MALAYSIA'S TRADE PERFORMANCE, JUNE 2021

Malaysia's total trade in June 2021 surged by 29.3 per cent, reaching RM188.7 billion as compared to RM145.9 billion in June 2020. Exports remained strong at a higher level, increasing by 27.2 per cent to RM105.5 billion compared to June 2020. Imports in June 2021 amounted at RM83.2 billion soared by 32.1 per cent year-on-year (y-o-y). Trade balance continued to record a surplus of RM22.2 billion with an increase of 11.7 per cent.

On a month-on-month (m-o-m) basis, exports, imports, total trade and trade surplus recorded positive growths of 14.3 per cent, 5.9 per cent, 10.4 per cent and 61.7 per cent, respectively.

The overall performance for the second quarter (Q2) of 2021 also experienced significant increase as compared to Q2 of 2020. Exports, imports, total trade and trade surplus expanded by 44.0 per cent, 33.3 per cent, 39.0 per cent and 122.7 per cent, respectively.

A. EXPORTS

1. Performance of Exports

Malaysia's exports remained strong at RM105.5 billion jumped by 27.2 per cent y-o-y. The expansion was driven by both domestic exports and re-exports. Domestic exports stood at RM84.7 billion and contributed 80.3 per cent to total exports, grew by 21.0 per cent. On the same note, re-exports which was valued at RM20.8 billion, grew by 61.2 per cent y-o-y. In comparison to May 2021, exports went up 14.3 per cent or RM13.2 billion. Analysis of the seasonally adjusted terms m-o-m, exports increased by 23.3 per cent or RM21.6 billion to RM114.5 billion.

Exports continue with strong growth, grew 27.2 per cent in June 2021

Chart 1: Domestic Exports, Re-Exports (RM billion) and Annual Change (%)

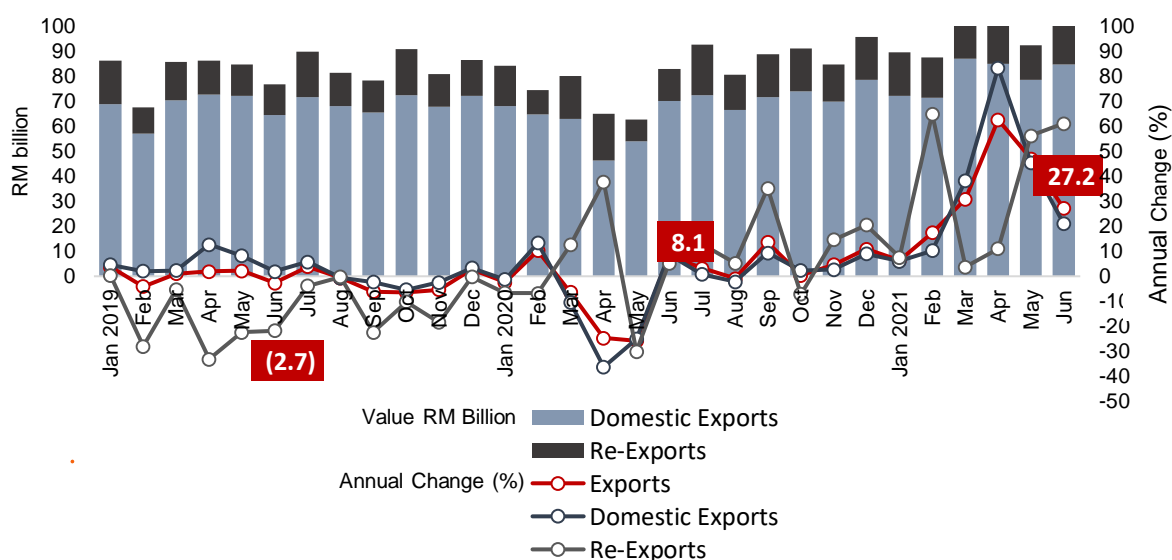
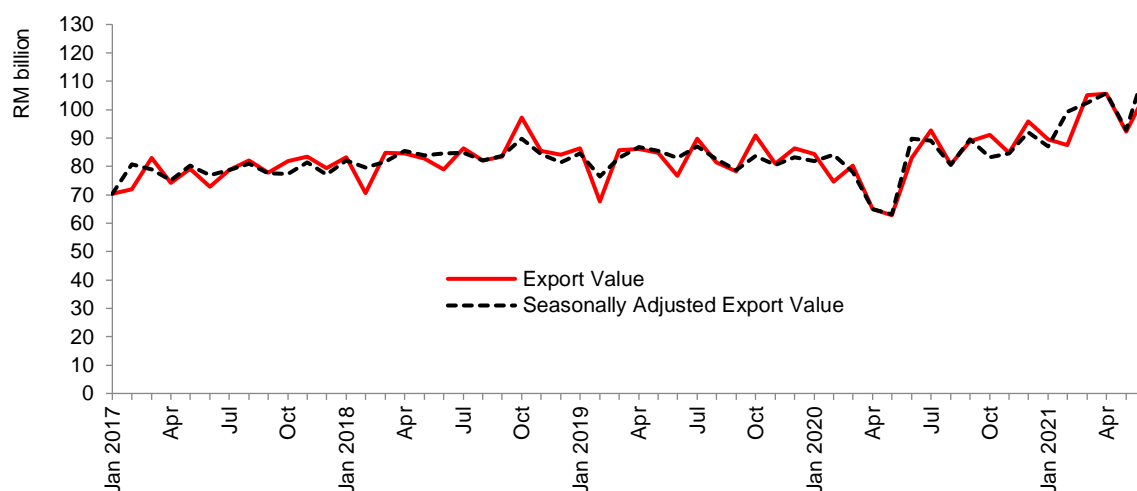


