



MONTHLY RUBBER STATISTICS MALAYSIA, NOVEMBER 2020

Production of natural rubber decreased 14.8 per cent in November 2020

Production of natural rubber decreased **14.8** per cent in November 2020 to **42,554** tonnes as compared to **49,943** tonnes in the previous month. Meanwhile, year on year also showed a decreased in production with **19.7** per cent.

Exports of Malaysia's natural rubber amounted **56,522** tonnes in November 2020, an increase of **3.7** per cent against **54,492** tonnes in October 2020. P.R. China remains as the main destination for natural rubber exports with **57.8** per cent of total exports in November 2020 followed by Germany (**9.1%**), Iran (**5.1%**), Finland (**3.4%**) and Turkey (**3.4%**).

Rubber gloves was the main export item with export value RM**4.4** billion in October 2020, an increase of **0.9** per cent to RM**4.5** billion in November 2020. United States of America, Germany and P.R. China were among the highest importer of rubber gloves.

The stocks of natural rubber increased in November 2020 with **259,440** tonnes as compared to **258,052** tonnes in October 2020 with an increase of **0.5** per cent.

Average price of Latex Concentrate recorded an increase of **620.76** sen per kilogramme as compared to October 2020 (**576.14** sen per kilogramme). Standard Malaysian Rubber 20 (S.M.R. 20) also increased to **632.74** sen per kilogramme as compared to **621.76** sen per kilogramme for the same period.

Total domestic consumption for natural rubber was **44,236** tonnes, a decrease of **8.4** per cent as compared to the previous month. Rubber gloves industry continues to dominate the use of natural rubber with **33,110** tonnes or **74.8** per cent from the total domestic consumption.

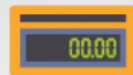

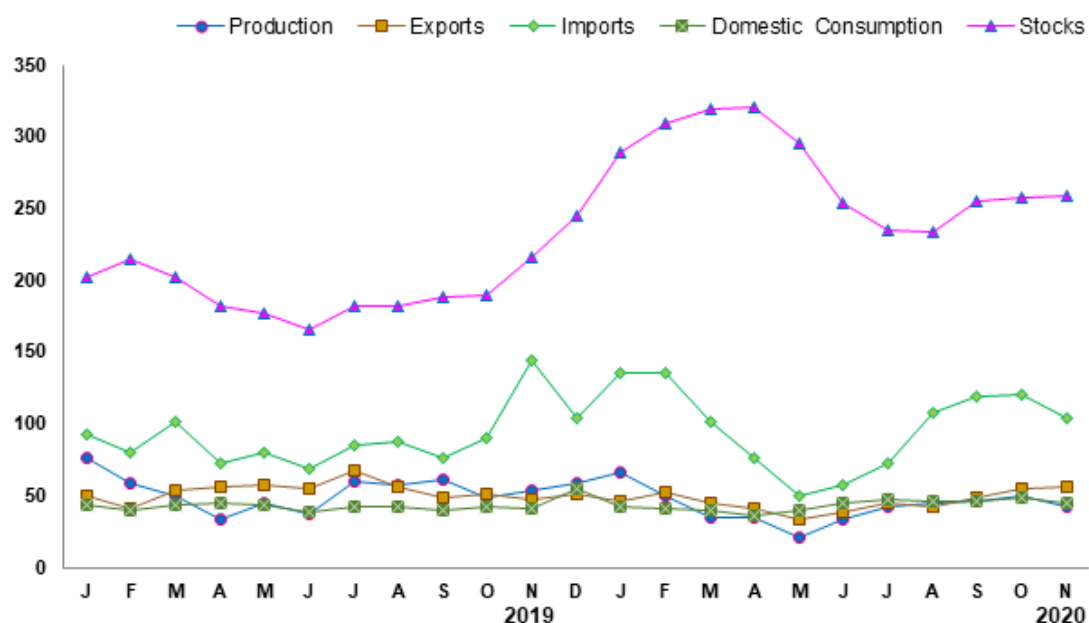
