, Malaysia.

Malaysian economic time series data are often affected by major religious festivals such as Eid-ul Fitr of the Muslims, Chinese New Year of the Chinese and Deepavali of the Indians. These festivals' dates are fixed according to the lunar year but vary according to the Gregorian calendar. Therefore, to estimate and remove moving holiday effect from time-series data, a procedure was developed, namely Seasonal Adjustment for Malaysia (SEAM).

The SEAM method is used to remove seasonal effect for Malaysia's merchandise external trade data. The seasonal adjustment is carried out on monthly total exports and total imports. The seasonally adjusted series data for the preceding three years are revised each year when the figures for complete 12 months become available.

15. CLASSIFICATION BY BROAD ECONOMIC CATEGORIES (BEC)

- 15.1** *The BEC was originally devised mainly for the summarization of data on international trade by large economic classes of commodities. In addition, it was designed to serve as a means for converting external trade data compiled on the HS into end use categories that are meaningful within the framework of the System of National Accounts (SNA) namely capital goods, intermediate goods, and consumption goods. This aggregation permits external trade statistics to be considered jointly with other sets of general economic statistics such as national accounts and industrial statistics for national, regional or world level economic analysis.*
- 15.2** *The BEC includes nineteen basic categories. Each category of the BEC is defined in terms of divisions, groups, sub-groups and basic headings of HS. Each HS basic heading is allocated entirely to one BEC category. The allocation is done on the basis of the main end use of the commodities in each HS basic heading, although it is recognised that many commodities that are traded internationally may be put to a variety of uses.*
- 15.3** *The statistics in Table 16: Imports of Commodities by Broad Economic Categories Classifications are generated based on retained imports i.e. imports minus re-exports. The figure could be negative for a reference month if re-exports are higher than imports.*

16. CONFIDENTIALITY REQUIREMENTS

*The trade data statistics have been compiled under the provisions of the **Statistics Act 1965 (Revised-1989)**. The Act stipulates that the contents of individual returns are **confidential**. In conformity with the said stipulation, only aggregated figures are published.*

17. REVISION POLICY

Data for the current month is provisional and subject to revision until it is finalised. Revisions are made if there are additional information. Starting 2021, final data will be released by 7 (seven) months after reference year. Final external trade statistics for reference year 2021 was used from reference month June 2022.

18. ROUNDING