Chart 2: Actual Export Value and Seasonally Adjusted Export Value, RM billion



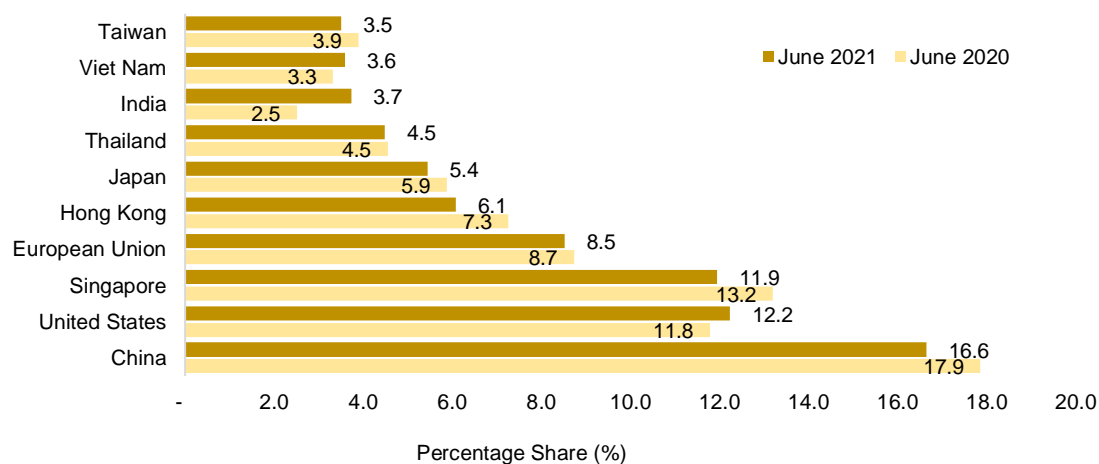
2. Export Performance for Major Country of Destination

China and the United States were the major country of destinations in June 2021 with a total contribution of 28.9 per cent to Malaysia's exports.

Exports to China with a value of RM17.6 billion, represented 16.6 per cent of total exports, registering an 18.5 per cent or RM2.7 billion increase y-o-y. The expansion was led by higher exports of electrical & electronic (E&E) products, surged by 29.7 per cent or RM1.3 billion, petroleum products (+RM1.1 billion, +101.8%) and chemical & chemical products (+RM277.8 million, +20.4%).

Exports to the United States in June 2021 amounted to RM12.9 billion and accounted for 12.2 per cent of Malaysia's total exports, increased by 32.0 per cent or RM3.1 billion y-o-y. The expansion was led by higher exports of rubber products which rose by 220.5 per cent with a value of RM1.9 billion, E&E products (+RM581.1 million, +12.2%), manufactures of metal (+RM259.2 million, +108.5%) and machinery, equipment and parts (+RM140.2 million, +30.1%).

Chart 3: Percentage Share of Exports by Major Country of Destination, June 2020 and June 2021

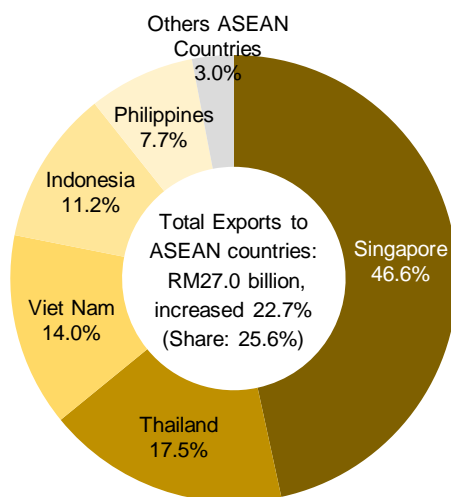


3. Exports to ASEAN Countries

Exports to ASEAN in June 2021 accounting for 25.6 per cent of total exports, grew 22.7 per cent from RM22.0 billion in June 2020 to RM27.0 billion. This increment was contributed mainly from petroleum products as it widened by 42.8 per cent or RM1.1 billion as well as E&E products which expanded by 11.0 per cent or RM938.0 million.

Among ASEAN, Singapore dominated as country of destination for exports, with contribution of 46.6 per cent or RM12.6 billion, expanded by 18.9 per cent over the previous year.

Chart 4: Percentage Share of Exports, June 2021



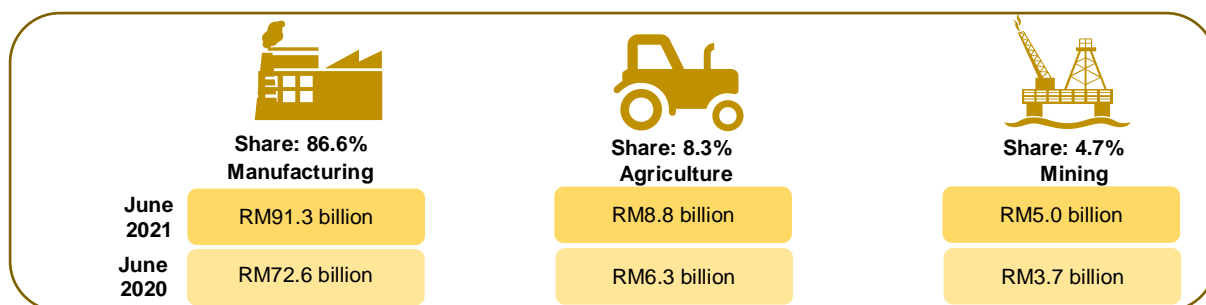
4. Export Performance for Economic Sectors

Exports of manufactured products in June 2021, which constituted 86.6 per cent of total exports, expanded by 25.8 per cent or RM18.7 billion y-o-y to RM91.3 billion. The main contributors to the expansion were petroleum products (+RM5.1 billion, +113.6%), followed by E&E products (+RM4.6 billion, +14.1%), rubber products (+RM3.7 billion, +103.5%), chemical & chemical products (+RM2.3 billion, +53.5%), palm oil-based manufactured products (+RM1.3 billion, +71.1%) and manufacture of metal (+RM1.3 billion, +34.0%).

Exports of agriculture products, which contributed 8.3 per cent of total exports increased by 40.0 per cent from RM6.3 billion in June 2020 to RM8.8 billion. The increase was in accordance with higher exports of palm oil and palm oil-based agriculture products which grew by 51.0 per cent from RM4.7 billion to RM7.1 billion.

Meanwhile, exports of mining products which represented 4.7 per cent of total exports recorded positive growth of 32.9 per cent from RM3.7 billion in June 2020 to RM5.0 billion. This was supported by higher exports of crude petroleum (+RM998.8 million, +109.5%), LNG (+RM262.6 million, +12.4%) and condensates & other petroleum oil (+RM137.5 million, +384.8%).

5. Exports of Selected Major Product

The expansion in exports for June 2021 has been seen in the positive growth of the following products:

- E&E products (35.2% of total exports), posted a double-digit growth of 14.1 per cent (+RM4.6 billion) to RM37.2 billion;
- Palm oil and palm oil-based products (9.7% of total exports) grew by RM3.7 billion (+56.6%) to RM10.2 billion. Exports of palm oil, the major commodity in this group of products rose by RM2.1 billion or 49.1 per cent along with the rise of average unit value (+81.4%), but export volume decreased (-17.8%);
- Refined petroleum products, which accounted for 7.6 per cent of total exports, expanded by RM4.3 billion or 114.5 per cent to RM8.0 billion in line with the increase in average unit value (+85.3%) and export volume (+15.8%);
- Crude petroleum, which constituted 1.8 per cent to total exports increased RM1.0 billion or 109.5 per cent to RM1.9 billion as a result of the increase in average unit value (+122.2%), but export volume decreased (-5.7%); and
- Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG), accounting for 2.3 per cent of total exports, increased RM262.6 million or 12.4 per cent consistent with the growth in average unit value (+14.6%). In contrary, export volume declined (-2.0%).

However, exports of timber and timber-based products, which contributed 1.3 per cent to total exports declined by 27.6 per cent or RM537.3 million to RM1.4 billion.

B. IMPORTS

1. Performance of Imports

Malaysia's imports in June 2021 totaled RM83.2 billion, continued to register a growth of 32.1 per cent or RM20.2 billion. On a m-o-m basis, imports grew 5.9 per cent or RM4.7 billion. Based on seasonally adjusted terms, imports increased 14.0 per cent to RM87.8 billion.

On a y-o-y basis, imports by end use registered an increase with the rise of the intermediate goods, capital goods and consumption goods.

Chart 5: Imports, Value (RM billion) and Annual Change (%)

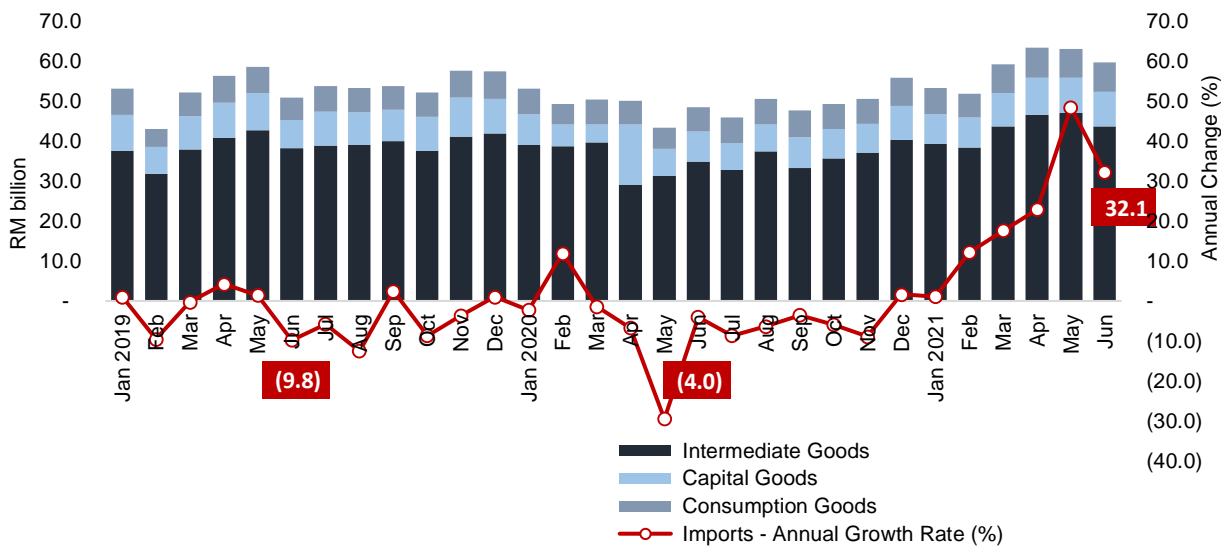
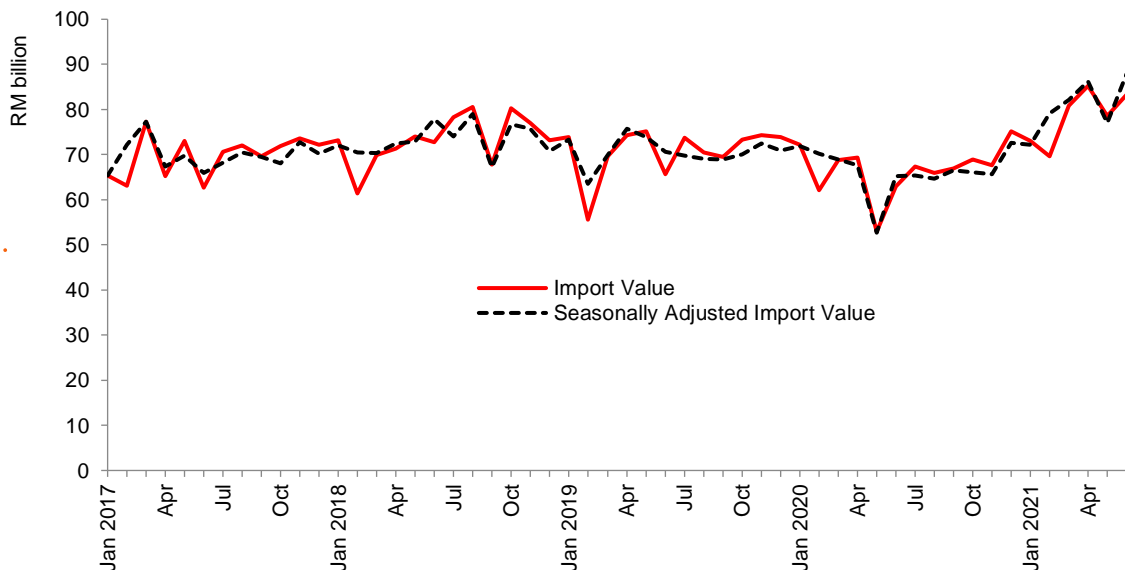


Chart 6: Actual Import Value and Seasonally Adjusted Imports Value, RM billion



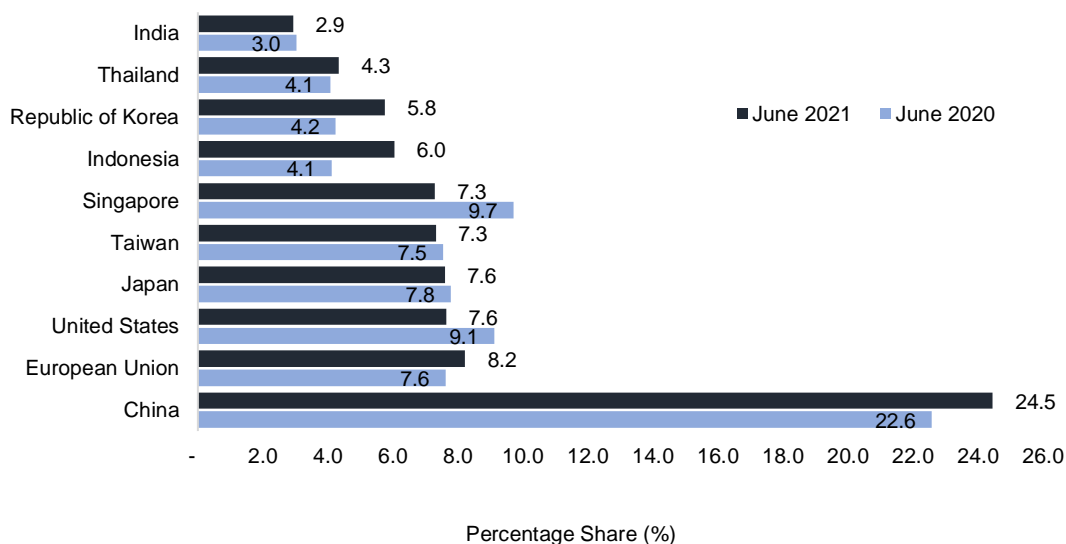
2. Imports Performance for Major Country of Origin

Two main countries of origin for Malaysia's imports in June 2021, contributed 32.7 per cent of total imports were China and the European Union.

Imports from China which represented 24.5 per cent of Malaysia's imports, expanded by 43.0 per cent or RM6.1 billion to RM20.4 billion. This was contributed mainly by significant growth in imports of E&E products, increased by 31.3 per cent or RM1.8 billion, petroleum products (+RM1.4 billion, +825.5%), and chemical & chemical products (+RM1.2 billion, +109.9%).

Imports from the European Union was valued at RM6.8 billion, made up 8.2 per cent of Malaysia's imports, grew by 42.6 per cent or RM2.0 billion y-o-y. This was mainly due to the increased in imports of E&E products (+RM1.1 billion, +99.8%), transport equipment (+RM442.5 million, +142.2%) and petroleum products (+RM264.1 million, +405.4%).

Chart 7: Percentage Share of Imports by Major Country of Origin, June 2020 and June 2021

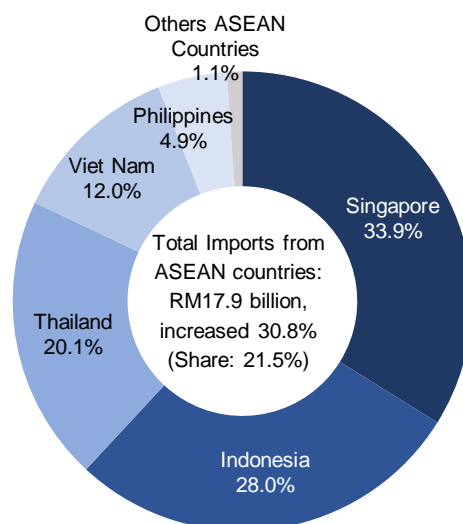


3. Imports from ASEAN Countries

Imports from ASEAN in June 2021 amounted to RM17.9 billion with a share of 21.5 per cent to total imports, increased by 30.8 per cent as compared to June 2020. The growth was mainly attributed to higher imports of petroleum products (+RM1.0 billion, +60.8%).

Among ASEAN countries of origin, one third of Malaysia's imports were from Singapore, expanded by 19.1 per cent or RM1.2 billion as compared to previous year.

4. Import Performance for Economic Sectors

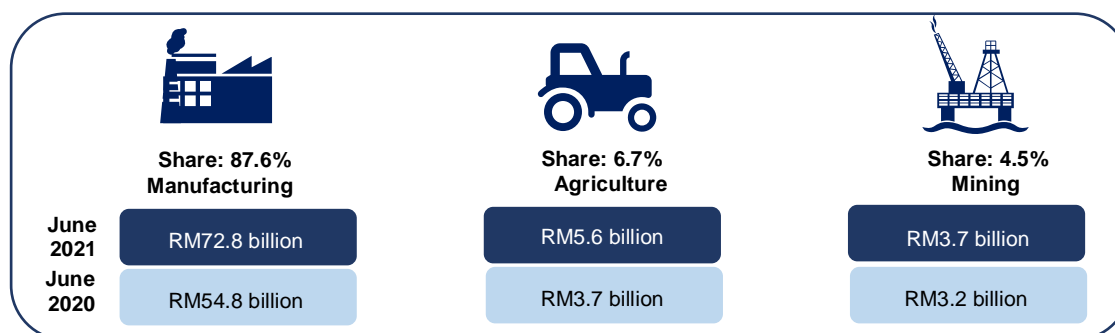
Expansion in imports was on the back of higher imports of all main sectors in June 2021.

Manufactured products which constituted 87.6 per cent of total imports, increased by 32.9 per cent from RM54.8 billion to RM72.9 billion y-o-y. This was supported by higher imports of petroleum products (+RM4.5 billion, +109.1%), E&E products (+RM3.6 billion, +17.1%) and chemical & chemical products (+RM2.9 billion, +49.4%).

Imports of agriculture products (6.7% of total imports) expanded by 50.0 per cent or RM1.9 billion y-o-y to RM5.6 billion, underpinned by higher imports of palm oil and palm oil-based agriculture products (+RM772.0 million, +242.9%), other agriculture products (+RM567.3 million, +22.6%), other vegetable oils (+RM249.3 million, +106.1%) and natural rubber (+RM220.4 million, +67.3%).

Imports of mining products amounted to RM3.7 billion, increased by 16.1 per cent compared with June 2020 and accounting for 4.5 per cent of Malaysia's total imports. The expansion was seen for imports of metalliferous ores and metal scrap which surged by 32.9 per cent or RM255.9 million.

5. Imports for End Use & Broad Economic Categories (BEC) Classification

Total imports in June 2021 was valued at RM83.2 billion, jumped 32.1 per cent y-o-y. The three main categories of imports by End Use which accounted for 71.6 per cent of total imports were:

Intermediate goods, was valued at RM43.7 billion or 52.5 per cent of total imports, increased by 25.3 per cent on account of higher imports of industrial supplies, processed (+RM5.2 billion, +40.0%), industrial supplies, primary (+RM1.4 billion, +62.1%), parts and accessory of transport equipment (+RM915.2 million, +64.4%) and food & beverages, processed, mainly for industries (+RM913.2 million, +118.5%);

Capital goods, stood at RM8.6 billion (10.3% of total imports) grew 15.2 per cent, attributable to the higher imports of capital goods (except transport equipment) (+RM376.2 million, +5.0%); and

Consumption goods, amounted to RM7.3 billion (8.8% of total imports) went up 19.2 per cent, resulting from the higher imports of food & beverages, processed, mainly for household consumption (+RM450.6 million, +24.9%), non-durables goods (+RM256.4 million, +15.7%), durables good (+RM169.9 million, +21.1%) and food & beverages, primary, mainly for household consumption (+RM118.6 million, +14.0%).
